## The Cyprus Papers, Al Jazeera Investigations (Undercover)

Speaker of the Parliament in the Greek Cypriot Administration Dimitris Şilluris whose name was involved in scandals regarding the "citizenship for investment", also known as "golden passports", has resigned.

According to the Greek Cypriot press, Şilluris announced that he resigned due to increased public pressure following the public reflection of the video taken by reporters who were disguised as investor intermediaries with a hidden camera.

Greek Cypriot Council of Ministers, during its extraordinary meeting held on Tuesday 13th October, 2020 cancelled the program which includes the criteria of granting citizenship to foreign investors in return for money.

It was noted that the decision was taken after the images were published by Al Jazeera and will come into effect as of 1st November.

According to the news of Al Jazeera, more than 1400 passports were approved between 2017-

2019. Many official documents obtained by Al Jazeera revealed that convicted fraudsters from more than 70 countries, money launderers and politicians accused of corruption, received a citizenship certificate called "golden passports" from the Greek Cypriot Administration. It was

noted that between these dates, the majority of applications for golden passports were made from Russia, China and Ukraine.

## Second round - TRNC Presidential election Sunday 18th October

The second round of the Presidential elections will be held on Sunday, 18th October 2020. UBP candidate Ersin Tatar and independent candidate Mustafa Akıncı are the two candidates who received the most votes and will compete in the second round.

In the first round of the Presidential election, which was held last Sunday 11th October, none of the 11 candidates received the absolute majority of the valid votes, the number of voters entitled to vote increased by 72% in respect of the first round and reached 199,029.

The voting process will start at 08:00am and will be completed at 18:00pm.

In the election to be held on Sunday, 18th October 2020; 63,884 voters will be able to vote in 223 ballot boxes in Lefkoşa; 50,030 voters in 185 ballot boxes in Gazimağusa; 42,933 voters in 163 ballot boxes in Girne; 15,003 voters in 54 ballot boxes in Güzelyurt; 20,310 voters in 83 ballot boxes in İskele and 6,869 voters in 30 ballot boxes in Lefke.

## Opening of Varosha region is historical turning point for Cyprus

Speaking at a party group meeting the President of Turkey and the AK Party Chairman Recep Tayyip Erdoğan referred to developments in Cyprus and noted that they have closely followed since the 1974 Peace Operation, and the closed beach and two main streets in Maraş that opened for the use of the Cypriot people in the last days.

Expressing that the opening of the closed Varosha region is a historical turning point for Cyprus, there are those who are uncomfortable with this, Erdoğan continued his words as follows:

“Who gets annoyed, we'll look at them. The West is disturbed. Who is disturbed? Greece is disturbed. Who is disturbed? Southern Cyprus, they are uncomfortable. But you are also looking at those who are uncomfortable inside. This really upset us. The closed Varosha region belongs to the Turkish Cypriots, this should be

known like this. I call out to our cognates in Northern Cyprus to my Turkish brothers: This land is yours. You have to protect these lands.”

Reminding that they repaired the failure in the pipeline carrying water from Anamur to Northern Cyprus after long and laborious work and started to give water to the island again, Erdoğan said that this pipeline is capable to meet the drinking water, irrigation water and utility water needs of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus.

Erdoğan also wished Northern Cyprus would benefit from the re-activation of the pipeline connecting Anatolia and Cyprus, as a source of prosperity.

In the meantime, one more step was taken, emphasising that they built a 1006-room hospital similar to the 1006-room hospital built in

Istanbul Atatürk Airport in a very short time, we will bring it to our brothers and sisters. It is finished within a two-month period. Thus, our cognates there will have an alternative hospital. This will be good for them. I hope that the Presidential elections in the second round will be the best for our

Cypriot brothers. I believe that the citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus will make the best decision for them and the island, Erdoğan said.

## Turkish Foreign Ministry statement regarding the Session of UN

Statement by the Turkish Foreign Ministry regarding the Session of United Nations on "The Situation in Cyprus".

Regarding the Session of United Nations Security Council on "The Situation in Cyprus" the Turkish Foreign Ministry said in a statement: "The international community must take into account the events on the island and not the propaganda of the Greek Cypriot administration and evaluate the developments without prejudice". The statement also stressed that Turkey fully supports the statement made by the Prime Ministry of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus.

