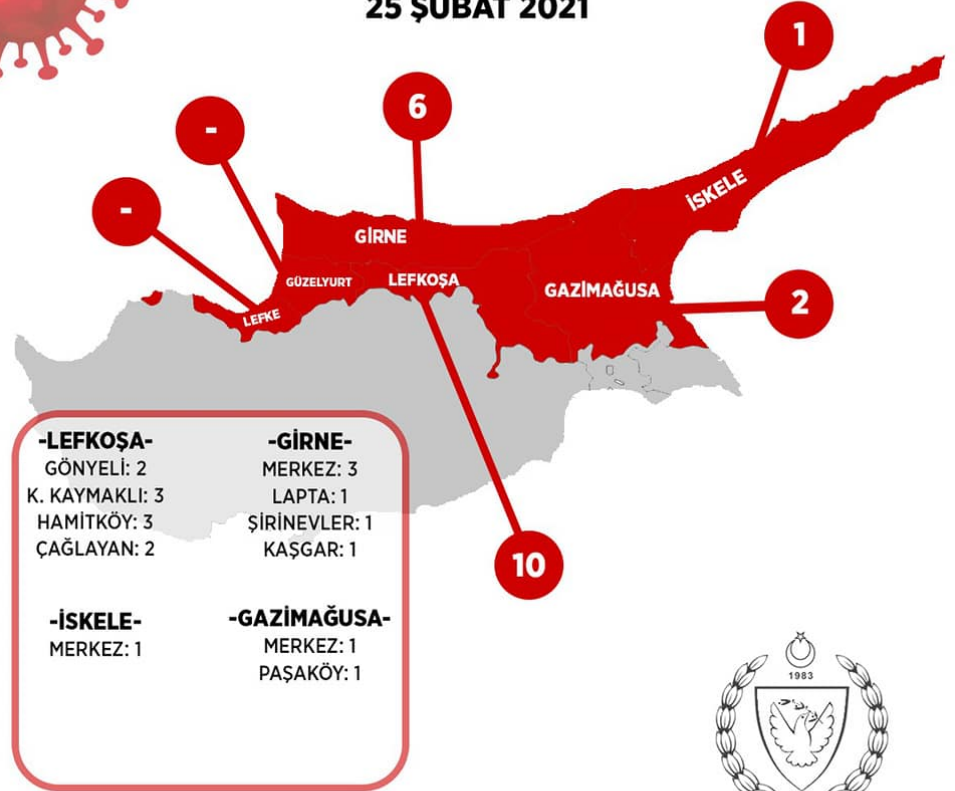

UK Parliamentarians congratulated Tatar on election as President

British Parliamentarians sent a congratulatory letter to President Ersin Tatar. According to the information given by the Presidency, in the letter sent with the signature of Lord Northbrook, Co-Chairperson of the Parliamentary Group of All Parties - TRNC (APPG-TRNC), it was stated that they congratulated President Ersin Tatar on his election as President of the TRNC.

In the letter, the meeting held at Parliament during Tatar's London visit where he talked about two-states on the basis of sovereign equality, was also mentioned. It was noted: "We will follow your two-state solution proposal with great interest".

In his response to the letter, President Tatar expressed his

satisfaction for the efforts of APPG-TRNC for standing against the inhuman isolations and injustice towards the Turkish Cypriot people for many years.

President Tatar noted the following in his letter:

"I give great importance to the continuation of coordinated lobbying activities in the UK and the search for new opportunities in trading and direct flights post-Brexit. During his visit to the island we also discussed these, and other issues, with the UK Foreign Secretary Dominic Raab.

As the Turkish Cypriot side which is fully supported by Turkey we put forward that any sustainable and realistic solution in Cyprus should be based on the sovereign

equality of two states living side by side in cooperation."

In his letter, President Tatar mentioned that no solution was reached in the 2004 Annan Plan and in Crans Montana, Switzerland in 2017 and the Turkish Cypriot side had no fault in the on-going negotiations within the framework

of the federal solution. Tatar added: "The federal solution negotiations are exhausted due to the irreconcilable and hegemonic desire of the Greek Cypriot side in not sharing power and prosperity with the Turkish Cypriot side."

Çelik: Greek Cypriot side admission to EU is against rules & law

AK Party spokesman in Turkey, Ömer Çelik, stated that the recognition of the Greek Cypriot side and its admission to the European Union is contrary to all

the rules, law and the fundamental principles of international relations.

