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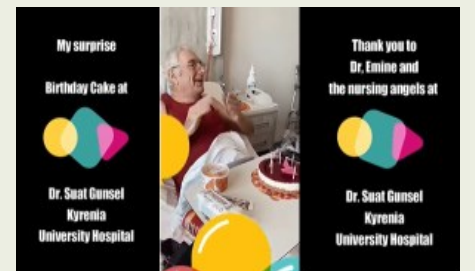

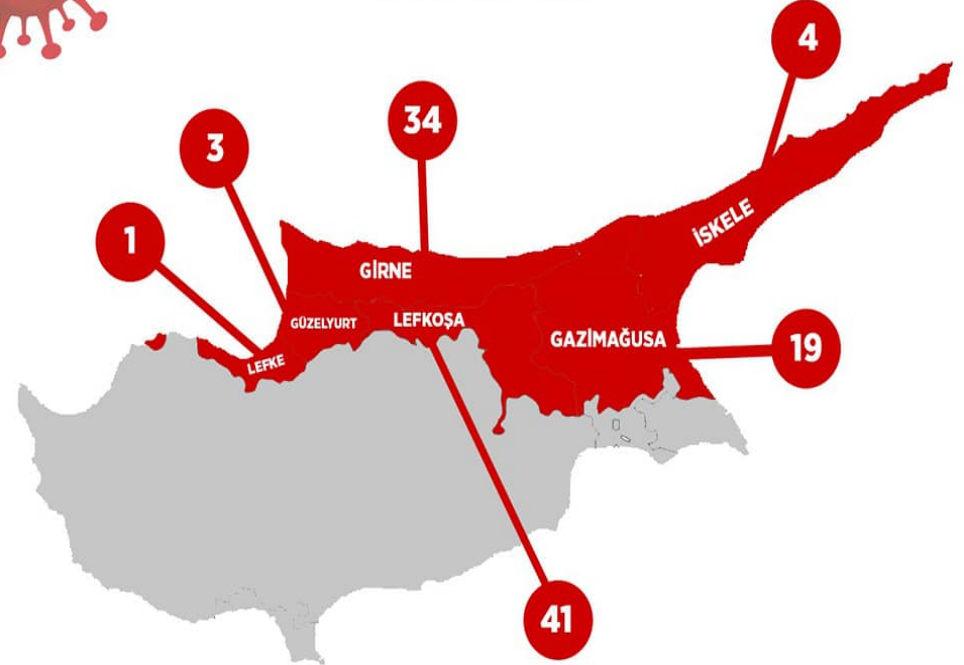

## “Teslimat” (Delivery) film selected in 8 more festivals

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The Turkish-Cypriot short film “Teslimat” (Delivery) will compete in eight more international festivals in September, including Latin America's biggest short film festival -“Shorts México”.

The Turkish Cypriot short film “Teslimat”, directed by Doğuş Özokutan and produced by Vasvi Çiftçioglu, will be screened in Mexico, Ecuador, Spain, Bulgaria, the USA and Italy in September.

“Teslimat” which was filmed with the support of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and its post-production made with the support of the TRNC Culture Department, had its world premiere in November 2020, since then the

number of countries where it has been screened will increase to 10, and the number of international festivals it has been selected for will increase to 31.

The film in which İzal Seylani played the leading role has so far won 5 international awards from Italy, Spain and Puerto Rico.

## Turkey strongly condemn attitude of Greek Cypriot Administration

Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs: “We strongly condemn this anachronistic, hostile and unacceptable attitude of the Greek Cypriot Administration.”

The Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs strongly condemned the instruction given by the Greek Cypriot Ministry of Education to tear up the page about Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, the founder of Turkish Republic, from a textbook taught in schools

In the written statement made by the Ministry, the instruction reveals the radical level of the distorted mentality of the Greek

Cypriot Administration towards Turkey and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. It was also noted in the statement “We strongly condemn this anachronistic, hostile and unacceptable attitude of the Greek Cypriot Administration.”

It was also added that the latest action of the Greek Cypriot Administration, which has been responsible for the deadlock of the Cyprus issue for years, demonstrates that they do not have tolerance not only to share the power and the wealth, but even to live together with the Turkish Cypriots on the Island.