The statement also said that the decision taken by the Turkish Cypriot authorities regarding the closed Maraş region does not create any unjust treatment and no change has been made in the status of the region opened for use. Therefore the claim that this resolution is contrary to the decisions of the UN Security Council does not reflect reality.

The international community must take into account the events on the island and not the propaganda of the Greek Cypriot administration and evaluate the developments without prejudice. Defence of the status quo will not benefit either of the two communities that are co-

owners of the island of Cyprus, nor will it contribute to the resolution of the Cyprus problem.

## Turkey continues protecting its own and Turkish Cypriots rights

Aksoy: "Turkey will continue to protect its own rights and those of the Turkish Cypriots in the Aegean and Mediterranean"

Turkish Foreign Ministry Spokesman Hami Aksoy criticised "unfounded" remarks made by the Foreign Minister of Greece.

"The claims and remarks of the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Greece Nikos Dendias in his interview with the newspaper Eleftheros Typos, which was published yesterday (11 October), are unfounded" Foreign Ministry spokesman Hami Aksoy said in a statement.

"Exploratory talks were suspended in 2016 upon the request of Greece. Claiming that the talks were suspended on the account of Turkey is an attempt to mislead public opinion" Aksoy said.

"By the same token, the claim that a single issue is discussed within the framework of exploratory talks does not reflect the reality. These talks are aimed at resolving all interrelated issues between the two countries" he said.

"On the other hand, it is the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus which opened the coastal area of Maras for public visits, not Turkey," the statement read.

"The Greek-Greek Cypriot duo's claim that identifies this step as a violation of UN Security Council resolutions and that people who enter the sea there threaten international security is ridiculous and far from being serious" he added.

According to Aksoy, the attempt by Greece to use the EU as a "trump card" against Turkey instead of resolving its issues in the Aegean and Eastern Mediterranean through sincere dialogue with our country, is a futile endeavour.

## Provocation of Greek Cypriot fascists should not go unpunished

Deputy Prime Ministry and Ministry of Foreign Affairs: "The provocation of Greek Cypriot fascists should not go unpunished this time"

The Deputy Prime Ministry and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs emphasised that it is unacceptable for members of the ultranationalist and chauvinist organisations to

break into the buffer zone under the supervision of the Greek Cypriot police and start fires by throwing torches and fireworks at the Derinya Land Border Gate which occurred on the evening of 11th October 2020.

In the written statement on the issue, it was stated that "the provocation of Greek Cypriot fascists should not go unpunished this time."

"In addition, as announced in the Greek Cypriot press, fascist organisations made calls to the Greek Cypriot people to participate in demonstrations for the same reason with the

participation of motorcycle groups in Lefkoşa on 13th October 2020 and in Derinya on 17th October 2020.

Our Ministry has already made the necessary suggestion to the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in order to prevent the extremist groups who will participate in both demonstrations not to come close to the land border gates and to take necessary measures by the Greek Cypriot administration on this issue, which will be a test of sincerity for the Greek Cypriot side".

## TRNC Presidential Election results 11th October 2020

Supreme Committee of Elections has announced the results of the Presidential elections which were held in the TRNC on 11th October 2020. 7 independent candidates out of a total of 11 candidates ran in the Presidential elections.

Out of 198,957 registered voters 115,966 cast their votes in the elections, which saw a 58.21% voter turnout.

Since none of the 11 candidates received more than half of the valid votes, the second round of the election at which Ersin Tatar and Mustafa Akıncı will compete will be held next Sunday 18th October.

## Tatar reacts to statement of the UN Security Council Presidency

The Leader of the National Unity Party and Prime Minister Ersin Tatar reacted to the statement of the UN Security Council Presidency regarding the opening of Maraş and said “the UN is expected to see the realities”.

In his written statement, Tatar stated “The decision taken regarding Maraş, which is a part of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, was discussed during the

UN Security Council session held on 9 October 2020 and within this framework, a statement was made by the UN Security Council Presidency.

As the Prime Minister of the TRNC, I consider that the statement was made without taking into consideration the new conjuncture in the Eastern Mediterranean and the realities of the Island by being affected by the Greek Cypriot side”.

Expressing that the Turkish Cypriot side never disregarded the UN parameters at the negotiations for many years but Maraş stayed closed for years due to the Greek Cypriot side not accepting a comprehensive solution, Tatar stressed that continuation of the status quo will not help the solution of the Cyprus problem.

Tatar added that many Greek Cypriots apply to the Immovable Property Commission. Some of these applications are regarding Maraş. Therefore, the decisions of the Immovable Property Commission will be compatible with the international law.