Çelik answered the questions of

journalists at the press conference held at AK Party Headquarters.

Upon a question whether there is an action plan for recognition of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, Çelik said that the old negotiation model in Cyprus is not possible to be continued.

Stating that it is time to speak of a two-state solution model, Çelik said that recognition of the Greek Cypriot side and admission to the European Union is against all rules, law and the fundamental principles of international relations.

"Turkey desires to see the recognition of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus as a

sovereign state. There is a state, a flag, a President and a Prime Minister there. There is a government and an Assembly. They represent the Turkish Cypriot cause.

Turkey desires to see that the TRNC is respected and recognised by the international community.

This policy of Turkey has been continuing for many years" Çelik added.

North Cyprus in Dubai Gulfood exhibition

Turkish Cypriot Chamber of Industry (TCCI) attended the Dubai Gulfood exhibition with 5 companies.

According to the information from the TCCI the exhibition will be open until 25 February 2021.

Head of the TCCI Candan Avunduk mentioned that the Dubai Gulfood exhibition has been held since 1987 and TCCI has been attending the exhibition for 16 years. The exhibition has 5,000

participant firms and 97,000 people have visited the fair.

Avunduk stated that despite the global pandemic Turkish Cypriot Chamber of Industry attended the Dubai Gulfood exhibition in order to improve the exports and the economy of the country by creating networks with the foreign markets and Turkish Cypriot producers.

Equal status and legitimacy should be created between the 2 sides

Special Representative of President Ersin Tatar, Ergün Olgun stated that equal international status and legitimacy conditions should be created between the two sides for sustainable peace, stability and cooperation in Cyprus.

In the written statement made by Olgun, it was stated that the 1960 partnership arrangements and usurpation of the rights of the Turkish Cypriot people in 1963 by the Greek Cypriots is a clear violation of 1960 Treaties and the Constitution.

The statement emphasised "The tolerance of this usurpation by the international community did not legitimise this international illegality and did not eliminate the legitimate equal rights and status of the Turkish Cypriots. It is accepted in the UN Security Council resolutions that the relation of the sides is not a minority / majority relationship and it is on the basis of a political equality. The problem is that this principle and its reasons are observed by the international community in practice".

Furthermore, it was stated that it should also be remembered that the mission of the United Nations organisation is to facilitate the achievement of an agreement freely negotiated and accepted by the two parties in Cyprus.

It was also stressed "In this context, everything is included in the resolutions of the UN Security Council that nothing will be accepted until everything is accepted".

Considering the objective realities of our island and our region and what is required for peace and stability in this geography, it is obvious that sustainable reconciliation and cooperation with the Greek side is not possible to be reached with the so-called federal partnership arrangements that provide the Greek side with superiority in many aspects and patching the Turkish Cypriot side to the so-called Republic of Cyprus under their occupation.

Considering also the events in the last 54 years of negotiation process, the Greek Cypriot side using the international status unfairly and the main reason of the instability in the Eastern Mediterranean, it is clear that sustainable peace, stability and cooperation is possible with equal status of the two sides and by respecting sovereign equality of the two sides.

"With this vision, the Turkish Cypriot side will attend the 5+UN unofficial meeting where it will be discussed whether there is a common ground to start the official negotiations or not.

In our continuous contacts with the UN, it is foreseen that the meeting will be held in the second half of April 2021 and most probably in Geneva".

Tatar: Our voice and our thesis are in the world agenda

President Ersin Tatar stated that the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) is a sovereign state which is known by the whole world and added that a two-state solution model is being discussed in the whole world including the Greek Cypriot side. Tatar stressed “We have now brought our voice and our thesis to the world agenda”.

President Tatar held a video conference with heads of different civil organisations in relation to the latest developments on the Cyprus issue and current affairs.

President Tatar stated that a “new page” has been opened following the Presidential election, adding that he was “putting forward a new policy and vision based on the political will of the people and the authority which has been afforded to me”.

President Tatar said “for any agreement to be sustained there is need for the approval of the two peoples,” adding: “The TRNC is a sovereign state. The world accepts the existence of the TRNC and acknowledges and respects that

Turkish Cypriots are a separate people. A two State settlement is being debated in different parts of the world, including the Greek Cypriot side,” he said.

