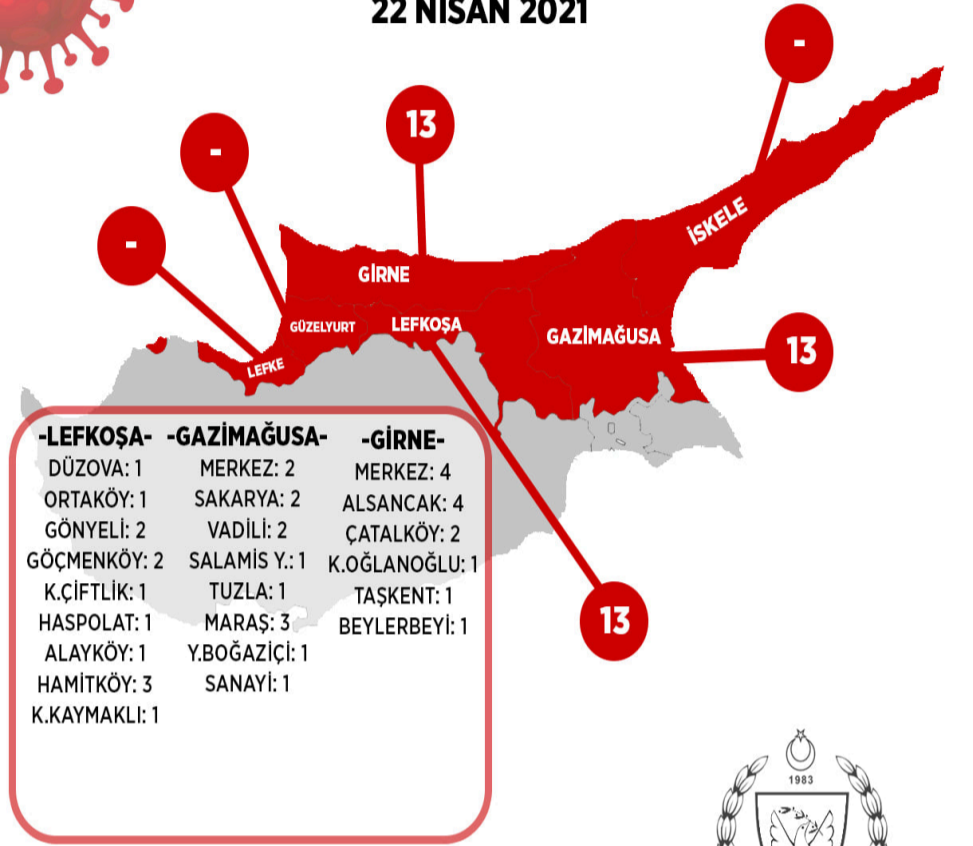

President Tatar to meet Erdoğan in Ankara on 26 April

President Ersin Tatar who headed the meeting of the Council of Ministers yesterday (21.04.2021) stated that he would go to Ankara and meet with Turkish President Erdoğan and he will have an opportunity to evaluate the issues to be put forward at the meeting in Geneva.

Tatar indicated that they will evaluate with Erdoğan the new policy that the Turkish Cypriot

side will put forward at the meeting in Geneva, that is, two states living side by side based on sovereign equality and that this is the only realistic way of solution as a result of all the research carried out for a solution.

Dana: “We will attend the 5+UN meeting with constructive attitude”

The Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus New York Representative Mehmet Dana evaluated the upcoming 5+1 informal meeting to be held in Geneva next week to the Anadolu News Agency.

Dana said that during the conference that will last for three

days the sides will see whether or not a common ground can be found in order to restart negotiations on the island. “As the Turkish Cypriot side we will take part in the meetings with a constructive attitude, with good intentions and new creative ideas”.

Stating that the informal 5+UN meeting had in fact been proposed by the Turkish side, Dana said that the format of the meeting had been decided to be informal in order to provide the necessary environment so that the parties can share their opinions freely and comfortably. “During this meeting we will explain to our collocutors, especially the Greek Cypriot side, why the new ground we have proposed is necessary for both sides of the island and why it is the most correct, realistic and effective basis for our region. We will try to convince them” and he expressed the hope that the Greek Cypriot side will not insist on formulas that have been tried and have failed all these years. Stating that the

Turkish Cypriot side supports a solution that will be found within the framework of sovereign equality and the equal international status of the two states, Dana said that if the sides act on this common basis then a permanent solution can be achieved on the island. Reminding that negotiations based on a federation have been continuing for over 50 years but have been unsuccessful, Dana said that they do not want to take part in a process in which the status quo on the island is maintained with open ended talks and an endless negotiation process.

