Additional Entry Restrictions To Indoor Areas - 29th August 2021

As can be seen from the attached graphic the Government has now introduced the ADAPASS scheme in Lefkosa from Friday 27th August and plans to roll the requirements out to other Districts in the coming days.

These measures are for INDOOR activity and the most common of these will be allowed for those members who are vaccinated or who have recovered from the

virus. Others will require a PCR/Antigen test for the appropriate period prior for entering an indoor venue, and this will include Supermarkets.

If, for the time being you have not been able to obtain your ADAPASS record then the advice is to carry your vaccination cards and passports to gain entry.

As we receive additional information we will circulate it immediately.

Ertuğruloğlu condemns statement of US Senator Menendez

STATEMENT OF H.E. MR. TAHSİN ERTUĞRULOĞLU, MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS

We strongly condemn the US Senator Bob Menendez's statement dated 30 August 2021, regarding his goal "to see the last Turkish soldier leave the island" during his speech at the ceremony where he was awarded "the Grand Cross of the Order of Makarios III" by the Greek Cypriot administration of Southern Cyprus. Being sponsor for many resolutions at the US Senate against Motherland Turkey and TRNC and notorious for his anti-Turkish sentiment, Senator Menendez's remarks uttered with the sole aim of paying the debt of having been elected with the support of the Greek-Greek Cypriot associations in the USA, are null and void for the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus.

Supporting the Greek-Greek Cypriot duo in return for personal gain, Menendez harms the relations between Turkey and the USA. Similarly, Menendez, undermines efforts to restore security and stability both in the Island and the region.

We remind Menendez that the Turkish army intervened in the island to prevent the annihilation of the Turkish Cypriot people, who were subjected to all kinds of inhuman treatment, including mass murder, by the Greek Cypriot side, especially between 1963 and 1974. It is an undeniable fact that the Republic of Turkey intervened by using its rights and obligations stemming from the 1960 Treaty of Guarantee. We emphasise that the Turkish Armed Forces, the sole guarantor for the security for the Turkish Cypriot people, are on the island upon the request of the

Turkish Cypriot people in order to prevent the repetition of past sufferings.

Demanding the withdrawal of the Turkish Armed Forces, which has been maintaining peace and security prevailing on the Island since 1974, means nothing but dragging the Island back to war and opening the door for Greek

Cypriot brutality. Only losers like Menendez, who have no idea on the Cyprus issue and try to conceal their ignorance with anti-Turkish sentiment, can ask its withdrawal from the Island. Neither him nor his words have any value.

BRS News: Returning to the TRNC and ADAPass requirement

We are sharing for readers who are seeking the latest facts and information with the approval of the BRS, news recently provided by the British Residents' Society to their members.

RETURNING TO THE TRNC – ADAPASS REQUIREMENT

As of 6th September 2021, people who enter the TRNC by air/sea routes and from outside the island using land border crossings will need to visit the following link (adapass.gov.ct.tr) and apply for an adapass before leaving the TRNC. (you cannot access this website from outside the TRNC)

On your return to the TRNC you MUST show your Adapass QR code, as well as adhering to the

country entry criteria (negative PCR test result for the last 72 hours before the trip).

People who do not add their information to this site and do not receive an OR code will not enter our country

When you log into the site you need to click on the 'Get AdaPass Code'. This will take you to the registration page. Once completed you will be provided with an SMS 6-digit verification code which you enter into the box, then you will receive the QR code and AdaPass. You can then save this as a PDF file. See the website for a FULL explanation of the process.

If your Vaccination Certificate is from the UK, you need to make

sure you have this in your possession when entering the TRNC. The documents will be checked upon arrival, so people must bring them with them.

Citizens of other countries are required to include valid vaccination cards and/or PCR test results in the section specified in the application.

This application is mandatory for ages 18 and over.