The President added: “The recognition of the sovereignty of the Turkish Cypriot people is very important. The coordinated efforts between the TRNC and the Republic of Turkey have created a strong and consistent position for the Turkish side.” He added that the policy developed unanimously with the Republic of Turkey for a solution model to be based on sovereign equality based on the existence of two States, has come to the agenda of the world.

“Turkey is a powerful, leading country in the eastern Mediterranean,” President Tatar said. “The guarantee of Turkey is a red line of the Turkish Cypriot side. Messages are being communicated to the whole world in relation to the increasing importance of the TRNC which is located in Blue Homeland. We

have at long last carried our voice and policy to the agenda of the world.”

Emphasising the position of the Turkish side in relation to the Cyprus issue, President Tatar stated “negotiations for a federation, on-going for over 50 years, have been exhausted. The understanding of a federation is very different between the Turkish Cypriot side and the Greek Cypriot side. The Greek Cypriot understanding of a federation envisages the diminishing of the influence of Turkey in Cyprus over a period of time. It also envisages for the Turkish Cypriot people to be patched onto the Republic of Cyprus.” Stressing that the Turkish Cypriot people, who have the right to self-determinate “are not without alternatives,” the President said “our state will exist forever, with or without a settlement.”

98 year old Ernie Andrus crossing America on foot

He is not a recognised athlete. He is not a runner. He is not even a competitor. He has not won medals in races. But what he is doing is something that most of us in general and athletes in particular, do not even dream of.

98 years old ERNIE ANDRUS is crossing America on foot. This is not just first time that he is doing this. He had crossed America at the age of 93, and is now again tracking back the same route. Some may consider him a crazy person, but he is just a man that I always and still want to be. Yes I always want to enter into such astonishing adventures.

Back in 1974, when I was about 19 years old, my father was appointed as liaison officer, with an engineer sent by the World Bank, to carry out some research about water distribution in Karachi city (Pakistan).

My father at that time was Financial Adviser in the Karachi Development Authority. Apart from the development of good friendship between the two, my father was introduced to the National Geographic Magazine for the first time by that American Engineer.

So I also then read the National Geographic Magazine for the first time. The first issue that I came across was having an adventure walk of a young couple across America. They had travelled from west to east (or was it from east to west, I am not sure now). The magazine had published a detailed story about them and there were many photos. I was thrilled to read all that.

Perhaps that was the first time that I had seriously developed a liking for adventures. In other words that was the beginning point of my never ending thirst for adventure.

Returning back to 98 years old

Ernie Andrus, I found some material on the internet about him. Born in 1923, he participated in the second World War, in the American Navy.

He is said to raise money for LST 325 Ship Memorial. He had been one of the crew on one such ship during the second world war.

Returning back to his adventure. He had started his first cross America walk on 7th October 2013 at San Diego (Pacific ocean), and finished it about 3 years later on 16th March 2019, at Saint Simons Island (Atlantic Ocean). He was 90 when starting off and ended it at the age of 93.

Later on, he went out for different short distance walks, but as he

said, he got bored, so he decided to re-trace his previous route, and returned back to start his Trans-America walk, from the point where he had finished three years earlier. He is still on his way, doing 13 miles a week.

His doctors have diagnosed him with congestive heart failure, but he is still moving ahead and says that he wants to die with his running shoes on.

That indeed is what I always dream of. I strongly believe that one day I will be doing any such long long walk, from some particular point on the earth to some other point.

“You may say I am a Dreamer”.

Once the centre re-opens, if you are interested in homing her, then please come up and meet this lovely young dog. Please share for Monday and let's find her that large garden that she would love so much.



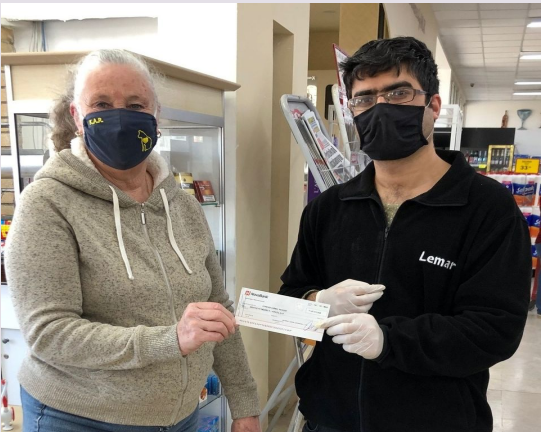

KAR - News Update



VET'S ASSISTANT VOLUNTEERS - all you need to know!

