NEWS AND UPDATE

Dear Stallholders, Customers, Friends and Patrons,

As you may be aware Lambousa Market will be moving to new purpose-built premises next week. Whilst a major part of the work on the site has been completed there will be further additions and improvements over the coming months, including a fixed roof for the Pavilion, winter siding, more paving, a large barn housing the café and bar amongst other things. To this end we ask for your understanding and patience as, after all, not even Rome was built in a day! Further details about the expanded Market and its additional facilities are as follows:

ACCESS & CAR-PARKING [see map]

Access the Market by approaching the Chateau gatehouse and driving either into the Chateau car-park [CP1] or by turning to Club Alda and taking the first LEFT turn onto the new car-parking sites [CP2 & 3]. Car-Parking has been expanded to 10 donums and is available on 3 sides of the new market site — giving better access for stall-holders and customers alike. GAU have kindly agreed to make the main Chateau Lambousa car-park [CP1] available and accordingly we respectfully request that patrons do not park in the areas shaded in red on the map.

THE MARKET: Trojan Garden, Planter Garden, Courtyard and Pavilion [see map]

The new market site is arranged over 4 areas with direct access and car-parking from 3 sides. The Trojan Garden borders CP1 (the Chateau Lambousa main car-park). The Planter Garden is adjacent to CP3 (the Auction House) and the Courtyard is next to CP2. Over the coming months all the Market areas will be fully paved and will have awnings and umbrellas rigged where space allows. The Pavilion, bordered by the other 3 trading-areas, is at the centre of the Market. It will have a fixed roof and also drop-down weather-proofing, making it fully enclosed for winter. Because the Pavilion has been designed as a clear space of 400m2 there have already been enquiries and suggestions for alternative uses, amongst them theatre staging and a sprung dance-floor. Should you have ideas for other uses please do not hesitate to bring them to our attention.

SHELTER & SHADING

We at Lambousa Market have always endeavoured as best we can to shelter our patrons from more extreme weather conditions, be they sun, rain or wind. Pending the completion of the Pavilion's roof and sides, awnings and shades will be rigged – though where our trees allow! And the market is protected from Cyprus' prevailing westerlies by virtue of being in the lee of our Auction rooms and other buildings.

LAVATORIES

A brand new lavatory block has been situated at the centre of the market. As well as Ladies' and Gentlemen's conveniences we have also installed an EU spec disabled access lavatory which will soon also have baby-changing facilities.
