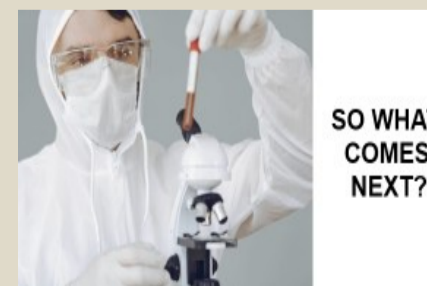

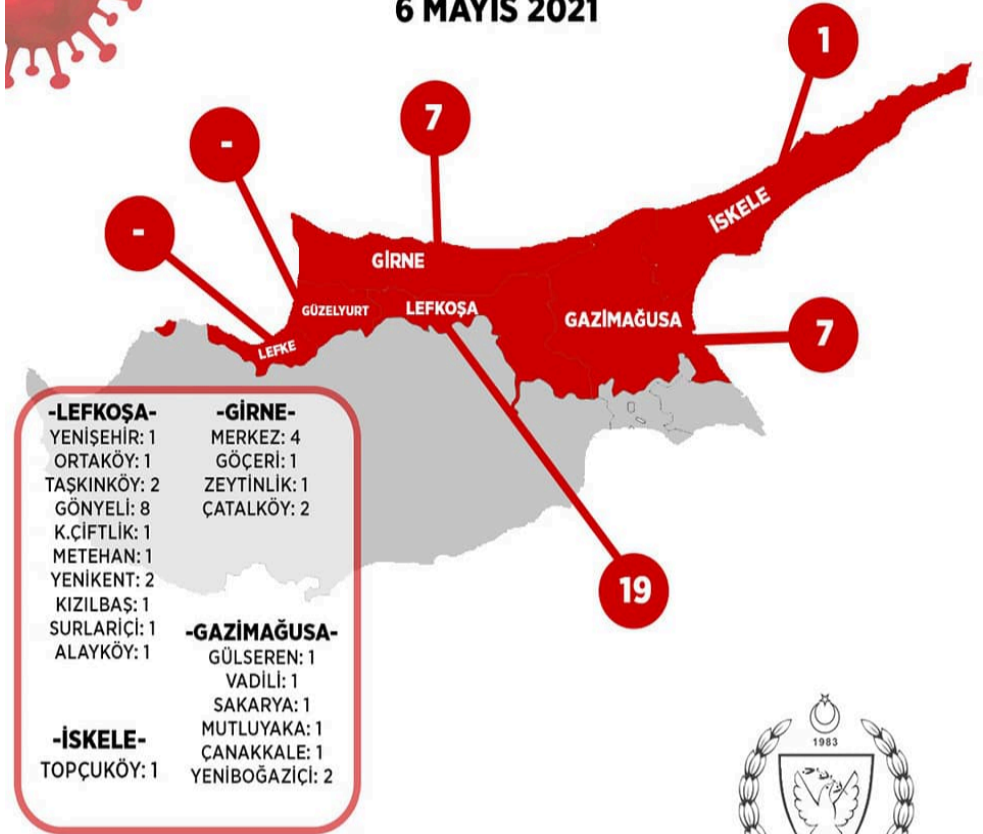

## Stephen: Best way to solve Cyprus problem is a two-state solution

British politician and lawyer Michael Stephen stated about the 5+1 conference on Cyprus, held in Geneva, organised under the auspices of the United Nations (UN) with the participation of the Cypriot parties and the guarantor countries, that "The TRNC and Turkey have no one to rely on and the best option to solve the Cyprus problem is a two-state solution."

Former MP from the British Conservative Party, Stephen, made evaluations regarding the Cyprus problem at an online meeting organised by the British Turkish Cypriot Association (BTCA).

Stephen said that he had been working with the "Turkish Cypriot Community" when he was a member of parliament when the international community saw the Greek Cypriots as "victims" at that time, but he discovered that the Turkish Cypriots were subjected to "genocide".

Stating that the Greek Cypriot

politicians in the 1960s pursued the policy of "establishing Greek Cypriot domination in Cyprus" or "uniting Cyprus with Greece" and that today's Greek Cypriot politicians also have the same dreams, Stephen said: "Until they get this idea out of their minds, it is not possible to reach a solution acceptable for both Turkish Cypriots and Greek Cypriots."