PCR/ANTIGEN TESTING

There appears to be a problem with certain clinics who have previously offered these tests Free of Charge. Apparently, there is a dispute with the Government in relation to Finance and Policy.

Also Belediye clinics have been stopped due to some irregularities.

However, we are aware that the Near East Hospitals are, from 1st September, offering PCR tests for 100TL and Antigen tests for 40TL

Council of Ministers decision re PCR/Antigen tests/quarantine fees

The new decision of the TRNC Council of Ministers regarding PCR/Antigen tests and quarantine fees has been published in the Official Gazette. The decisions are as follows:

1- Tests to be done will be free for positive patient follow up, contacts of positive patients and symptomatic patients.

2- In the case of wearing a wristband by positive patients and contacts, the wristband expenses will be covered by the state, and if the relevant people are in hotel quarantine instead of the wristband, the quarantine expenses of the people who have not completed the vaccination process will be covered by themselves. Quarantine fees of vaccinated persons or persons who document that they cannot be vaccinated due to health reasons will be covered by the State.

3- PCR/Antigen tests will be performed only in laboratories, health institutions and pharmacies authorised

by the Ministry of Health. Individuals will create an application through the Ministry of Health system and continue the process with the guidance of the system. Authorised laboratories, health institutions and pharmacies will enter the test results into the Ministry of Health system.

Reports will be acceptable if they are made through the Ministry of Health system.

4- Antigen tests will be free of charge for people under the age of eighteen and those receiving social assistance. Antigen tests will be free of charge for people who have completed the vaccination process and those who document that they cannot be vaccinated due to health reasons, provided that the time interval in the decisions of the Supreme Committee on Communicable Diseases is complied with.

5- Private services will be available within the framework of the allowance provided by the Ministry of Health for

screenings with antigen testing. However, these scans may be for the purpose of detecting the disease and preventing its spread in connection with positive and contact persons.

6- Persons who pass through land border gates for health, work and education purposes will be exempt from the antigen test fee, provided that the time frame in the intra-island transit decision of the Communicable Diseases Supreme Committee is met. Accompanying persons travelling for health and education purposes will also be exempt from this fee within the framework of the same rule.

7- The tests to be carried out to go abroad by air and sea are paid, and only those who go for treatment with the referral of the Health Board and official officials will be exempt from this fee.

8- In the test fees, the maximum price has been determined as 100 TL for PCR and 40 TL for Antigen, and tests can be performed below these figures.

9- The rules contained in this decision shall enter into force as of 1.9.2021.

No oil-related pollution has been detected in the Karpaz area

In order to eliminate the marine pollution caused by the oil spill from Syria and especially its effect on the Karpaz coast, a further meeting was held by the expert personnel of the Ministry of Tourism and Environment Environmental Protection Department, the technical teams of the Republic of Turkey Ministry of

Environment and Urbanization, the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure of the Republic of Turkey and the Coastal Safety personnel of the Ministry of Public Works and Transport. In the meeting, which was held with the participation of the technical team of the Ministry of Environment and Urbanization of Turkey and

the personnel of the Ministry of Tourism and Environment, Environmental Protection Department, who came to the TRNC to evaluate the work done, the Minister of Tourism and Environment Fikri Ataoğlu was informed about the latest situation.

Department Staff will continue on the Karpaz coast, and that an environmental protection campaign has been started.

Minister Ataoğlu stated that if any pollution is detected, the technical and equipment assistance of the Republic of Turkey and the TRNC marine elements will be on alert ready for any kind of intervention, and that 2 more marine pollution response ships have been sent to the region by the Republic of Turkey, despite any threat.

Stating that he will continue his inspections without interruption, Minister Ataoğlu also stated in his speech that it is a great source of strength and motivation that the Republic of Turkey stands by the TRNC with all its institutions, as it always has, and he thanked the technical committees that continue their work, as well as the valuable personnel of the TRNC authorities, for their extraordinary efforts.