Tatar: "New political consensus has been improved with Turkey"

President Ersin Tatar stated that a new political consensus has been improved with Turkey, a solution is no longer possible on the basis of a federation and noted that there is no hope with this conjuncture and understanding in the framework of an agreement.

Stating that an agreement might be possible based on sovereign equality, living side by side, separate, sovereign and independent states with cooperation and also permanent, comprehensive and sustainable agreement in Cyprus, President Tatar said that they developed this policy with Turkey in a consensus.

President Ersin Tatar and Turkish Foreign Minister Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu held a joint press conference.

Expressing pleasure for Çavuşoğlu's visit to the TRNC, Tatar said that the final touch has been done ahead of Geneva and added that new political development in Cyprus has been developed.

Drawing attention to the efforts, devotion, and sacrifice for an agreement on the basis of a federation for years, President Tatar reminded that this meeting process dates back to 1968.

Indicating that the process that started in 1968 between the Founding President Rauf Raif Denktaş and the Greek Cypriot Administration Leader Glafkos Klerides continued until 1974, after the Peace Operation, and the Cyprus Turkish Federated State established, and during the 1977-79 High-Level Agreements continued, Tatar pointed out that various meetings have been held on the basis of federalism adding that the negotiation process continued with the events experienced before the Annan Plan and after Annan Plan in recent years and the meetings carried out in Crans Montana in 2017.

President Tatar emphasised that in order to reach an agreement in Crans Montana with the Greek Cypriot side, the Turkish Cypriot side worked through 11 days of

meetings involving all kinds of goodwill indicators but no result was achieved, because of the stance of the Greek Cypriot side, which is known all over the world.

Stating that even though the two leaders were sitting at the negotiating table within the framework of the goodwill of the United Nations, President Tatar said that the Greek Cypriot side

continued on its way as the Republic of Cyprus when they left the table. President Tatar added:

"Unfortunately, we continue on our way in isolation and with restrictions."

The Turkish Cypriot short film "Delivery" entered the official selection of the "Columbus

International Film and Animation Festival", the oldest in the USA and the longest-running festival in North America.

"Delivery" directed by Doğuş Özokutan, succeeded to be one of the 16 finalist films in the international short film competition of the 69th festival which was held on 17-18 April this year.

Since its world premiere in November 2020, "Delivery" has entered the official selection of 10 international festivals and won the "Audience Award" from Italy.

This festival screening will be Delivery's third screening in the US and its second in the state of

Ohio. Delivery was recently shown at the 45th Cleveland International Film Festival in Ohio state.

The leading man of "Delivery", İzel Seylani, brings a different perspective to the refugee drama.

The film tells the story of a driver who believes that the only way to pay for his daughter's surgery is to transport a group of refugees in a refrigerated truck.

Ertuğruloğlu met Turkish Foreign Minister Çavuşoğlu

TRNC Foreign Minister Tahsin Ertuğruloğlu met with Turkish Foreign Minister Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu.

In the statements made to the press after the meeting, Ertuğruloğlu said:

“Either they, the Greek Cypriots will show the courage and stance to open a new page on Cyprus, or they will continue with their determination to continue their unfair policies towards the Turkish Cypriot people, and then it is revealed that the parties standing before us with the demand for agreement in Cyprus are not sincere in agreement”.

Regarding the 5+UN informal Cyprus meeting to be held in Geneva, Ertuğruloğlu reiterated that the meeting in Geneva has only one agenda, and that this is to reveal whether there is a common ground on which the parties can negotiate in the future.

Ertuğruloğlu said:

“If there is such a ground, a new negotiation process that has a chance of success and results can be brought to the agenda. If there isn't, this will be explained clearly and sincerely and as 53 years have been spent in vain, spending another 50-100 years for nothing will be prevented, adding that in such a situation a new process will start.