We expect the UN to evaluate the developments on the basis of the realities on the Island in a fair way

and to contribute to the solution of Cyprus problem.

Furthermore, Tatar pointed out “There is not any other territory in the world which has been kept closed due to waiting to reach a solution for half a century. This expansion is not only to the advantage of the Turkish Cypriots but to the advantage of the Greek Cypriots as well.

I hope this development will bring a new dimension to the Cyprus problem which has been continuing for years and the Turkish Cypriots will take their rightful place in the world”.

## Girne Municipality disinfected all schools in the region

Girne Municipality Health Department spraying teams and a private company disinfected the schools in the region within the scope of protective measures following the TRNC Presidential Election that took place on 11th October.

After the Presidential Elections held at the weekend, all schools in the Girne area were disinfected in order to protect the health of students and teachers and to reduce parents' concerns about hygiene.

Girne Mayor Nidai Güngördü made a statement on the subject and said; In schools where elections were held, classrooms comprising of hand-touched desks, door handles, tables and chairs and corridors, toilets and sinks were disinfected by our Municipality's disinfection units at 05:30 the following morning and schools were made ready.

Güngördü noted that while substances recommended by the World Health Organisation and licenced by the Ministry of Health are used in all spraying and disinfection activities, these substances do not have a negative effect on human health.

## Girne Municipality - Tax Amnesty extended to 31 December 2020

In the statement made by Girne Municipality, it has announced that a reorganisation has been made for taxpayers who have debt to the Municipality under the reduced financial regulation law regarding the updating of fixed assets in 15/2020 and the collection of accumulated public receivables.

With the agreement on the disputed or finalised taxes, the legally enforced Decree on the collection of partially or fully unpaid public receivables despite the due date of payment has been extended, taking into account the social conditions we are going through in respect of the Covid-19 pandemic, the official application

number 187 dated 30.09.2020 has been published in the newspaper and entered into force.

The application period to the law no 15/2020 on tax amnesty has been extended to, and including, 31.12.2020.

Accordingly, the applications of our citizens who want to benefit from the said law for "Drinking Water, Real Estate Tax and Workplace Taxes", which are subject to the reduction of penalties for delay in the Law No. 15/2020, will be submitted by Girne Municipality Financial Affairs Department and Girne Municipality Water Affairs until

31 December 2020.

If you would like to meet Toto, then please come up to the centre and see her - we are open every day between 9am and 1pm. Fingers crossed for Toto!

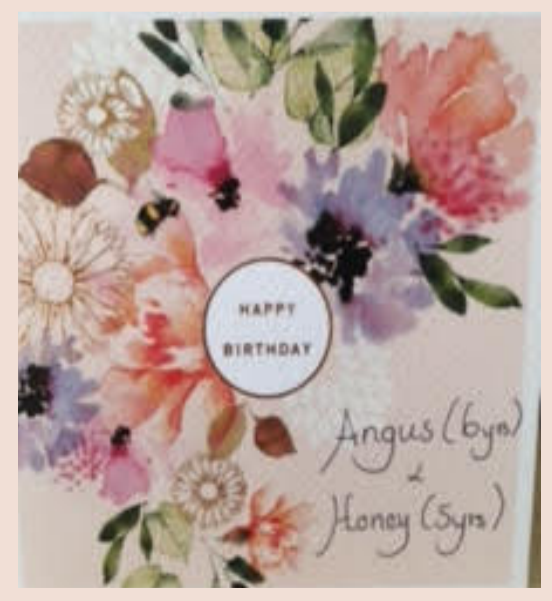

## Famagusta (Varosha) an 18 year old Soldier returns after 66 years



### Readers Mail .... from Richard Chamberlain ....

The last time I walked down Democratias Street in what is known now as Varosha or Maraş, but I knew it as Famagusta, was in 1954. I was serving as a British Soldier in the Royal Signals stationed just outside the lovely town of Famagusta. We soldiers used to go to the beautiful beach and clear blue sea to swim when we were off duty or go around the town shopping or eating in the few cafes that were there then. In the evening we used to go to the open air cinema.

Amazingly, after 45 years, the authorities have decided to open up to the public the closed military zone. There were hundreds of people waiting for the official opening on 8th October. When the gates opened, the people swarmed into the previously closed area after 45 years when the Turkish army closed the area to the public.