At the meeting; It was stated that the intervention and cleaning works carried out in the region had so far yielded results.

It was informed that from 09:00 in the morning until 18:30 in the evening, a scan and examination was carried out at all the notification points received by UAV and satellite images around the Karpaz Peninsula with 4 ships, and as a result of the scanning and examination, no pollution caused by the oil spill originating from Syria was found. .

Minister of Tourism and Environment, Fikri Ataoğlu, in his statement after the information meeting, underlined that the inspections of the Environmental Protection

Evaluation meeting on Syrian Fuel Leak is held

An evaluation meeting was held today 31st August with the participation of the Minister of Public Works and Transportation, Resmiye Canaltay, on what can be done in case the fuel leaking from a power plant in Syria reaches the TRNC.

In addition to Minister Canaltay, officials from the Ministry of Environment and Urbanization of the Republic of Turkey, Coast Guard, Ports Department, Coastal Safety, Meteorology Department, Turkish Embassy in Nicosia, experts from various departments and

organisations attended the meeting at the Ministry.

Suat Yeldener, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Public Works and Transport, said that they will make evaluations with the experts of the Ministry of Environment and Urbanization of the Republic of Turkey and other officials.

Yeldener said that "there is no danger yet" for the leak to reach the shores, and that the direction of the leak, which is currently 12 miles out, is changing depending on the wind.

Yeldener noted that all possibilities will be evaluated and discussed at the meeting and measures to be taken in case the spill reaches the island.

Canaltay: Pollution by Syrian fuel leak is international problem

The Minister of Public Works and Transportation Resmiye Canaltay said that the problem caused by the fuel leaking from the storage of Baniyas Thermal Power Plant in Syria is an international problem.

Minister Canaltay, who gave information about the oil spill advancing from Syria to the Karpaz coast by connecting to the live broadcast on BRT, said that a crisis desk was created in the Prime Ministry in the first place and they contacted the Turkish Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure. Stating

that a delegation from the Turkish Ministry of Environment and Urbanization and the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure came to the TRNC, Minister Canaltay said that a meeting was held with the delegation.

Canaltay said "This is a huge event, an environmental disaster is taking place in the Mediterranean. We worked on what we can do in cooperation with TC for this disaster. There was the weather we had to follow, according to the information given by the Meteorological Department, the coordinates are returning to us again,

there is an uncertain situation here. Our crisis desk meeting is still going on..." Pointing out that they will take images to determine the status by UAVs, Canaltay said, "This is the problem of the world, of us and of

Turkey, this is an international problem."

Charlie Watts of "The Rolling Stones" dies aged 80

After serving The Rolling Stones as drummer for 59 long years, Charlie Watts died on 24th August, 2021 in a London hospital. He was 80 years old.

The Rolling Stones is one exemplary music group which has maintained its popularity for over half century. This indeed is not something easy. As I had written some years back in the same column, they were there when the Beatles had rocked the music world. They were still among a very few groups on top when Michael Jackson took the music lovers along. The Rolling Stones, survived all and everything. It is their type of music that has made them successful in maintaining their followers.

Since the early 1960s, more than three generations have listened to the music of The Rolling Stones. The grandparents, fans of the Stones, still find their children and grandchildren following the beat. This is the quality of the music produced by The Rolling Stones.

Charlie Watts can very well be declared as the most humble celebrity of the music world. There is no doubt that he was one of the greatest drummers of music history. The Rolling Stones magazines

put him as 12th of the 100 Greatest Drummers of all times, in 2016.

Charlie did have a unique face, rather an expressionless sort of face. He always maintained his sober sort of expression, even when smiling. Mostly he kept himself away from the "show" side of the music world. He was not a showman sort of person, appearing in every this and that television show.

He did have a very private sort of family life. Married to Shirley Ann Shepherd, in the early 1960s, he remained loyal to her till the end. The couple had one daughter Seraphina and a grandchild named Charlotte. He loved Arabian horses and owned a stud farm.