The day in the life of a kitty snipper - written by JJ (volunteer extraordinaire and aka Mrs Cake)

I joined KAR around 2012 and worked in our GladRags shop, since then the I've become a Meeter and Greeter at our centre one morning a week, still working GladRags one morning a week and now volunteer to work with our KAR vet, neutering un-owned street cats.

KAR are very proactive in trying to reduce the numbers of un-owned cats in that we have a scheme of neuter and return.

We work 2 days a week neutering cats, and are supported by our 2 lovely vets who each work one day, ably supported by 4 volunteers assistants, 2 each day. Wednesday is Public stray day, people can book in stray cats to be neutered and collect them later in the day. Instructions on after care are given. Thursday is cat catching day, (my day) our cat catching team consists of Yulian our community warden and his trusty volunteer cat catchers Beryl and Sue. People can report large colonies of cats that live on sites, restaurants, etc and a slot is booked for the cat catching team to come. Our waiting lists get full pretty quickly so there can be a wait.

So, what do we do with our cats?

We aim to neuter around 10 cats per day. Each cat is weighed to determine how much sedation they need, it can be a little lively and noisy as some just don't appreciate being in a cage, squashed and a needle stuck in their thigh. Some protest (loudly) more than others. It takes around 15-20 minutes for the sedation to work, we check they are asleep as some have been known to try and fool us and attempt to make a drunken escape, they never do! Once we know they are asleep they get their anaesthetic injection, we wait 20 minutes until we know they are completely out. They are then prepped for their operation and the necessary bits of anatomy are shaved. All the cats are health checked, their teeth and ears are checked. They are given a long acting antibiotic injection, an injection for the pain and a worming injection. If they have fleas or ticks we treat them for those too. Next step is surgery, after surgery the left ear is clipped, this indicates the cat has been neutered, we also use a long antibiotic spray which we spray on the wound, so it you see any boy cats walking around with blue bottoms you will know why. The girls will have blue tummies. This spray can stay on the skin and fur a while. When we have finished the cat is placed in its cage to recover and we check on them regularly.

Wednesday cats are taken home by the person that brought them. Thursday cats stay overnight in our vet room, Yulian collects them and releases them to the area they came from.

What's the cost? We ask for a minimum of 80TL per cat to cover the meds. A bargain!

If you have read this and think could I do this? do I need experience? yes you can, no, you don't need experience. Just a love and enthusiasm for our furry friends and to work to aim to reduce the numbers of unwanted animals, the neutered animal has a safer and healthier life.

If you would like to become a Kitty Snipper volunteer please email the office on kartrnc@gmail.com and we will contact you once lockdown has been lifted and we are allowed to return to work.

This handsome boy is **Maraş**, who was found by another animal rescue group. They asked for our help as he had a broken back foot, so he came to stay with us and his foot is now healing nicely. He is about 8 years old, very friendly and as you can see, he doesn't mind being sniffed by Evie - our resident photo-bomber! He has probably been on the streets for his whole life so it would be fantastic if he could spend his senior years in a home of his own. Please come and see him once the centre is open again - we will of course be making an announcement when we can allow visitors again. Please share for Maraş!

BRS News: Latest changes to Curfew/Lockdown - 20th February

We are sharing for readers who are seeking the latest facts and information news recently provided by the British Residents' Society to their members.

LATEST CHANGES TO CURFEW/LOCKDOWN

PLEASE READ ALL SECTIONS AS THERE IS A LOT OF INFORMATION INCLUDED

FROM MONDAY 22ND FEBRUARY UNTIL FRIDAY 26TH FEBRUARY

Food Markets will be open between 8 am and 6 pm

Retail and merchandising services will open between 10 am and 6 pm.

The supply chain will operate which will include taking orders, shelf arrangements and displays. Orders, sales, and distribution will be allowed between 8 am and 6 pm. Shelf arrangement and such will be done after 6pm.

ESTABLISHMENTS THAT WILL REMAIN CLOSED:

Theatres and cinemas, performance centres, concert halls, engagement/wedding and birthdays halls, casinos, bars, taverns, coffeehouses, cafeterias, hookah cafes and halls, internet cafes, all kinds of game halls, indoor playgrounds, swimming pools, massage parlours, spas, indoor sports halls, open buffet restaurants, hairdressers, barbers, beauty salons, tattooists, open markets, night clubs, clubs, Turkish baths, and saunas.