We have come to a stage where it will emerge whether the international community will give up its misdiagnosis stance on the Cyprus issue, which started in 1964," and he continued his speech as follows:

“The international community has to decide whether or not it will continue to discriminate against the Turkish Cypriot people unfairly. Either they will show the courage and stance to open a new page on the Cyprus issue, or they will continue with their determination to continue their unfair policies towards the Turkish Cypriot people, and then it will be revealed that the parties standing in front of us with the demand for agreement in Cyprus are not sincere in agreement.

If it is planned to create one legal Cyprus, it should be accepted first that there are two separate States in Cyprus. If there are two separate Cyprus states, only legal Cyprus can be on the agenda. No, there is only one Cyprus, its government is also legal, as long as it is a member of the EU and the UN, I would like to emphasise that once again, it should emerge that there is no chance for any reconciliation formula in Cyprus, no matter how many years it is negotiated. "

Ertuğruloğlu said,

"The Turkish Cypriots will continue on their way with the desire to achieve success in the national cause being given in the Eastern Mediterranean together with the motherland."

In his speech, Foreign Minister Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu stated that he has been in Cyprus to exchange views ahead of the 5+ UN informal meeting to be held in Geneva at the end of this month, the last meeting before going to Geneva will be held in Ankara and then they plan to go to Switzerland together.

Reminding that they had said in the past that they would no longer negotiate for a federation, Çavuşoğlu said,

“We stand behind this promise. Not a rigid attitude or stubbornness. We have negotiated a federation for 53 years, and Turkey and the TRNC has been in a very constructive approach for 53 years and shown good intentions but the Greek Cypriot side does not want to share anything with the Turkish Cypriot people and its supporter Greece has rejected all solutions of either a referendum or at the table”.

Çavuşoğlu said that the Greek Cypriot side was rewarded as a result of the negotiations that lasted for 53 years and that the Turkish Cypriot people were punished. “We no longer have to tolerate this”

Stating that they also discussed what they can do regarding how they make the TRNC missions more active, Çavuşoğlu said:

"The Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus has a different status in some regional and international organisations, and we have evaluated the participation of some other organisations, especially the Turkish Council, in their activities today and we will continue to work in a coordinated manner on these issues”.

The "Crate" Escape

I am sure most of us have watched "The Great Escape", where Steve McQueen made it out of the German prison camp, against all odds, during the second world war. Even those who have not watched it, I am sure, will have heard of this world class movie.

The reason why "The Great Escape" came to my mind, is that recently I came across a real life drama, where a young Welshman had posted himself from Australia to London, in a "wooden crate", as a cargo. The event took place way back in 1965, where 19 year old Brian Robson, a Welshman, travelled as "cargo", inside a small wooden box.

In short, the boy had gone to Australia to work there under a sponsored scheme of the Australian government, but he did not like the work and residential environment, so he had decided to go back home. However, under the scheme, he would have to pay back to the Australian government, all the expenses paid. Unfortunately he did not have sufficient money to pay. So he found the way to go back home without paying all this.

He came up with the idea of locking himself inside a wooden crate to be sent as cargo with the help of his two friends, who nailed the crate and handed it over to the couriers. However, due to some problems, he was loaded on a Pan-Am flight for USA, instead of London via Qantas. It took him five terrible days, locked inside a wooden crate, to reach Los Angeles.

The story is a hit recently on social and in print media as, at the age of 75, Brian Robson is searching for his two friends in Australia who had nailed his "crate" and taken it to the cargo office.

Reading all details of this adventure, I really feel very thrilled, thinking how a young boy could constantly keep his legs stuck up to his chest, inside a wooden box 30 x 26 x 38 for such a long period of time. I simply cannot even think of what might have passed through his mind, during such a long period of time, all locked up in the dark.

Not only just that, as mentioned in a report, at first his crate was put upside down while waiting to be loaded in the plane. It's really difficult to comprehend how did a

teenager bear all this ordeal for such a long period of time.

I wonder what his two friends in Australia had thought after handing over their friend at Melbourne airport, inside the wooden crate. Interestingly, putting myself in place of them, I think that under those particular circumstances, even if they might have received the news that their friend was put in the cargo section of the Pan Am flight bound for Los Angeles, they would have found themselves unable to do anything at all. But the interesting point is that those two friends perhaps

never heard of their friend becoming a scoop in the American and British press.