He did have health problems, mostly due to drugs and alcohol. He was diagnosed with throat cancer in 2014. However, his devotion to music and love for drumming, kept him going. " It seems that whenever we stop, I get ill. So maybe I should carry on"

Interestingly Charlie Watts never had a driving licence, though he owned a number of cars, which he preferred to view as beautiful objects. He loved cricket.

The Rolling Stones is not just Mick Jagger, or Keith Richards, or Ronnie Wood or Charlie Watts.

This quartet have jointly succeeded in producing fantastic music since they hit the charts in the early 1960s. They were inseparable, as they had spent their youth, their middle age and their advanced years together.

So what will happen to The Rolling Stones, as Charlie Watts is no more?

Indeed this is a very difficult question to answer. Most probably the remaining three would opt to retire. At their advanced ages, I always believed that they were continuing their active music career just because they were getting energy from each other. Now minus their drummer, it may be very difficult for them to continue as a band.

An incredible achievement and we cannot thank everyone enough for their involvement.

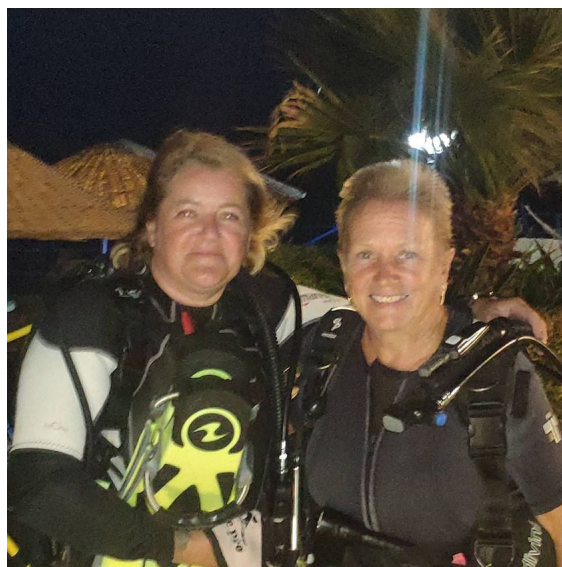
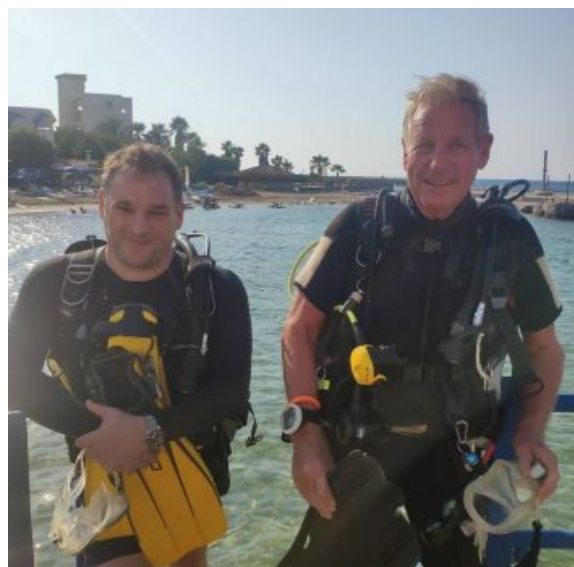
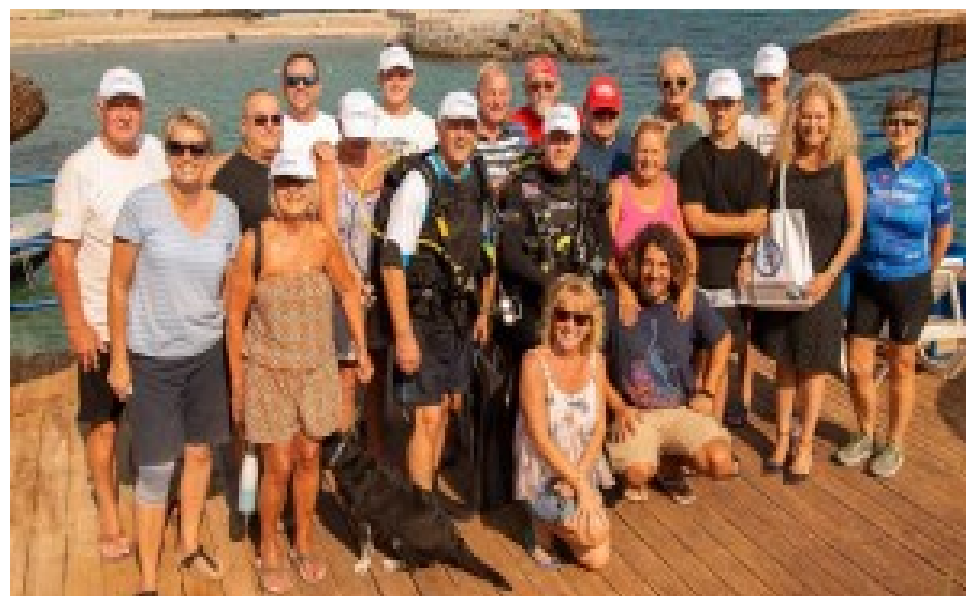