ESTABLISHMENTS THAT WILL NOW BE ALLOWED TO OPEN:

All businesses and activities that are not included above may be open under the conditions stated below.

Restaurants, cafes, buffets, sandwich shops, bagel sellers, etc. services will only be provided in the form of takeaways, online sales, and deliveries. Seating areas will not be used in these sectors. Takeaway/delivery services will be provided between 7 am and 9 pm.

(NB – Under previous regulations provided by the Police, takeaways were allowed provided that the customer collecting is able to be at home before the curfew time of 8 pm. After that only deliveries can be made up until 9 pm. Please check with the outlet at the time of ordering which service they are providing.)

There will be no trying on of products in the clothing industry.

Betting offices will be able to operate at the door without using seating areas.

In open businesses, the total number of customers and employees will be 1 person in a maximum of 5 m2.

In order to protect the social distance, these businesses will display information at entrances explaining the m2 areas and how many people can be in the business, including employees at any one time.

In addition, businesses that provide services will work on a staff rotation method or with reduced personnel.

People working in open sectors will repeat PCR tests every fifteen days.

INDIVIDUALS ARE ASKED TO MEET THEIR ESSENTIAL NEEDS FROM BUSINESSES CLOSEST TO THEIR RESIDENCE.

SATURDAY 27TH FEBRUARY

All businesses and activities will be closed on Sunday, except pharmacies and bakeries.

EXERCISE

People can now go to open spaces for exercise, but the TRNC Government urges people to use the closest option to their homes. For those who are looking for a link to this information, there is not one, but you may note that the clarification came from the Prime Ministry to the BRS.

CURFEW EXEMPTION CERTIFICATES

With effect from the 22 February travel within the same district DOES NOT require a Curfew Exemption Permit request to be submitted within the hours of 20.00 to 05.00, however, the TRNC Government urges people to use the closest option available to their homes, wherever possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Since the number of infections is less in the Lefke, Güzeyurt, Iskele and Famagusta districts, and in order to prevent the further spread of infection to these districts, it has been deemed appropriate that travel from Nicosia and Girne districts to the above-mentioned districts will be controlled by the District Police Boards.

Travel between different districts at any time still requires an application to be made for a Curfew Exemption Permit Application to be submitted.

Only TRNC citizens and permanent residents who travelled from the United Kingdom, Netherlands, Brazil, Denmark, and South Africa where they had been for the previous 14 days are allowed to enter the country, provided that they remain in central quarantine for 14 days.

(NB - Permanent Residents are those persons who have a current Residency Permit. They MUST be in possession of the document when travelling)

Certain Institutions will remain open and these are,

Essential departments of the Ministry of Health and health personnel, the Ministry of Finance, police, fire brigade, municipality, civil defence, district police boards, Customs, Central Prison, BRTK, TAK, TÜK, KIBTEK, Milk Institution, press employees and / or universities with yellow press cards will be able to work at full capacity.

(NB – We have contacted the Ministry of the Interior to get confirmation as to whether their regional offices are open to the public between Monday 22nd and Friday 28th February. Please note that if they are operating it will be with reduced staff.)

The Ministry of Public Works and Transportation has confirmed that the Motor Vehicle department in Lefkosa WILL be open from 8.30am daily until either 3pm or 4pm dependant on how busy they are. They also confirmed that all Motor Vehicle offices situated in District Tax Offices WILL also be open during normal hours.

The personnel deemed essential to work in the Ministries, departments and institutions affiliated with the ministries will continue their duties as determined by the senior management.

In order not to interrupt all services at the Air and Sea Ports, minimum personnel will be employed.

All institutions and workplaces are obliged to measure temperatures at the entrances, to comply with the social distancing rules, use markings in order to maintain

social distancing in accordance with square meters, and to apply hygiene and disinfection conditions both inside the workplace and at the entrances and exits. It is the employer's responsibility to implement these measures.

Until February 28, 2021, there will be no face-to-face education (including private lessons and course activities) in public and private schools, all pre-school, primary and secondary education, and to switch to online education. Considering the prevalence of the epidemic in the society and the curfew, it was decided to stop the services of private education centres. However, in sectors that will remain open, creches may be open on demand in order not to interrupt the services.