What I understand from all this is that there are some situations where one person takes unorthodox sorts of decisions, and takes all risks, just to achieve the set goal. Indeed the young boy had taken a great risk. If not he and his next generation would have perhaps now been living in Australia, for over half a century. But if that was the case, we would not be having the story of "The Crate Escape".

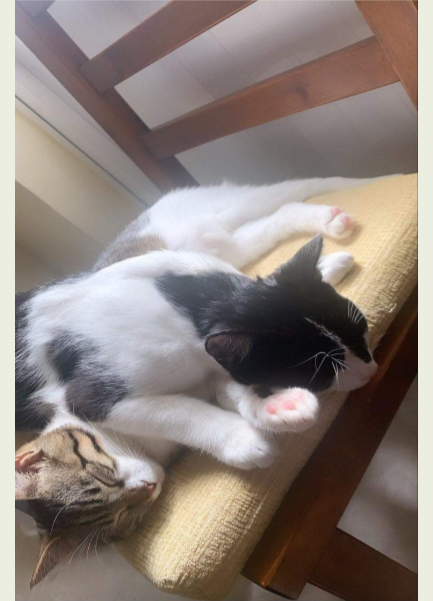

Tourism Workers Initiative visit Minister Fikri Ataoğlu

Fikri Ataoğlu, Minister of Tourism and Environment, received and met the Chairman and members of the Board of Directors of the Tourism Workers Initiative.

It was stated that the Board of Tourism Workers Initiative, headed by Chairman Fuat Neşe, made this visit to thank the Minister of Tourism and Environment, Fikri Ataoğlu, for his sincere interest and well-intentioned approach to tourism workers.

Tourism and Environment Minister Fikri Ataoğlu, receiving the Chairman and members of the Tourism Workers Initiative, stated that tourism is one of the most affected sectors in the country due to the pandemic, so it is a fact that tourism workers have experienced a very difficult process.

Minister Ataoğlu stated that they decided to start with the closed circuit tourism model, which is the first step of the tourism initiative, without ignoring public health, and with this decision they aimed that some of the tourism workers who have not been able to work for more than 1 year and were in a difficult situation will now have the opportunity to work.

Tourism and Environment Minister Fikri Ataoğlu pointed out that their goals are the tourism initiative they plan to implement for May and June, taking into account the pandemic conditions in the country and the point the country has reached in vaccination, and in order for this to be successful, the management and employees of the hotels included in the closed circuit tourism model, will be able to fully comply with the specified criteria.

Fuat Neşe, Chairman of Tourism Workers Initiative, also thanked Minister Ataoğlu for his sincere effort and well-intentioned approach on behalf of tourism workers and said, "Only the Minister of Tourism Fikri Ataoğlu has protected us" and added that as tourism employees, they are ready to contribute to the tourism initiative that Tourism

Minister Fikri Ataoğlu targets for May and June, included in the closed circuit tourism model. He stated that they will demonstrate all the supervision and support required for hotel staff to comply with the criteria.

Girne Food Inspections and Covid-19 Control Inspections - April

During the official controls carried out by Girne Municipality, between the dates of 08 - 20 April 2021, a total of 273 enterprises were inspected for Hygiene and Covid-19 Measures, 2 workplaces were sealed on the grounds that they did not work in accordance with the Covid Measures, 2 workplaces were sealed that did not fulfill their obligations related to the legal legislation, 1 workplace was fined for not working in accordance with Covid measures.

In the information received from Girne Municipality, it was stated that a total of 273 workplaces were inspected in the audits carried out by the Girne Municipality Health Branch and (Zabita) Police City Security Unit teams between 08 April and 20 April 2021.

Girne Municipality continues to monitor the commercial service businesses with the official controls regarding the general Covid

measures published within the framework of the decisions of the Council of Ministers and to share the results of these controls with the public, as the Covid-19 Pandemic continues to affect the whole world.