International Cartoon and Humour Festival 2021, Jury is announced

The Jury of the 10th International Cartoon and Humour Festival, part of the Girne Municipality 20th International Olive Festival, was introduced at a press conference held at the Grand Pasha Hotel on Wednesday 1st September 2021.

In previous years prominent members of the cartoon community from different countries of the world have formed the jury. The works this year were reviewed by famous cartoon artists Öznur Kalender and Kübra Deligöz, from the Republic of Turkey, Girne Mayor Nidai Güngördü, and Girne Municipality Art Director Derman Atik. Turkish Cypriot cartoonists and Association members, Serhan Gazioğlu, Hüseyin Çakmak, Musa Kayra and Selen Selışık also judged. Nidai Güngördü, Mayor of Girne and Chairman of the Selection Committee, in his speech at the press conference, explained that the Covid-19 epidemic has created difficulties in many fields from the economy to culture and arts throughout the world. As a result, this year, only judges from the Republic of Turkey and the TRNC will participate in the competition jury.

Mayor Güngördü observed that the competition has become an established event that has an important place in the world cartoon community and noted that 157 cartoonists from 40 countries participated in the competition with 432 works this year. Güngördü stated that the jury will consider the entries between 1st and 4th September.

Reminding us that 1st September World Peace Day, people in underdeveloped countries still have difficulty in obtaining vaccines and there are wars in many parts of the world, Güngördü wished the whole world a day full of love, tolerance and peace away from war, where all humanity will benefit equally from the opportunities of the world.

Güngördü said that it will be decided within a week whether the 20th International Olive Festival can be held physically and this will be

announced to the public. At the end of his speech, he expressed his condolences for Ferhan Şensoy, the Theatre Artist, who passed away yesterday, and for İnci Çayırılı, who made significant contributions to the development of the Girne Municipality, Turkish Art Music Ensemble.

Hüseyin Çakmak, one of the members of the International Jury of the competition, reminded that famous cartoon artists from all over the world took part in the competition jury in past years.

Serhan Gazioğlu, a member of the selection committee, stated that the competition is of great importance as it contributes to the promotion of the country's culture of art and caricature to the world. It brings together the artists of the country with international artists, and shows the unifying power of caricature despite the differences between their sense of humour.

Öznur Kalender, one of the cartoon artists in Turkey, who is on the selection committee of the competition, stated that he has completed his 54th year in the art of caricature and congratulated the Girne Municipality and the Turkish Cypriot Cartoonists Association, which gave life to a professional and exciting competition. Expressing that he is very happy to be a member of the jury in this competition, Kalender also expressed his condolences for the famous theatre artist Ferhan Şensoy, who passed away yesterday.