It has been deemed appropriate for people residing in Northern Cyprus and required to travel to Southern

Cyprus for treatment purposes, to cross without daily quarantine as long as they document their appointments at the border gates.

The patient and their attendant (if necessary) will be required to submit a negative PCR test result taken within the last 3 days upon arrival. In addition, patients and companions returning to our country following treatment should repeat their PCR tests again on the seventh and fourteenth days of their entry into the country and submit the results to our Ministry

Funerals will be held with the participation of only first-degree relatives.

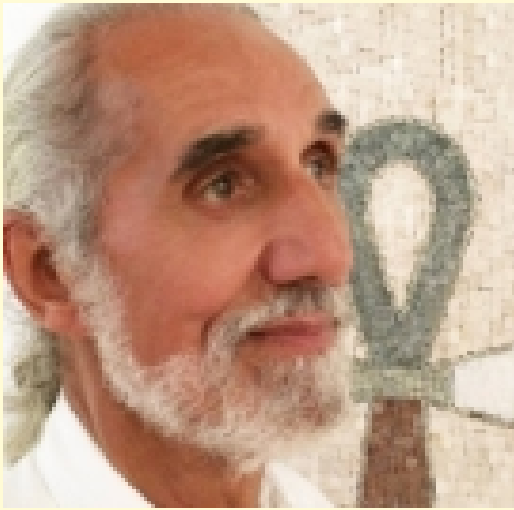
The owner of the business was fined 3,820 TL and the hairdressing salon was sealed by Municipality police teams for a period of 1 month.

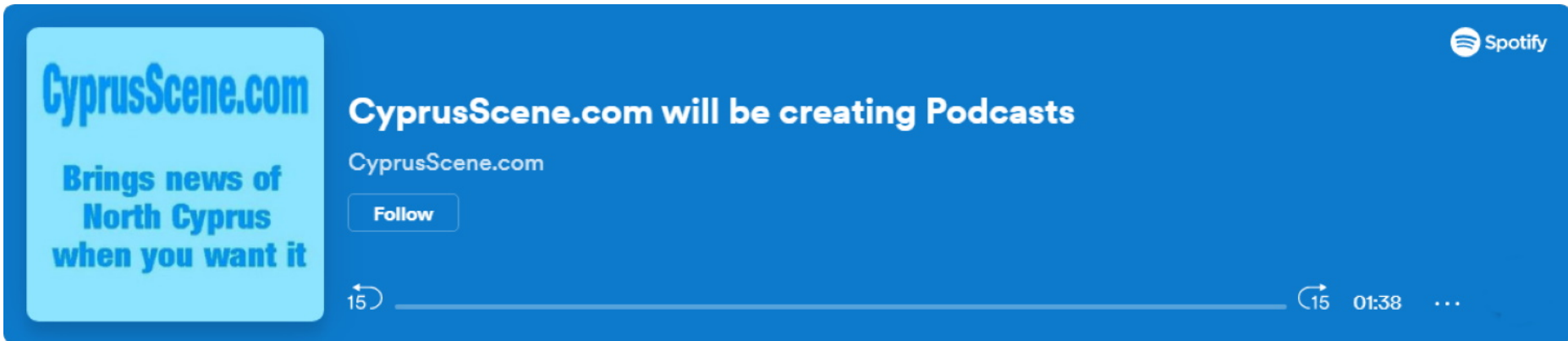

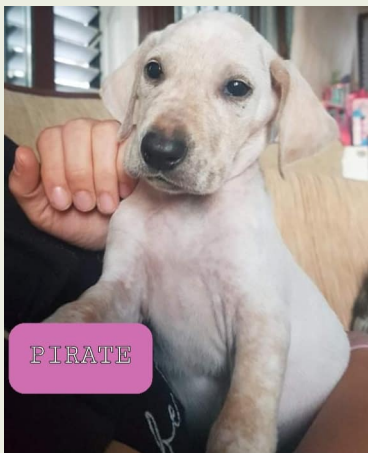

The foster needs to be on the westside due to current restrictions.