Stephen said that international actors are part of the Cyprus problem, and that the UN and the European Union (EU) recognise and legitimise the Greek Cypriots as the sovereign government of the island.

He also pointed out that the EU had acted unlawfully by allowing the Greek Cypriot side to join the bloc as a single unit without the consent and approval of Turkey or the Turkish Cypriots.

The former British MP noted that the UK could not take a decision towards recognising the TRNC so

as not to endanger its sovereign bases on the island which are also being used by the US.

He added that Britain was trying to maintain the status quo, to dissuade the Turkish Cypriot side from a two-state solution and convince the two sides to accept a solution plan similar to the Annan Plan. "Britain is ready to sacrifice its human rights and legal obligations to protect its bases on the island and instead focus on its strategic value" Stephen said.

Stating that "a powerful country like China can recognise the TRNC", Stephen said that Bangladesh had previously recognised the TRNC but withdrew this decision due to pressures, and that the problem could change with the recognition of the TRNC by a few Muslim-majority countries, Turkey should use its military and regional power to exert pressure over these countries for the recognition of the TRNC.

## Foreign Minister Ertuğruloğlu gave interview to "Bayraqdar.info"

Foreign Minister Tahsin Ertuğruloğlu gave an interview to "Bayraqdar.info" published online in Azerbaijan and evaluated the latest stage reached regarding the Cyprus problem.

Stating that the 5+UN informal meeting held in Geneva was an "historical turning point" in the 58-year Cyprus issue, Foreign Minister Ertuğruloğlu said "The two-state solution model based on sovereign equality put forward by the Turkish Cypriot side with the support of homeland Turkey has been put on the record".

Minister Ertuğruloğlu said, "This is the TRNC's struggle for independence and sovereignty."

Stating that the UN Secretary-General examined whether there is a common ground between the parties in Cyprus at the informal meeting in Geneva but, as a result, a common ground could not be found to initiate a new negotiation process, Ertuğruloğlu said that the UN Secretary-General expressed that he needs a few more months to continue the process.

Furthermore, expressing that the TRNC supports the decision of the UN Secretary-General, Ertuğruloğlu stated that their expectations regarding the outcome of the meeting was "in this direction."

Responding to a question regarding what the roadmap will be in the next period, Ertuğruloğlu emphasised that as long as the inequality the Turkish Cypriot people have been subjected to for years continues, it is impossible to find a common ground".

Minister Ertuğruloğlu stressed "The essence of the Cyprus issue is of status, it is not possible to come to a conclusion as long as one side is treated as the state and the other as a society. I would like to emphasise that equal international status and sovereign equality are our red line. They are our basic principles, not elements to be negotiated".

Ertuğruloğlu emphasised that "if a common ground is found on this basis, negotiations can start, or otherwise, we will continue in our

own way".

Indicating that they, as the Turkish Cypriot side, attended the 5+UN informal meeting in good faith and made constructive suggestions, Ertuğruloğlu said that "they can see that the Greek Cypriot side continues its obsolete views that have interrupted the negotiation processes carried out so far".

Pointing out that the UN Secretary-General is planning to hold another informal meeting within 2-3 months, Ertuğruloğlu stressed that they do not accept the continuation of open-ended informal talks.

Stating that they, as the Turkish Cypriot side, will attend the meeting with the same good intentions in order to give the process another chance, and if the Greek Cypriot side looks positively to the cooperation-based proposals, an agreement can be reached that will help the regional peace and stability, Ertuğruloğlu said that if the Greek Cypriot side continues to maintain its uncompromising attitude, the TRNC will put the recognition policy on the agenda with the support of the motherland".

in Cyprus, Akar said "We imply peace, tranquillity, dialogue and good neighbourhood relations.

On the other hand, unfortunately, Greece always uses the language of provocation, crisis, disrespect and threatening behaviour".

## Ertuğruloğlu: “53 years have been wasted”

TRNC Foreign Minister Tahsin Ertuğruloğlu evaluated the 5+UN informal meeting held in Geneva to the Milliyet newspaper in Turkey.

Ertuğruloğlu said “We claimed our honour, state, sovereignty and freedom in Geneva. We continued our struggle by presenting once again that we will never give up the full and effective presence of the Turkish military.

We knew what the Greek Cypriot side would say, they didn't surprise us. What needs to be criticised is the Cyprus policy of the international community.