Kübra Deligöz, another selection committee member of the competition from Turkey, congratulated the Girne Municipality, which organised the competition, and stated that she was honoured to take part in the organisation as a jury member.

Derman Atik, Girne Municipality Art Director and member of the selection committee, stated that Girne

Municipality attaches great importance to the preservation of the cultural art of the country and its transfer to the future, and emphasised that the inclusion of caricature albums among the 25 books published by the Municipality is an indication of the importance given to the art of caricature and its preservation.

Member of the jury, Musa Kayra, expressed his happiness that the organisation had reached its 10th anniversary and for his participation in this event. He added that the competition, which has an olive logo, has a special relevance as the olive is also the symbol of peace.

Selen Selışık, a member of the Selection Committee, congratulated the Girne Municipality, who organised the event, and thanked everyone who contributed.

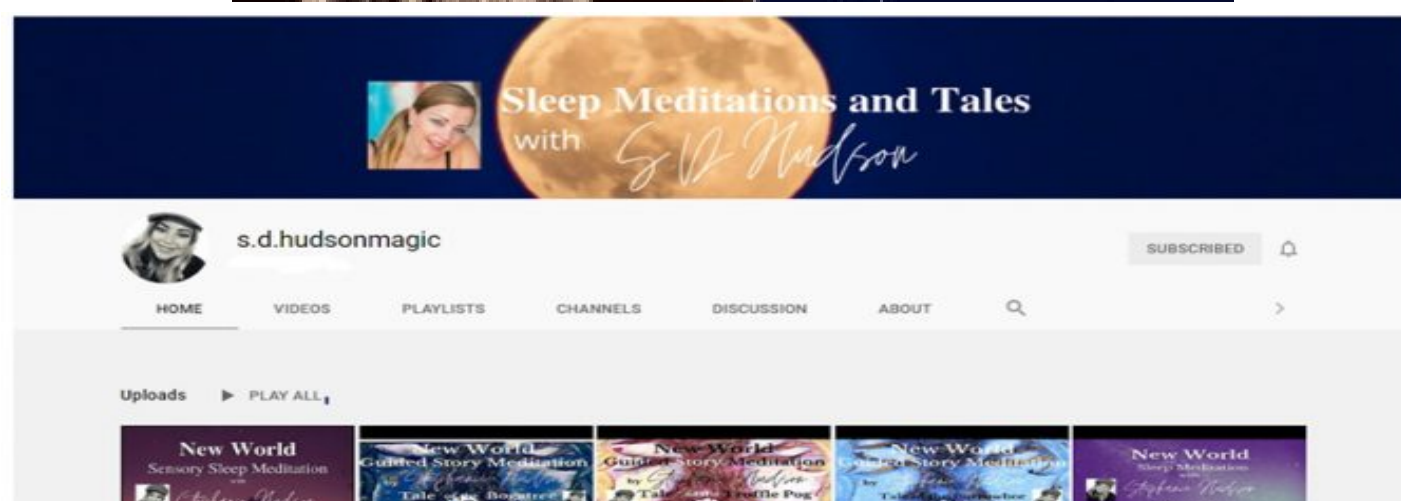

ARUCAD Co-Production - Mr Rabbit's Doll - Montreal Film Festival

The short animated film "Mr Rabbit's Doll", created by Iranian director Arvin Medghalchi, a lecturer at Arkin Creative Arts and Design University (ARUCAD), Visual Communication and Design Department, will compete at the 13th "Stop Motion" Montreal Film Festival, to be held in Canada between September 10-19.

This festival is famous for being the only film festival in the world that includes only films shot using the "stop motion" technique.

Director and Illustrator, Arvin Medghalchi, who has more than 15 years of experience in independent animation film directing, is known for his stop-motion animations that have been shown and awarded at many international film festivals.