It was reported that the Ministry of Education in the Greek Cypriot Administration sent a circular letter to the secondary education teachers to "tear up" the 36th page, which includes the chapter on Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, before

distributing the book, entitled "Oxford Discover Futures 3 Workbook", to students.

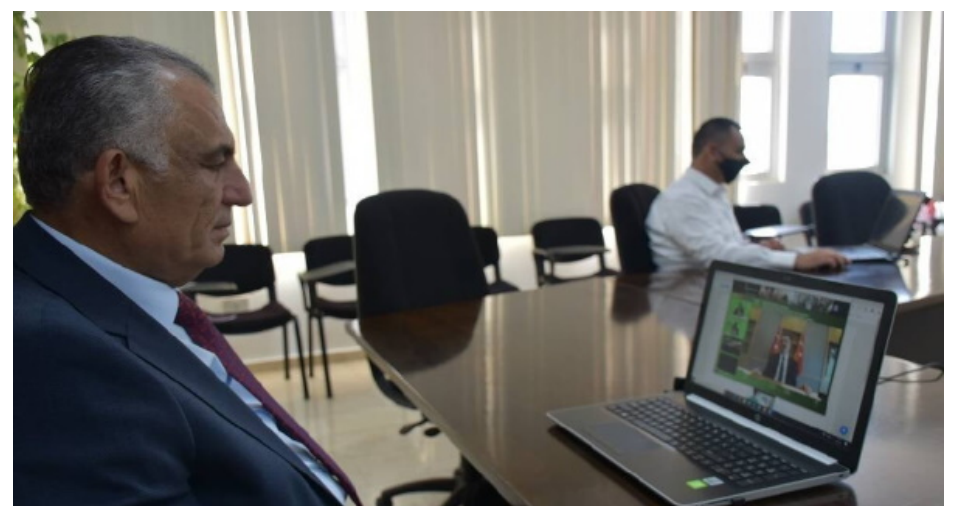

## Statement of TRNC Ministry of Foreign Affairs re textbooks in RoC

Official Statement by TRNC Ministry of Foreign Affairs regarding the Greek Cypriot decision to collect the textbooks which contain a section about Atatürk.

We strongly condemn the decision taken by the Greek Cypriot Ministry of Education to first tear the page containing a section about our Great Leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk from the textbook used in the secondary education and then having it removed altogether, claiming that the textbook is “inappropriate”. The decision is a new example of the racist stance of the Greek Cypriot administration.

The Great Leader Atatürk is an inspiring Leader not only for the Turkish nation, but also for all the countries in the world, with the epic struggle he demonstrated during the establishment of the Republic of Turkey and with his revolutions after the Republic was established. It is not possible to accept the disrespect towards the Leader of the Turkish Nation.

The reflection of the increasingly hostile behaviour of the Greek side onto the Greek Cypriot education system clearly shows that the Greek side cannot tolerate the Turkish existence on the island and cannot digest the glorious history of the Turkish nation.

The international community needs to understand that this racist mentality prevailing on the Greek Cypriot side lies at the root of the inability to reach an agreement on the Cyprus issue.

On this occasion, we commemorate Great Leader Atatürk, the founder of our Motherland Turkey with respect and gratitude.

## Canaltay: The face of Girne Port and region will change

The TRNC Minister of Public Works and Transportation, Resmiye Eroğlu Canaltay, accompanied by Near East University Founding Rector Dr. Suat İrfan Günsel, examined the ongoing works in the area in respect of the TEAL ship, which is to be transformed into the Maritime History Museum in Girne Harbour. Work continues at full speed in the area where the 66-year-old TEAL ship belonging to the University of Kyrenia, will be transformed into a Maritime

History Museum with the protocol signed between the TRNC Ministry of Public Works and Transportation and the Near East University Organisation, and will be situated in Girne Port.

Examining the ongoing works in the area where TEAL will be placed in the Girne Harbour as the Maritime History Museum, the Minister of Public Works and Transport, Resmiye Eroğlu Canaltay, reminded that Cyprus is a very important tourism centre

with its historical and cultural riches and natural beauty, and said: "This step makes a very important contribution to the identity and tourism of our country. The Maritime History Museum, founded by the Near East Organisation, will also transform Girne into a very important cultural and art center with its unique features." Minister Canaltay said that with the opening of the Maritime History Museum, the face of Girne Harbour and its region will also change.