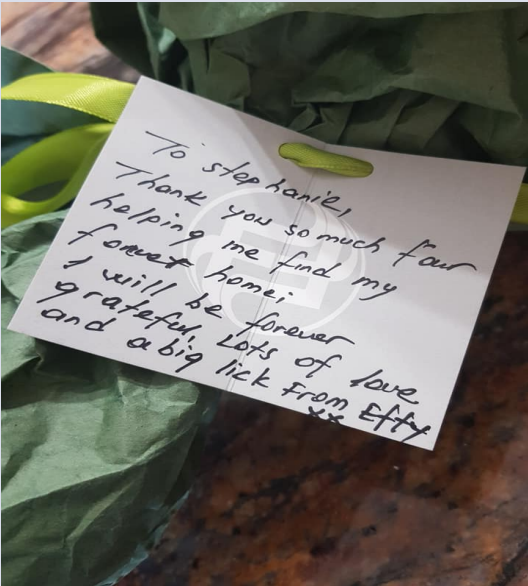

Damn Virus

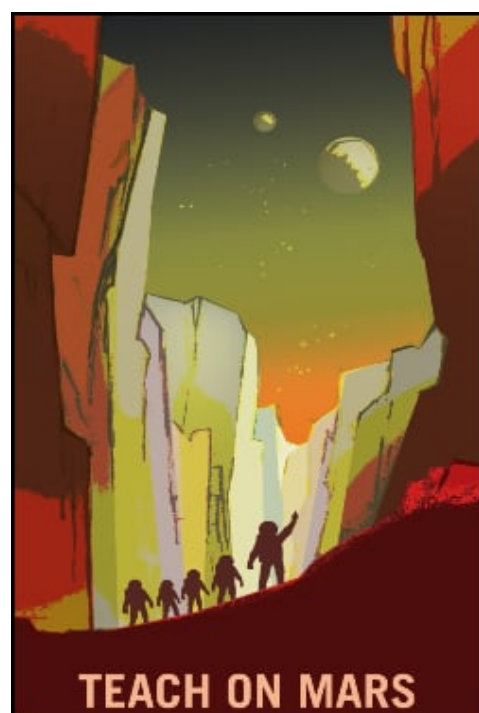

I know some folks are afraid to fly and rightfully so. Apparently in the US, airlines are considering having passengers show they have had the vaccine before they can board. Next week we receive our second jab, for which we are extremely grateful, but we don't know yet whether we can still carry the virus and transmit it onwards. And airports seem like one of the places to avoid like the plague. In any case, direct flights to Malta from here have long since ceased, and who knows if they will ever return.

Our country remains very safe compared to most of the world, but that's because of extremely strict measures, including enforced government quarantine for up to 14 days for all incoming travellers. That's been described as being in prison but without any hope of

time off for good behaviour! Sadly, Mrs B has many underlying health issues, and she would not survive 14 days without being able to leave a room.

Will things have changed by next Christmas, for our trip to Denmark? Well, maybe most people will have been vaccinated by then, and maybe it will feel a little safer. But is it worth the risk? Will we even be able to afford what are likely to be astronomical airfares? Maybe there'll be a fourth or fifth wave of the virus, meaning we might not be able to get home.

That's a frightening thought that would be on our minds the whole time.

So I think it's more likely that we will give 2021 travel a miss, and hope we can finally catch up with all our postponed visits in 2022.

Intense activities during one week's PCR testing in Girne

Conducted by the Ministry of Health, PCR Tests with the support of Girne Municipality Teams received great Interest at the weekend.

In the information given by the Girne Municipality, at the weekend, with the support of the Ministry of Health personnel and the Girne Municipality teams, PCR tests were carried out trouble-free and with great care at the Leymosun Culture House belonging to the Girne Municipality on Fazıl Küçük Boulevard on the New Harbour Road.

It was reported that 704 people were tested on Saturday 20th February and 790 people in total on Sunday 21st February until 15:00 at the Leymosun Culture House, which had been taking place every day during the week

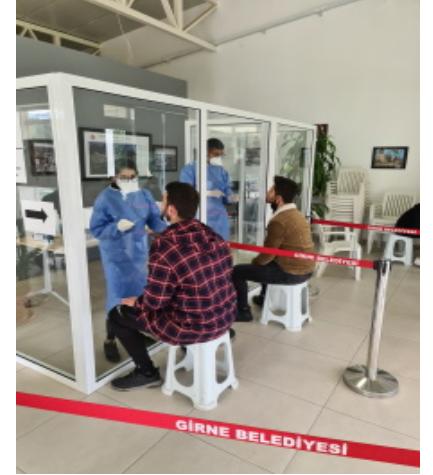
(including Saturday-Sunday) between 8.00 and 15.30.