Most recently, in 2017, he was awarded the Best Animation prize at the Asian Peace Film Festival for his movie "In Mediterranean Arms". Medghalchi also finished a short animated film, called 'CORONUS', during the pandemic period.

Medghalchi's latest animated short film "MR. RABBIT'S DOLL" was inspired by a story by the world-famous Iranian writer Sadik Hidayet. More than 10,000 frames were used in the animated short film, which used handmade puppets from latex and clay.

The entire movie, with a screen time of 12 minutes, was shot at ARUCAD's Animation Studio. This drama and thriller deals with the themes of loneliness and lack of self-confidence through individual relationships.

The creative staff of the film, which Medghalchi started in partnership with ARUCAD in 2019, includes ARUCAD Film Design and Management Department lecturer, Ali Azhari, as cinematographer, Arkin Innovation Hub art expert, Batu Gündal, as sound artist, and ARUCAD Architecture Department Head Assistant Associate, Dr. Cem Yardımcı.

Also involved were students of the University as assistants.

MR. RABBIT'S DOLL will compete in the Independent Films category of the 13th Stop Motion Montreal Film Festival.

Super League Cihangir put on a super performance

Super League team Cihangir gave Esentepe a football lesson as they virtually dominated this friendly match for the ALİ ŞENKAYALAR MEMORIAL TROPHY. This match has been played annually since 2017 in remembrance of Ali Şenkayalar, a great servant of Cihangir, and this year Esentepe were the team invited to play.

The Cihangir Stadium, which is a lovely stadium, was looking at its best, a sunny day, a lush pitch and a welcoming cooling breeze, a perfect setting which fittingly attracted a large crowd.

The opening 15 minutes were disappointing though with a number of fouls, with Cihangir in control without really threatening.

The home team came close in the 16th minute when Musa shot from outside the box and just cleared a leaping Tuğrul's goal.

Cihangir were now in their stride over-running Esentepe's midfield and exerting pressure on their defence. Esentepe were on the back foot and were guilty of giving the ball away on numerous occasions. On the few times they got over the halfway line their attacks were easily dealt with, especially by their powerful centre back Zihni who gave Esentepe's forward Emrah very little room.

Cihangir are a strong, tall, powerfully built side that break at lightning pace and it was no surprise that a through ball split open Esentepe's defence and SELÇUK SERGEC lashed the ball past Tuğrul. **1-0**

Şükrü who had come on as an early replacement for triallist Kemal smashed a powerful drive just wide of the Cihangir goal in a rare and sporadic Esentepe attack.

32 minutes another quick through ball caught Esentepe defence wide open on the right and LUKA shot past Tuğrul. **2-0**

It was virtually all one way traffic Ali Öztürk hit a shot from outside of the post that took a deflection and cannoned off Tuğrul's right hand post.

Esentepe were very fortunate to go in at the break only two goals down. **HALF TIME : 2-0**

In the first minute of the second half Tuğrul was in action again parrying a fiercely taken free kick from Berkay.

We were then treated to a goal in the 49th minute that would grace any Stadium in the world scored by LUKA who outside the box hit a shot that looked like it was going high over the Esentepe bar until it suddenly dipped hit the underside of the crossbar and went in giving goalkeeper Tuğrul not a chance. **3-0**.

Esentepe replaced Tuğrul with Osmond and soon the young goalkeeper was in action bravely diving at the feet of Musa after a lightning Cihangir break from their own penalty area. A minute later the young goalkeeper made a double save in quick succession to deny Ali Öztürk.

LUKA completed his hat trick in the 68th minute turning a cross in at the far post in the 68th minute. **4-0**

With both teams making changes, the tempo of the match changed and



Esentepe bravely tried to rescue something out of this match. Eser shot wide in the 75th minute after being set up by Şükrü .