Within the scope of the general workplace controls, where the night raid inspections were also continued, 25 workplaces were notified for their deficiencies, 1 workplace was fined and sealed for working out of working hours due to Covid precautions, while a workplace was sealed for failing to renew the PCR tests. In addition, it was stated that the sales in the Girne Municipality Open Market, which is held every Wednesday, were carried out within the framework of the Covid-19 Pandemic measures, and it was stated that the Health and (Zabita) Police teams took part in the control of both the sales conditions of the sellers and the Covid measures during the purchases of the citizens.

Girne Mayor Nidai Güngördü said: "Official controls, which are vital in pandemic management, have been

carried out uninterruptedly since the first day of the pandemic. Our aim in these controls is to control the elements that may be contamination risk for human health and to protect the health and safety of both tradesmen and all citizens. In addition to the continuation of daily life, it is imperative that all of us actively contribute to this process in order to maintain economic dynamism. It is for not closing once again in these difficult days we live. In order to keep the number of cases under control and to alleviate the burden of our healthcare professionals, it is essential that masks, social distance and hygiene rules are fulfilled by each individual. Since commercial enterprises have more responsibility, all necessary precautions should be taken. Criminal sanctions will continue to be imposed on businesses that do not work in accordance with the rules in order to prevent the sectors from closing."

BRS News : COVID-19 Regulations and news updates

We are sharing for readers who are seeking the latest facts and information news recently provided by the British Residents' Society to their members.

REGULATION CHANGES – 19TH TO 26TH APRIL

CURFEW BROUGHT FORWARD TO 9pm.

The curfew will be continued, except for meeting essential needs, between the hours of 21:00 and 05:00 from Monday to Saturday, and from 21:00 on Saturday to 05:00 on Monday.

Markets will be open between 07:00 and 20:00.

Retail and merchandising services, restaurants and all services/sectors that are not specified as closed will serve between 10:00 and 20:00 (Monday – Friday).

SATURDAYS

** It has been decided that restaurants, cafes, patisseries, taverns, barbers, hairdressers, tattoo parlours, coffee shops, coffee houses, cafeterias, betting shops, clubs, indoor sports halls (fitness), retail and merchandising services and all services/sectors not specified as closed can serve until 18:00.

** It has been decided that if cases increase at the same rate until April 21, 2021, the above sectors will be closed on Saturdays and restaurants, cafes, patisseries, and taverns will only provide a takeaway service.

SUNDAYS

** All businesses and activities will be closed on Sundays, except for

pharmacies, bakeries, petrol stations, and agriculture and animal husbandry, and related industrial enterprises and activities.

Other regulations continue unchanged at present.

HOME QUARANTINE

As we have received numerous questions regarding different aspects of the introduction of the new Home Quarantine system we have requested clarification from the Health Ministry but as yet have not received the answers!

Once we receive any further information we will circulate this to you.

PCR TESTS FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

There are some changes to PCR tests which are required for international travel. Results will no longer be emailed to the individual but must be collected from the test centre as they are required to be signed and stamped.

Recent examples show the Near East Hospital at Karakum are charging 120tl per test.

VACCINATION PROGRAM

We are aware from members information that the vaccination has been resumed using the online registration system.

The Ministry of Health has released the following most frequently asked questions and answers in relation to the current vaccination program.

Frequently asked Questions and Answers

Q - Can I change the brand of vaccine given to me with the brand I want?

A - People who do not go to their appointment because they do not want the vaccine brand will be given a new appointment when the new vaccine is available. But the waiting time for this is not clear.

Q - What can people who miss their appointment and who cannot go?

A - People who cannot go on the day of the appointment due to illness or any reason can call the call centre and change their appointment date to the appropriate day.

Q - How will patients with serious chronic diseases be vaccinated?

A - Vaccination of people aged 55 and over with serious chronic diseases continues in line with their application to the website asbilgisistemi.com. People under the age of 55 with serious chronic diseases can be vaccinated after completion. Vaccination appointments will be notified by SMS message in line with the appointment requests they have made through the vaccine information system. Individuals with chronic diseases do not need to come to the ministry of health

and bring a document.

Q - Should people who have had Covid-19 disease be vaccinated?

A - Healthcare workers can make vaccination appointment requests from the vaccine information system for an appointment after one-month, other people 3 to 6 months after they have had the disease.

Q - Could be vaccinated at the same time as my wife?