53 years have been stolen and wasted. They locked us in a process that had no chance of success. We took part in all processes by showing good

intentions. We also responded positively to every proposal which had a possibility for an agreement. However, the Greek Cypriot side never paid the price despite the intransigence exhibited for years, on the contrary they were rewarded. We did not put forward an attitude of intransigence. We demand our rights”.

Stating that the UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres intends to hold a further 5+1 meeting in 2-3 months, Ertuğruloğlu continued, “We, as the Turkish Cypriot side, are not against this. It was the Greek Cypriot side who refused this and set the condition. They declared that ‘if the Turkish Cypriot side makes a new move regarding Maraş and hydrocarbon research in the sea, they will not participate in the 5+1 meetings again’. They once again showed the

uncompromising attitude of a side that has been pampered for years. The decision of whether to call or not for a meeting belongs to the UN Secretary General. If he calls, we will be there, but we are not going to deviate from the position we put forward in Geneva.”

Ertuğruloğlu stated that TRNC want to become a state demanding recognition and said “If it is refused, we are determined to take steps by

ourselves for recognition. What we demand from the UN Security Council is to ensure the equal international status of the sides. The EU also gets involved in the issue in this way. We cannot continue from where we left off, the period for a federation is over. There is not any other alternative than to turn a new page”.

## Tatar: Anastasiades should look in the mirror to see arrogance

TRNC President Ersin Tatar criticised the Greek Cypriot leader Nikos Anastasiades for his latest remarks against the Turkish Cypriot side and Turkey in his Easter message.

In a written statement, Tatar said that the Greek Cypriot Administration was carrying out a propaganda campaign aimed at spreading lies and false claims.

According to the information given

by the TRNC Presidency, President Tatar's statement is as follows:

“While our proposal for a solution based on the cooperation of two equal sovereign states, which we presented at the 5+UN informal meeting held in Geneva on 27-29 April, created great reactions, the Greek Cypriot side is trying to deceive the world public opinion by conducting a black propaganda based on lies and slander. We experienced the last example of

this in the Easter message published by Anastasiades, the leader of the Greek Cypriot Administration.

Anastasiades spilling out hatred and grudge even in a religious message is another issue that should be evaluated.

While Anastasiades called out to the Turkish Cypriot people by saying 'my citizens' in his message, he once again revealed his anachronistic and dominant mentality and showed his arrogance by insulting our people by saying 'our citizens'. The World and Anastasiades should know that Turkish Cypriots are not the minority and citizens of the Greek Cypriot side, they are the citizens of a free and sovereign Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus.

Anastasiades, who insulted our people, called the Greek Cypriot people, their allies and their extensions to fight together and showed the TRNC and Turkey as a target, and it once again revealed how far he is from dialogue and compromise.

In Geneva, we, as the Turkish Cypriot side, demanded respect for equal status and sovereignty as an acquired right, however Anastasiades, who says that he defends Cyprus Hellenism and praises the terrorist organization EOKA, suggested that we should join the 'Republic of Cyprus', which turned into a Greek Cypriot state, as a minority with privileged rights. If there is impudence, this is it.

My reply to the EU that Anastasiades called for duty against the Turkish Cypriot side is; fulfilling the promises made to the Turkish Cypriot people in the Annan Plan referendum and abandoning its pro-Greek Cypriot stance. Because this attitude of the EU encourages the Greek Cypriot intransigence and does not serve the solution efforts.