A lot of the roads and areas where people were allowed to go had been tarmacked and tidied up, and large pots of flowers had been put along the side of the roads. It was obvious the opening had been previously planned for some while. Most of the shops and buildings were in a poor state, but with time and money they could

be restored to their former glory. It was a surreal feeling walking down Democratias Street after 66 years. A feeling of excitement and sadness. Excitement because I never thought I would see inside Varosha again, and sadness because what I was seeing was a very different beautiful town that I once remembered and photographed.

When I was sent to Cyprus in 1954 under the National Service army scheme, I took a camera with me, and because everything was so amazingly different to where I had lived in the UK, I could not help photographing almost everything I saw.

When I walked round Varosha last week, I could hardly recognise the places I had photographed.

At the time I took the photos I did not realise the importance that they would have in modern history 66 years later when things in Cyprus have changed so much.

I am so pleased I have been able to visit and walk round the town of Varosha again before I die. It was an amazing experience and one I

shall treasure for the rest of what life I have left. Maybe, the rest of Varosha will be gradually opened up in the future, (politics willing), and what was once a lovely city/town will be restored to its former glory.

If you get a chance, I fully recommend you visit Varosha. You will have to use your imagination of how it was, or see the photos in my book. I have some books in the UK and Northern Cyprus. My email address is shown below.