Near East University Founding Rector Dr. Suat İrfan Günsel emphasised that the Near East museums adopt an original museology approach with an understanding that brings together historical objects with contemporary art. Dr. Günsel said, “TEAL, which is itself an important part of maritime history, will be a unique Maritime History Museum that brings together

contemporary art and historical materials.”

TEAL, which will be housed by opening a four-meter-deep channel to be placed in the area between the arriving passenger building and the marina at the Port of Girne, will serve the country's tourism as the Maritime History Museum upon the completion of the works.

TEAL, which has trained dozens of captains as training and research ships at the Near East University and University of Kyrenia in the last 27 years, will include more than 5,000 materials such as paintings, photographs, maritime objects, ship models, nautical maps as the Maritime History Museum. It is aimed to open the Maritime History Museum on 15th November - Republic Day.

## Tatar's message on anniversary of Allahverdi Kılıç's martyrdom

TRNC President Ersin Tatar published a message on the anniversary of the 25th anniversary of the martyrdom of Infantry Soldier Allahverdi Kılıç who became a martyr as a result of the attack of Greek Cypriot soldiers on the 8th of September 1996 while he was doing his military service.

President Tatar pointed out that Turkey's guarantorship and Turkish Armed Forces cannot be given up and added "We commemorate Infantry Soldier Allahverdi Kılıç once again with mercy and respect on the 25th anniversary of his martyrdom. We have not forgotten this treacherous attack, we will not forget it. It is our greatest duty to keep our martyrs alive and glorify them".

Stating that that this attack by Greek Cypriot soldiers is another proof that the Greek Cypriot administration has a criminal record, while showing once again

that the Greek Cypriot mentality, which does not give the Turkish Cypriot people the right to life and sees the people as a minority, has not changed and will not change, President Tatar emphasised that their main goal is to put an end to this mentality and aggression, to protect the people, to secure the future of the people and the new generations, and to reach a fair and lasting agreement.

Pointing out that this can be achieved with the agreement based on the existence of two separate sovereign equal states, which was put on the negotiating table for the first time in Geneva, not with an unrealisable federal-based agreement, President Tatar made the following statements in his message. "Our proposal for a solution proposal, which is also supported by Turkey, the most powerful and largest country in the region, is the most realistic solution and we will not take a step back from this proposal.

Aiming to abolish Turkey's guarantee and drive Turkish soldiers away from Cyprus by saying "zero army, zero guarantees", the Greek Cypriot administration should know that we will not give up the guarantorship of Turkey and the Turkish soldiers. Mujahid (Turkish Cypriot soldiers) and Mehmetçik (Turkish soldiers) are our only assurance and guarantee.

If we live under the roof of our own state as sovereign, free and fearless after the great resistance in this land that we know as our homeland today, we owe it to our martyrs, Mujahid, Mehmetçik and Turkey, who is always by our side."

## Adapass will be used in all TRNC districts as of 06/09/21

The Adapass application, which was launched in Lefkoşa on 27th August 2021, as a pilot scheme, will be used in all districts as of 06/09/21 in line with the decision taken by the Communicable Diseases High Committee on 1st September in order to query the test and vaccination status of people who will enter certain venues, sectors, activities and events. The Adapass inquiry will be mandatory for those aged 18 and over.

QR code will be requested when entering the TRNC as of 06/09/21.

As of 6/09/21, the QR code to be obtained from [adapass.gov.ct.tr](http://adapass.gov.ct.tr) web address will be requested from people aged 18 and over who

will enter the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus by using air, sea and land gates.

According to the decision taken by the Communicable Diseases High Committee on 1st September, those who will enter the country as of today (06/09/21) will complete the passenger form in [adapass.gov.ct.tr](http://adapass.gov.ct.tr) web address before the trip and will enter the island with the QR code to be obtained.

People who do not add their personal information to the site and do not receive a QR code will not be able to enter the country.

The documents with Adapass code from TRNC citizens, Healthpass from Turkish citizens, Greenpass

from EU citizens and NHS QR code from UK citizens will be required and checked during the entry to the country.

Citizens of other countries are required to add their valid vaccination cards and/or PCR test

results to the section specified in the application and to bring the attached documents with them as they will be checked upon entry to the country.