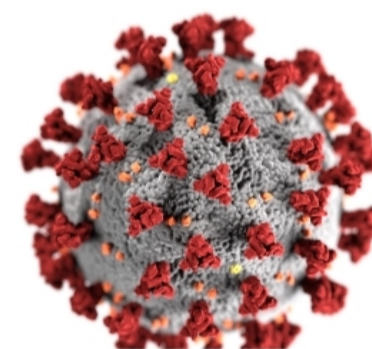

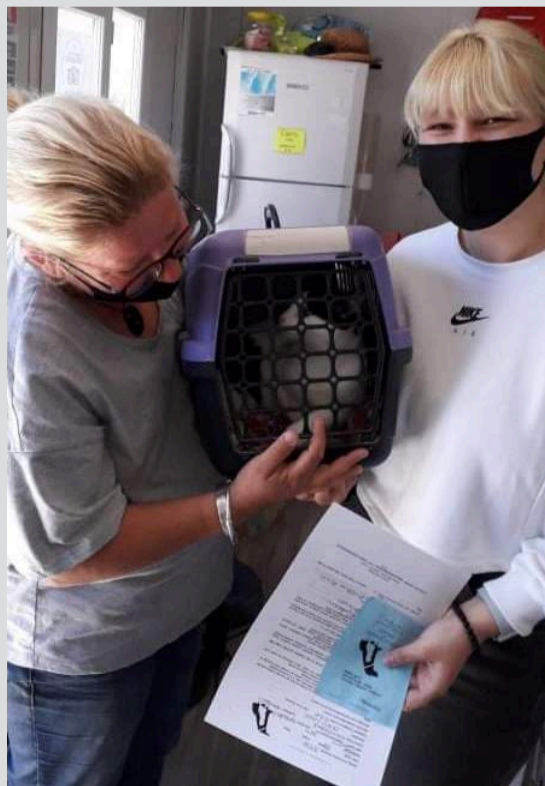


**Arlo** is looking for his forever home.

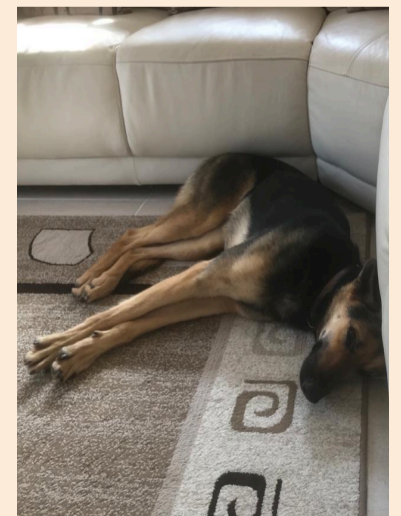

## Girne Municipality continued street cleaning work in April

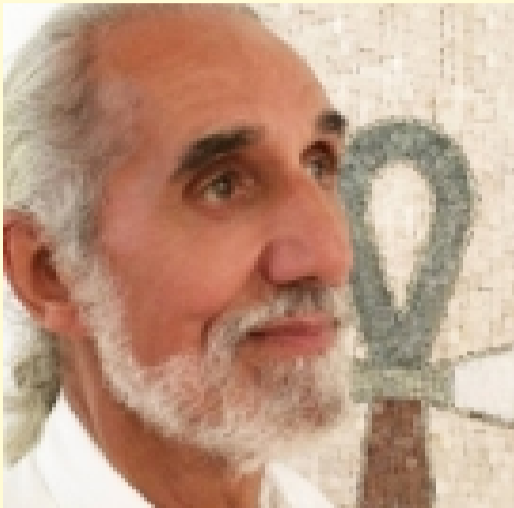

## Why the 5+UN Meeting in Geneva failed

The 5+UN scheduled informal meeting had hoped issues between Greeks and Turks over Cyprus could be resolved.

The UN showed up at the meeting without any proposal. Secretary-General Guterres asked the parties to be "creative." After some 53 years that was the best he could do.

The role of the UN should be neutral and not favour one side over the other. The UN should attempt to facilitate compromise and agreement. Here is what really happened.

The UN empowered the Greeks before the meeting by saying the UN was supporting the Greek position. So the Turks had no leverage against the resistance of the Greeks to make progress. The playing field was not level.

The UN could have pressured the Greeks privately to negotiate by telling them the UN will recommend ending the embargo on the TRNC if an agreement was not reached. Unfortunately, the UN is a partner with the Greeks rather than interested in human rights.

So the UN failed, again, after Crans Montana. The UN has demonstrated its ignorance of how to negotiate. Events show that the TRNC has no reason to deal further with the UN or Greek politicians.

Fundamental to progress is understanding that the Greek politicians do not represent the will of the Greek Cypriot people. The Greek Cypriot people want peace and prosperity. They do not want this constant bickering and posturing that does not contribute to the Greek Cypriot standard of living. Public protests before the 5+UN meeting are evidence.

The Turks arrived at the meeting with

a statement that had been repeated over and over during the past weeks. There was nothing new. Foreign Minister Ertugruloglu said, "We knew what the Greek Cypriot side would say, they didn't surprise us." Then what was the TRNC plan? Did the TRNC have a plan to break the impasse?