Girne Mayor Nidai Güngördü made a statement on the subject; "Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, PCR tests are continuing in the Culture House of Leymos with the cooperation of the Ministry and the Municipality, in these important studies carried out by the Ministry of Health. With the last decision of the Council of Ministers, many businesses will be opened as of Monday 22nd February. "The number of tests carried out yesterday is 700, and there was a huge density here in the morning hours."

Güngördü noted that the tests continue and, as a result, they provide a great service in increasing the number of tests, which is an important point for the society.

As a result of these collaborations, Güngördü emphasised that everyone should pay more attention to wearing masks, social distance and hygiene rules, especially because of the businesses to be opened at weekends.

Survey, Restoration & Rehabilitation of Old Girne Harbour

With the cooperation of Girne Municipality and the Ministry of Tourism, Department of Antiquities, and Planning Construction Department, surveying, restoration and rehabilitation work has started for all buildings with a skyline to the harbour at the Girne Antique Harbour.

According to the information received from the Girne Municipality, it was reported that the necessary work will be started according to the results of the archaeological experiment excavations made in 5 locations in order to understand the ground physiology, for the work to be

started in the Girne Ancient Harbour, and the Urban Aesthetics Department of the Girne Municipality will play a major role in the construction of architectural projects.

Girne Mayor Nidai Güngördü made a statement on the issue; "People sought aesthetic quality in the environments they created as well as in the buildings and, with this concern, they sought to regulate their environment." Güngördü stated that the project they will carry out in cooperation with the Ministry of Tourism, Antiquities and Planning Construction Department will be a wealth to the public. He pointed out that the restoration, which is

the necessity of bringing the buildings to the present day without deterioration, will be carried out as a result of long studies, and stated that it is of great importance to restore the Ancient Harbour, which has been neglected for various reasons, and that they work with all means in this context.

Güngördü stated that they see a positive understanding from the businesses and business owners in this region and that this is very important for them.

Latest news of recycling packaging in Karmi

Readers mail....

Jules Hall...

Hi Chris, I hope that you are well? I promised you that I would keep you informed as to the progress of the packaging recycling scheme in Karmi. The residents have all been fully committed to reducing the amount of packaging that ends up in landfill and we managed to fill the cage over the last week with recyclable plastics, aluminium and steel cans.

I have inserted below a post I put up on FaceBook last night and I have to say the response has been overwhelming! There is quite clearly an appetite to develop more of the schemes across TRNC.

"Following the successful launch of a recycling scheme in Karmi at the end of last year ASM Recycling Ltd came to the village yesterday to empty the cage of all the recyclable material that had been collected since the scheme was launched late last year.

The cage 4mx2mx2m, a bespoke design by Arman Metals, had been filled by the residents of the village (and other TRNC residents who wanted to participate in the scheme) who had diligently cleaned, crushed, and sorted the items into 4 different coloured bags.

The bags are filled as follows:

Blue bags: PET bottles e.g., milk, fizzy drink bottles, clear yoghurt pot lids. (recycling logo no. 1)

Yellow bags – HDPE, LDPE and PP e.g. detergent bottles, bleach bottles, shampoo and conditioner bottles, hard plastic cheese & ice

cream containers, some yoghurt pots and supermarket carrier bags. (Recycling logos 2, 4 and 5)

Green bags – aluminium drink cans e.g. Efes, Coca Cola.

Black bags - steel cans such as dog/cat food, tinned tomatoes, chickpeas, baked beans etc.

ASM Recycling Ltd, whose factory is based in Haspolat, shred or pelletise the plastics into a form that can be used in re-processing the material. 40% of this material will be used by manufacturers in TRNC who will produce products such as broom heads, buckets, and plastic chairs.

The cans and tins are crushed, baled and shipped to Turkey where they are made into different metal products e.g. bicycles, metal garden chairs.

The scheme is managed by the residents of Karmi but it is fully supported and sponsored by the KSVC, Karaman Özel Köy Komitesi.

This and the scheme at Çatalköy are the only schemes in TRNC where the material actually gets recycled and doesn't end up in landfill.

If anyone would like to join the scheme, then please do send me a PM and we can organise bags etc.