A - An appointment will be given to each individual according to the age criteria and severe chronic disease application. It is not possible to request an appointment from the spouse status.

Q - Can people aged 60-65 and over, who are not citizens and who do not have a residence permit, be vaccinated?

A - If these people have stayed here for more than three months because they are in the high-risk group and cannot return to their country, they can apply for vaccination via asbilgisistemi.com.

Q - If I go abroad, can I get vaccinated immediately?

A - Vaccinations are made according to age criteria.

Q - I have had my first vaccination abroad. Can I have my second vaccination here?

A - The person can make an appointment with the Covid vaccination counselling centre in order to have the 2nd dose vaccine here if there is a mandatory situation that requires the person to present the vaccination card and to be here on the second vaccination date (05469901313).

Q - Is it inconvenient to get vaccinated because of my chronic diseases?

A - If your doctor has indicated that it is okay for you to be vaccinated, you can apply for a vaccination appointment.

Q - Is it compulsory to be vaccinated, what if I am not?

A - It is not necessary to be vaccinated, but it is important that people who are vaccinated are vaccinated in order to stop the spread of the disease in the society.

Q - Are the vaccines used in the vaccination program safe?

A - Ensuring the safety and quality of vaccines is one of the highest priorities of the World Health Organization (WHO). WHO works closely with national authorities to ensure the development and implementation of global norms and standards to evaluate the quality, safety and efficacy of vaccines.

The process of developing COVID vaccines is quickly monitored while maintaining the highest standards: countries do not permit use until COVID-19 vaccines are proven to be safe and effective.

There are many strict protection measures to help ensure that COVID-19 vaccines are safe.

Like all vaccines, COVID-19 vaccines go through a rigorous, multi-step testing process, including large (phase III) trials involving tens of thousands of people. These trials, which included certain groups at high risk for COVID-19 (certain groups such as pregnant and breastfeeding women were not included in vaccine trials), were specifically designed to identify any common side effects or other safety concerns.

When a clinical trial shows that a COVID-19 vaccine is safe and effective, WHO conducts a series of independent reviews of efficacy and safety evidence, including regulatory review and approval in the country where the vaccine was produced for prequalification, before evaluating a vaccine product. Part of this process includes a review of all safety evidence made by the Global Vaccine Safety Advisory Committee. A team of external experts gathered by WHO collectively analyses results from clinical trials, together with evidence regarding the disease,

affected age groups, risk factors for the disease, and other information. This team determines whether and how vaccines should be used.

Authorities in countries decide whether vaccines will be approved for national use and develop policies on how vaccines will be used in their home country according to WHO recommendations.

Once a COVID-19 vaccine is in place, WHO supports working with vaccine manufacturers, health authorities in each country and other partners to continuously monitor any safety concerns. In this sense, the undesirable effects after the notified vaccine are meticulously evaluated and stopped if any side effects that require the vaccine to be stopped are detected.

IMMIGRATION OFFICES AT MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR CLOSED

Due to a positive-19 News round-up-test of an employee of the Ministry of the Interior ALL of its offices in Lefkosa are closed until further notice.

We will make an announcement once they reopen.

If you have made an appointment to attend the Immigration Department or the PTP office this week, we advise you to re-apply using the online system for another appointment next week.

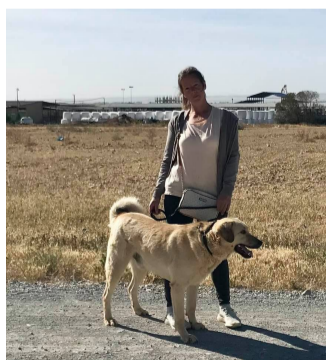
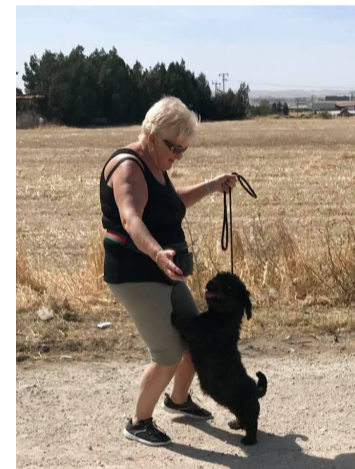