The Greeks did not have to do anything, and they didn't. The Greek politicians only will accept the Turks moving off the island, and nothing less. Their game plan is to starve the Turkish Cypriots with the UN-supported embargo

The Greek politicians won this round of the diplomatic battle by default. However, the Greek Cypriot people lost also. The Turkish Cypriots can deliver many benefits to the Greek Cypriot people that the Greek Cypriot politicians cannot deliver – even if they were so motivated.

What are the benefits? First, high paying jobs for Greek Cypriots. Second, restoration of Cypriot culture.

Turkish Cypriot banks can establish confidential investment bank accounts like Switzerland for wealthy people around the world who want to escape excessive taxation. Investors will not trust the Greek Cypriot banks after their investment in worthless Greek sovereign debt. Also, since the TRNC has been isolated from the world, the TRNC is not a party to any agreements preventing such investment accounts.

The money invested should then be used to build facilities to receive and store imported natural gas. Then facilities should be constructed to convert the gas to higher value products like synthetics, plastics, fertilizer, cosmetics and more. Many jobs would be created. The TRNC should declare that 50% of the jobs will be offered to Greek Cypriots and 50% to Turkish Cypriots. Hopefully, public pressure would open the door to building some of those facilities in Greek Cyprus.

When people work together to achieve shared objectives, they become friends and partners. That is the road to peace. No one on Cyprus wants peace and prosperity more than the Archbishop. He is the Shepherd. The President of Greek Cyprus, a politician, received less than 50% of the votes but became President in a fractured political system. The politician does not enjoy the support and reverence of the Archbishop.

So many jobs in construction and operation of these new facilities will be created that Cyprus will have to export some of the work. For example, when natural gas is used to make a synthetic fiber, that fiber has to be woven into a fabric, then dyed, cut, sewn, and more to deliver the final product to the world markets. Those additional jobs can be in Greece and Turkey. The Greek and Turkish people would be coming together to serve their personal interests and not the objectives of the politicians.

No one is better qualified to address Cypriot culture than the Archbishop. The rich history of Cyprus should be restored where possible. So as examples, the Apostolos Andreas Monastery should be returned to the Archbishop and opened for the public to visit. A new Lela Mustafa Pasha Mosque should be built conforming to the requirements of the Muslim faith, and the old building offered to the Archbishop for all Christians as the St. Nicholas Cathedral. Historical sites all over Cyprus should be restored, and the Greek Orthodox churches in Maras opened under the supervision of the

Archbishop. There are over 1000 Greek Cypriot parishes in the US and a Greek-American organization called the Leadership 100 which would finance this cause of peace. Cypriots would show the world how to achieve lasting peace and prosperity.

The TRNC working with the Archbishop can offer the Greek and Turkish Cypriot people a better life. The Greek Cypriot politicians have denied this future to the people they are supposed to represent. For the Cypriot people to take the trip on the road to peace, the leadership of the TRNC and Archbishop must meet to create an agenda. All Cypriots can be partners in this great decision by contacting the President of the TRNC and the Archbishop.

### Editor's Note :

Roger L Jennings is the third generation of the USA Jennings family who had been involved in helping Turkey/Greece.

His grandfather Asa K. Jennings was credited by the Ecumenical Patriarch with saving 1,250,000 people in 1922-23, and is the highest decorated person in Greek history. He also advised Ataturk, and that led to many of the modernizations like the emancipation of women in Turkey.

His father Asa W. Jennings provided shiploads of arms to Turkey in 1940 after Greece was attacked. The Nazi military then decided not to attack an armed Turkey to get to Suez and the oil fields.

## Girne Food Hygiene and Covid-19 Controls 21st April - 4th May

During the official controls made by Girne Municipality, between the dates of 21st April - 4th May 2021, a total of 255 enterprises were inspected for food hygiene, general hygiene and Covid-19 Pandemic Measures.

Girne Municipality stated, that a restaurant that does not comply with the legal regulations and operates under conditions that are not suitable for food hygiene, by not implementing Covid pandemic measures, will be closed for a total of 2 working days. It was stated that while notices were given to 6 workplaces with technical deficiencies in working conditions and deficiencies regarding legal legislation, fines were imposed on 2 workplaces that did not work in accordance with Covid measures and 2 food businesses with inadequate hygiene conditions.

In the information received from the Girne Municipality, it was stated that a total of 255 workplaces were inspected by the Girne Municipality Health Branch and Police (Zabita) City Security Unit teams between 21st April and 4th May 2021.