## Tatar: We will not give up our state, our sovereignty, our freedom

We will never give up our state, our sovereignty and our freedom. We will not go back to the dark days of 1974. Our aim and endeavour is to reach a just and permanent agreement based on the realities of Cyprus. The only way for this is the solution based on the existence of two separate sovereign equal states, which we

put on the negotiating table for the first time in Geneva. This form of solution, that is also supported by Turkey, is a solution which will be to the benefit of both Cyprus and the region, and we will not take steps backward from it.”

President Tatar made the following call to the Greek Cypriot side in his message:

“My call to the Greek Cypriot side is to give up its uncompromising attitude with the outdated and dominant mentality that sees the Turkish Cypriot people as a minority and sees themselves as 'the sole owner of Cyprus' and to show a positive approach.”

## Being a journalist during the 1980s when there was no internet

Right now we all are so much used to the internet, that we cannot even think of a life without it. But people of my generation did spend a life without the internet. Sometimes when I look back, I really find it interesting to recall how I worked as a freelance journalist during the 1980s, without internet.

Now a newspaper office without the facility of internet, is something that cannot even be thought of. The new generation cannot even dream of any such situation. But journalists of the pre-internet era did work a lot and were at their best. The newspapers in those days were competing with each other, and were rushing to find a scoop to increase their sales. Even in those days, the journalists working in any newspaper, used to compete with each other to get a chance of getting their news published on the front or back page.

The newspapers and the journalists also now compete in the same way. Their goals are still the same, but their means to reach the needed information have changed a lot, on the better side. Now they find most of the needed information online. In our days it was not so. We used to consult Encyclopedias, old newspaper

cuttings, old books, etc to build up the details of any topic. The journalists in those days had to literally run after every event, and incident. Although they still do have to do this, in most cases, they get most of the information through the internet.

I remember, frequently I had had to rush back to my office to write my article on the typewriter. Frequently it was difficult to find time to correct the typing mistakes since we all were facing a very strict time deadline. Mostly we were just rushing to type at our best speed.

Since I was working freelance, frequently I had had to rush to the newspaper office with my typed pages in hand, to see the editor. Making him accept my last moment stories used to be an additionally difficult task. The newspaper's offices in those days in the city were mostly in one particular area. So it was rather easy for me to rush to another nearby newspaper office, after being refused by one. Unfortunately, physically, it was quite a big problem for me since I was living in a distant area of the city.

At times, I used to go to a nearby library to find some basic information about the topic in my mind and rushing to more than one

library one after another, was also common. Usually my last stop had been the library of the newspaper office, where I could find the old newspapers, along with books. But being a freelance journalist, usually the newspapers were not providing me with the facility to use their typewriters. That had been an additional problem for me.

I remember, arranging for photographs also was a difficult issue. There were no digital cameras in those days. I was using my old Agfa, 12 snaps camera. Since I had to also arrange the developing and printing, I frequently rushed to the studio of my photographer friend. He had always been helpful to me. It was not so easy to cut the negative

inside the darkroom, develop them and then print the photo but there was no other way out for me.

After finishing the typing and photographs, I would rush to the newspapers offices to get my article approved by the editor.

Now, I think most of these problems are no more. The journalists have digital cameras. They have the facilities to send their write-ups online. They have all facilities of getting information from innumerable sources available on the screen of their mobile phones.

However, I still wish I could go out and work as a freelance journalist, but the world seems to have changed a lot.