78th minute Esentepe did put the ball in the back of the Cihangir net when a SEMİH ARSLAN free kick from outside the box beat a diving Berken, to score his first goal at senior level. **4-1**.

84 minutes Esentepe were now making a fist of it. Tuğra from outside the box hit a low drive through a crowd of players that Berken diving to his right pushed away for a corner.

86 minutes and another goal for Esentepe to make the scoreline more respectable came when DENİZ KIBAR turned in a cross to score his first goal since returning back to the club. **FULL TIME : 4-2**

SUMMING UP: On this evidence Cihangir should be challenging for the Super League title. In LUKA they had the Man of the Match 3 goals and he covered most of the pitch as well. TACETTİN KÖSE ex Esentepe favourite was not far behind him in his new midfield role.

This was a good lesson for Esentepe youngsters, heads didn't drop, they were simply outclassed.

**Muharrem Döveç Stadium,
Famagusta - Sunday August 29th.**

League 1 rivals Çanakkale and Esentepe fought out an entertaining draw on Sunday on a warm balmy evening in Famagusta.

Since my last visit to the Muharrem Döveç Stadium, quite near the newish shopping mall in Famagusta, the ground has not altered, it's still as run down as before in need of some TLC. Çanakkale are one of the poorest clubs in League 1 relying on bringing youth through and together with a couple of seasoned journeymen they always are favourites to be relegated but somehow just managed to avoid the drop every season. Good, as I like Çanakkale their team and supporters always make you feel very welcome.

The match itself was quite entertaining, both goalkeepers saved their respective teams at various stages, there was plenty of effort and endeavour but what was lacking was a little finesse. This was probably down to the playing surface which catches quite a few teams out due to its uneven bounce.

Esentepe started very brightly and forward Furkan Zengin almost created something out of nothing in the 8th minute with a half scissor kick volley which brought a good save out of the Çanakkale goalkeeper Ibrahim pushing the ball over for a corner.

Esentepe's early pressure paid off and they took the lead in the 11th minute, when Emrah on the right did well to control the ball and cross to Furkan who couldn't get away a shot, instead the ball rolled back to SALIH KARAL whose shot the diving Ibrahim managed to push onto the crossbar but unfortunately for him it

bounced down into the net.

Not to be outdone Yunus capitalised when Esentepe lost possession on the left and his low hard shot to the near post was only thwarted by Goalkeeper Tuğrul sticking out a foot at the last moment.

Yunus was unlucky again in the 22nd minute when he had a double effort doubly saved by Tuğrul. His first effort an overhead kick was blocked by the goalkeeper back to Yunus on the floor he managed to get a header which was gratefully scrambled away by Tuğrul.

The water break couldn't come quick enough for Esentepe but after that Çanakkale piled on the pressure pinning Esentepe back in their own half. In the 34th minute they equalised through YUNUS KALAYCI from the penalty spot after Devran had fouled his opponent.

Esentepe were struggling far too often, giving the ball away and failing to find players with poor passing.

Çanakkale deservedly took the lead just before the break when their best player HASAN ÇAĞKAN ÇAKA (who had tormented Esentepe all afternoon) received the ball on the right with his marker Emek all at sea and beat Tuğrul with a cross shot.

HALF TIME SCORE: 2-1

Esentepe Coach Kılıç Ali had seen enough, hauling off 6 players during the interval.

This seemed to have the desired effect as Esentepe took a firm grip on the match and came close to scoring on a number of occasions.

In the first minute of the half Ege on the left crossed to Hüseyin whose low



drive was held by the diving Ibrahim. A Hüseyin cross from the left was powerfully headed over the bar by Hürkan.

Good work on the right by Emrah found Furkan in the box who hit a first time shot just past the diving goalkeeper.

Esentepe were unable to play their passing game and had to grind out a result. Emrah put in a hardworking performance and was rewarded with a goal. Hürkan on as a replacement had a good 45 minutes.