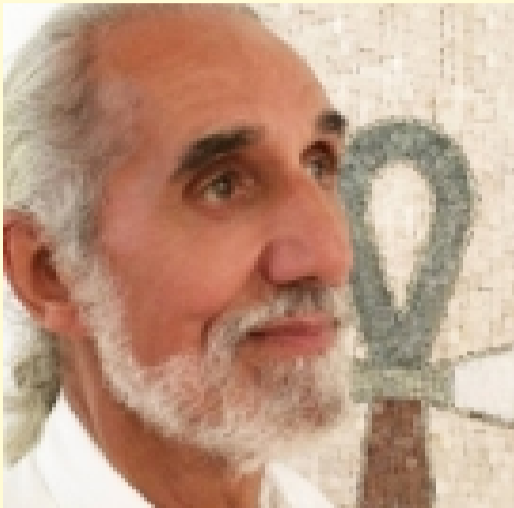

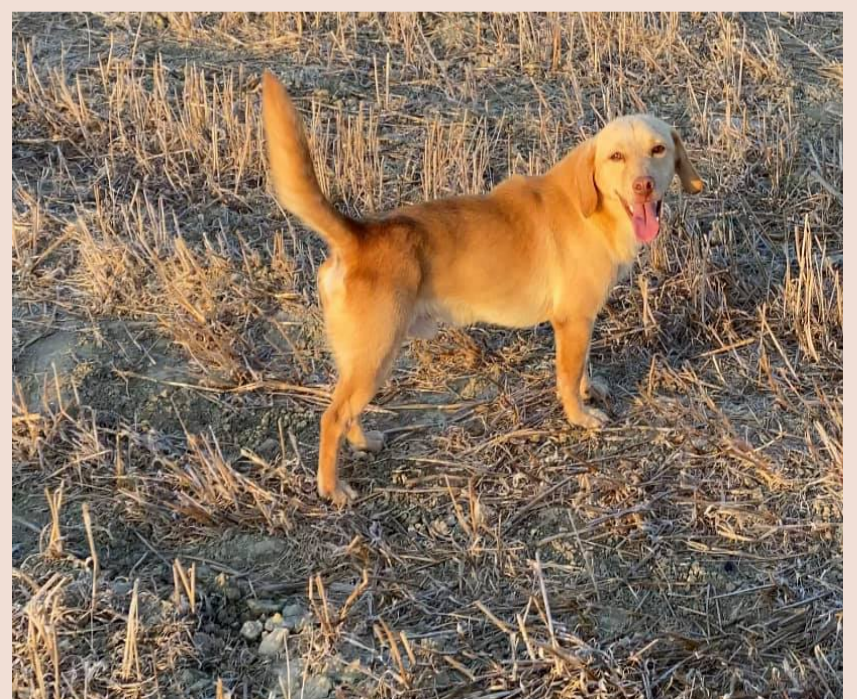

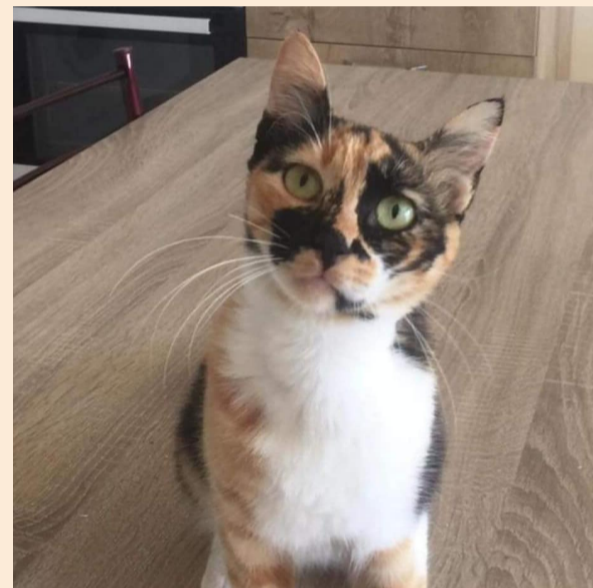

## RUSUK talk about their favourite books

### My favourite book

#### 'Manuscripts don't burn'

In 1968, the Rolling Stones released one of their most famous songs, 'Sympathy for the Devil'. It immediately hit the charts and eventually became an iconic Stones song. Sure, you know this.

What you probably don't know is that the song was inspired by the novel of the Russian playwright and author, Mikhail Bulgakov, who is now considered to be one of the greatest Russian writers of the XXth century. The book is called 'The Master and Margarita'.

He began writing it in 1928 and finished only in 1940, the year he died. It wasn't published in Russia and the West until 1967. Mick Jagger's then-girlfriend Marianne Faithfull gave him the book as a present, and according to her, they had a lengthy discussion about it. Jagger himself has confirmed that several times.

I first read it in 1990 when I was sixteen. In the Soviet Union it had been released in very limited circulation but still has become an iconic thing staged at theaters and later, in post-Soviet times, as a movie or TV series. Back in 1990 it was perestroika time and the book had been released in great circulation by various publishing houses.

I've started reading the novel's first chapter three times. In it, the Satan (his identity still not clear to the reader) comes to Moscow of the 1930s depicted as some weird foreign Professor Woland. The beginning seemed too boring to me as I couldn't get inside the plot at such an early stage.

How I was wrong... after my third try it was like diving into the deep waters and never wanting to get out, to stop floating in this ocean... I was gulping it chapter by chapter, then getting back, choosing the favorite pieces and reading it again countless times. It was just like getting into some parallel dimension. The book has become larger than life to me at this time and for years to come.

The novel has two settings, mixed with each other, chapter-based. The first is Moscow during the 1930s, where Satan appears at Patriarch's Ponds, a famous historical location, as Professor Woland. It is also a love story of the Master, a mad writer locked up in a home for the insane (it is believed this character to be a reflection of the author himself) and Margarita, a 30-year old beautiful woman. She lived, or I'd say, locked up in a passionless marriage with some Moscow bureaucrat much older than her. As the story goes by, the Master and Margarita lose each other, then encounter Woland in very strange ways...

The second setting is... the Jerusalem of Pontius Pilate where there is the trial of Yeshua Ha-



Notsri or Jesus of Nazareth, going on. The author describes Jesus in the novel as a real person which was unthinkable for Soviet Russia. Pilate gets to the recognition of an affinity with Yeshua and even of some spiritual need for him... This is where Jagger got his idea for his song.

Finally, both settings meet, each leading to a very strange connection between Woland and Yeshua... 'When evil is only seems to pretend evil but actually creates good...' It then impacts Master and Margarita's destiny, mysteriously changing their lives and spiritual habitat forever.

I love sci-fi and fantasy but this was a very unusual, even breathtaking plot staged in Stalin's Moscow, so tightly mixed with reality, written in perfect language. It is deep and fun, satiric and serious, phantasmagoric and very real... I've never seen anything like this before in my life.

It is really hard and kind of useless trying to describe what the book is about. Love, devotion, good, evil, satire, fantasy; whole life is within the book, depicted in very dramatic style.

You better just read it and make your own opinion. Some critics consider it to be one of the best novels of the 20th century, as well as the foremost of Soviet satires.

P.S. The title of this blog is the most famous line from the book. The Master burned his book (just like the author who did the same with the first version of the novel) and, at some point, got it back from Woland, absolutely unharmed, along with this quotation.