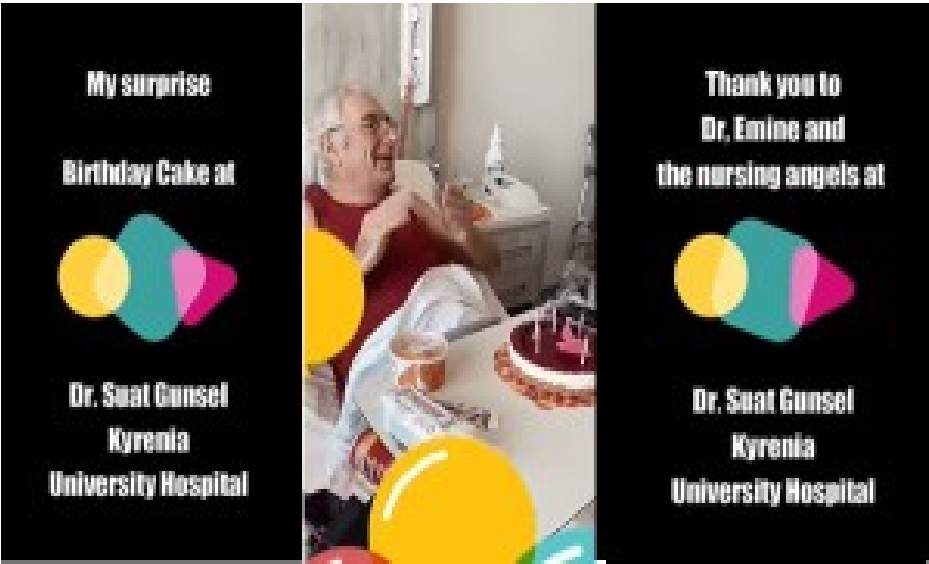

## Social Affairs Branch trained for Elderly & Home Care Patients

Girne Municipality Social Affairs Branch personnel received training on patient and elderly care at home.

According to the information given by Girne Municipality, in the training held at the Social Life Center in cooperation with Kolan British Hospital, Internal Medicine, Geriatrics

and Hepatology Specialist Prof. Dr. Mehmet Refik informed the Social Affairs Branch personnel about the care of the elderly at home. During the training, the personal care of the elderly, the training that should be given to their caregivers, their practices in the fields of dieticians and physiotherapists, as well as

psychological support issues, were discussed.

Girne Municipality Social Affairs Supervisor Misli Kadioğlu said that there are nearly a thousand members over the age of 65 registered to the Second Spring Unit affiliated to their branches. Kadioğlu pointed out that they support their members on many issues such as routine sugar, blood pressure measurements, and hospital transportation, and pointed out the importance of training the expert personnel by updating their knowledge.

Kadioğlu said, "There is a period associated with old age, illness, and need for care, and this leads to the isolation of elderly individuals from the society. Our staff, who come into contact with our elderly people one-to-one during their home visits, establishes close relations with them as their families. They support them. That's why. It is even more important that we are aware of these issues."

Girne Mayor Nidai Güngördü stated that it is more understandable to protect our elderly with the Covid 19 pandemic and said that they are working to understand them and not to leave them alone with the health issues and problems brought by old age. Güngördü stated that they act with the awareness that all people of all ages and situations have the right to a quality life and they are working to contribute to this.

Pointing out the importance of in-service training in a corporate structure, Güngördü said such an important service to the personnel of the Social Affairs Branch, who provide services in a human-oriented and sensitive issue and have one-to-one contact with the elderly.

He thanked Kolan British Hospital for showing interest and participating in education and for contributing to education and cooperation.

He could return to music only by 1983 and founded with his friend Nihat Aydın the protest music band Atmacalar in 1989. The band changed its name to Umuda Ezgi in 1991. Bingöl left the band in 1995 and released his first solo album Sen Türkülerini Söyle the same year.

Bingöl was in several miniseries on Turkish TV, including Bayanlar Baylar, Ah Be İstanbul and Yanık Koza. He also did the romance series Zerda and the sitcom Eşref Saati. His 2008 films made both great success: Three Monkeys premiered in competition at the 2008 Cannes Film Festival, where its director Nuri Bilge Ceylan won the Award for Best Director. ## A nightmare when we arrived at Ercan Airport

From Ian George.....

Hello CyprusScene,

I thought it might be worth sharing our experience of entering the TRNC through Ercan. We have an apartment in Esentepe and visit three times per year for the last twelve years so we are pretty experienced in the TRNC ways.

So my wife and I downloaded the EU jab certificate and PCR test we had in Dublin. Going through Dublin airport couldn't have been simpler, just show your passport, ticket and PCR test and away you go.

On arrival at Istanbul they allowed us to go straight to our departure gate rather than going out and back in again, like they do sometimes.

Boarded and arrived ten minutes early but then it all went wrong. After queuing for twenty minutes we were told we had to get a bracelet. Ok no problem so we go to the desk and waited ten minutes only to be told you must have a PCR test. So we have the test, get the paperwork and return to the desk and queue for another 15 minutes. We were told we had to pay 750TL for the bracelet and test and download an app on our phones. So we download the app only to be told they will send us a code to our Turkish phone, which is in our apartment! We found out later that you can use your own mobile to do this.