Girne Municipality continues to monitor the commercial service businesses with the official controls regarding the general Covid measures published within the framework of the decisions of the Council of Ministers and shares the results of these controls with the public, as the Covid-19 Pandemic continues to affect the whole world.

While it was stated that emphasis was placed on night inspections, 32 workplaces were notified for their deficiencies within the scope of general workplace controls, 2

workplaces were fined for failing to comply with Covid measures due to inadequate food hygiene measures. During the food inspections carried out for the protection of human health, a restaurant operating under conditions against human health and a cafe business that did not operate in accordance with the legal legislation were closed and sealed. Various products that did not have a date label were seized during the inspections at restaurants.

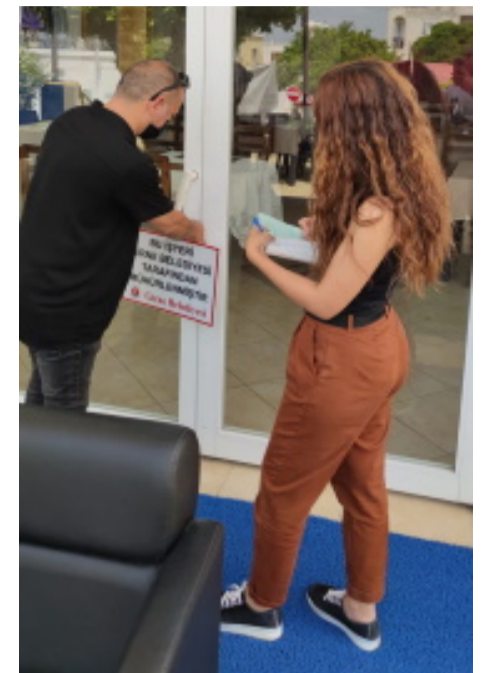
In addition, the officials stated that the sales in the Girne Municipality Open Market, which is held every Wednesday, are also under the scope of the Covid-19 Pandemic measures, and that the Health and Police teams are involved in the control of the sales conditions of the sellers and the Covid measures during the purchases of the citizens.

Girne Mayor Nidai Güngördü said: "Nowadays when we feel the effect of warmer weather, we observe that human mobility and socialisation are increasing in businesses across our city. This situation is positive for the vitality of our economy but it creates a risk in terms of Covid-19 transmission. As the Municipality, we continuously carry out the legal inspections of the enterprises to ensure pandemic measures are being implemented.

It is important to continue with protection by using masks, personal social distance and hand hygiene for our valuable people. It is possible to manage these difficult processes. For this, we need good cooperation with our people, tradesmen, and local administrators. In addition to the

continuation of daily life, it is imperative that all of us actively contribute to this process in order to maintain economic dynamism. Since commercial enterprises have more responsibility, all necessary precautions should be taken. Criminal sanctions will continue to be imposed on businesses that do not work in accordance with the rules in order to prevent the sectors from closing."

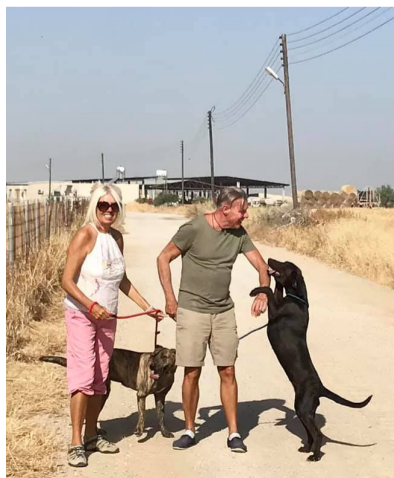
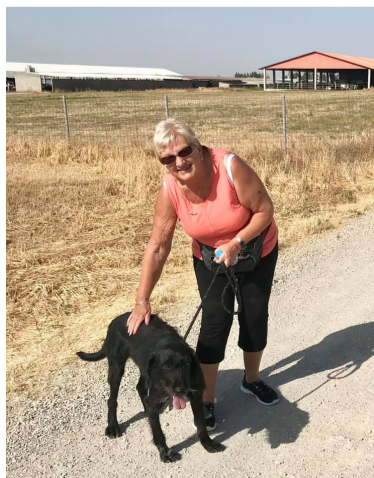