### My favourite book

#### Sounds and Scores – Henry Mancini

This is effectively a practical guide to professional orchestration, with all the hundreds of examples contained within being composed and arranged by the multi-award winning author.

It was originally published in 1962, and today, a pristine, unused copy is easily worth up to £500.00. I bought mine back in 1977, and even with over 40-odd years of wear and tear, it would still pocket me £50 or £60 on eBay, not that I ever intend to sell.

I'll tell you how old it is – it came with four separate records, or discs, (not the compact sort either!) to help illustrate aurally around 150 passages of orchestration contained in the 243-page book.

Henry Mancini was a true legend – even if you're not familiar with his name, you are almost bound to know some of his creations, like the song "Moon River", or the theme tune to the "Pink Panther" films. He wrote music for over 60 films – check –

## RUSUK talk about their favourite books

For a musician, this book has everything you need to know about each and every instrument of the orchestra; it will tell you, for instance, what the top and bottom notes of a bass flute are, and it contains all the hints and tips you would ever need for orchestrating and arranging, all written by one of the world's greatest contemporary orchestrators and arrangers.

I have kept and referred to this book throughout my musical career, and still today in retirement, I am happy to peruse its contents. I marvel at how much easier it is today to use the many sophisticated computer programmes to actually "write" the millions of notes that are used in a score, rather than in Mancini's day, (he died in 1994), when it still all had to be done by hand, using reams of expensive music manuscript paper.

All through the years, I always was able to vividly recall the last three sentences in the book. Mancini writes: "Finally, don't fall in love with every note you write.

The professional writer must be a first class editor. Be prepared to eliminate anything that tends to clutter up your score, painful as it may be to do so."

If you substitute the word "note" with "word", and then "score" with "blog", I think it's every bit as relevant to me today!



### A Connoisseur of Rubbish!

First, you should know that I will never be asked to host a book of the month reading club. My taste in books is, well... lacking. It's not that I don't read, I read quite a bit actually, it's that I would not burden others with my bizarre taste in literature.

Perhaps my most outlandish turn at book consumption was during about the seventh and eighth grades. I read college astronomy textbooks for fun. I'm still a big fan of all things space and can tell you what SpaceX is doing in any given week.

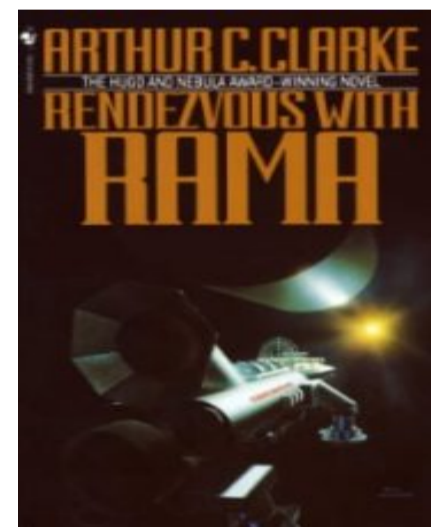
From this you would already guess that I read Science Fiction. Another thing you may not know is that Si-Fi fans can be a little snobbish. See, there are two different kinds of Science Fiction. First is the Star Wars stuff where our hero grabs a light sabre and slays the Dark Lord. The second maybe better called Science Speculation instead of Science Fiction.

These authors spend months doing the math to make sure their worlds would actually work. Let me give you an example: You may have heard of a fellow named Arthur C. Clark. One of his books is called Rendezvous with Rama. The book is set on a giant rotating space craft called an O'Neill Cylinder. I absolutely guarantee you that if you run the formula to predict gravity and plug-in the size of Rama and its rotational speed, the interior would produce the exact same gravity we have here on Earth. This is a long way from the magic floor plates producing gravity in Star Wars.

Moreover, American physicist Gerard K. O'Neill developed these habitats for real, peer reviewed papers. Unless something terrible happens, your grandchildren may live on one of these things. You may not know about O'Neill Cylinders but I promise NASA does.

So, I'll recommend one of my crazy, childish Si-Fi books: how about The Mote in God's Eye? It's by two guys named Larry Niven and Jerry Pournelle. (Gregorian Chants swell in the background) They wrote a couple of books you may not find too stupid.

While there is faster than light travel in this book, it's based on real theory so it could be possible. The story is about first contact and it really is well done. My only complaint is that the story-telling in the first 95% of the book is so good you expect it to close with some massive plot twist on the last page. I guess basing fiction on physics has some drawbacks.