Surprise, surprise there was a man sitting at the end of the desk selling Turkish SIM cards!! So I bought one, and after another twenty minutes of trying to

download the app and queuing back up again, we eventually got back to the desk to pay.

Now, as a regular visitor to Northern Cyprus I have used my debit card hundreds of times over the years. I put my card in the reader put my three numbers in, but it would not go through. My wife got her card out but hers wouldn't work either. I tried ten times to put my code in but was told you need to put in four numbers! I tried explaining to the girl that UK cards only have three numbers, but she said they cannot complete the payment. So I said no problem I will pay you in cash, but was told sorry only card payments.

So there we were two hours later in the sticky heat in Ercan airport scratching our heads as to what we do next. Luckily our taxi driver came to our rescue and paid for our bracelet on his card and we reimbursed him. We were told to stay indoors for five days, I asked about getting water and food, but all I got was a shrug of the shoulders.

Three hours and ten minutes it took us to get through the airport, whereas our neighbors came through Larnaca, straight to Metehan crossing, had a quick test which took ten minutes in total and no bracelet!

What is wrong with this government? They allow hundreds to come from the south with just a quick test at the border. Why do you have to have another test and a bracelet at Ercan?

They have succeeded in convincing me to give my money to British Airways rather than

Turkish Airlines in the future. With all that's going on in the world they should be welcoming tourists not making it so difficult that they will not come back.

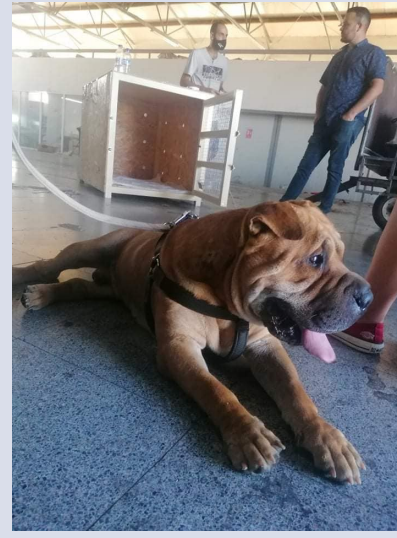

## Quitting alcohol & coming to terms with life via Medi Foundation

It has been a long time since I first started communicating with Ismet Medi and then meeting him for the first time at the launch of the Medi Foundation on 25th June 2020 at the Ezic Restaurant, Lefkosa and be on hand as he launched the Medi Foundation. So what is the Medi Foundation and what it does and what has it achieved?

I think it is right for Ismet Medi to express his own suffering and how he decided to start his foundation to help others and this is what he had to say:

*" I am Turkish Cypriot born in London, my parents were both born in a small Cypriot village in the Karpaz, which I am proud to say is called Kaleburnu.*

*I cared for my beloved mother for 4 years who was suffering from Alzheimer's, a beautiful lady who I loved very much and I lost my mother on 24th May 2019.*

*But I also must tell you that I was also an alcoholic for almost 4 years and now I am alcohol free for 48 months on 9th September after medical treatments and I am in recovery process doing the treatment that is composed of individual psychotherapy, the 12 steps with a sponsor, group support and keep up to my life meaning and the joy of healing. I know this process of recovery I will do for the rest of my life.*

*After stopping drinking my mind was getting better and so was my body, I was feeling good and positive I wanted to reach out and help people in any way I could to help others do what I had managed to do.*

*I wanted to help others but did not know where to start or what to do, I felt like I wanted to just shout out and ask if anyone wants help. But I didn't know where and how to start.*

*After many conversations and meetings, I started seeing the light and feeling the support when finally meeting like-minded people with the same vision, I am happy to say that the Medi Foundation was finally formed officially in February 2020.*

*Our aim is to help people of all ages with recovery from addictions of all kinds, for example alcohol, gambling, technology, food, smoking, drugs.*

*The Medi Foundation now has on its board as members a great professional team full of energy, including the President of the Prime Minister's Anti-Drugs Commission, Mr. Hasan Karaokcu, who said the following"*

*" We have been calling all individuals and all segments of the society to shoulder the struggle since the day we took office, and that the Medi Foundation established under the leadership of*

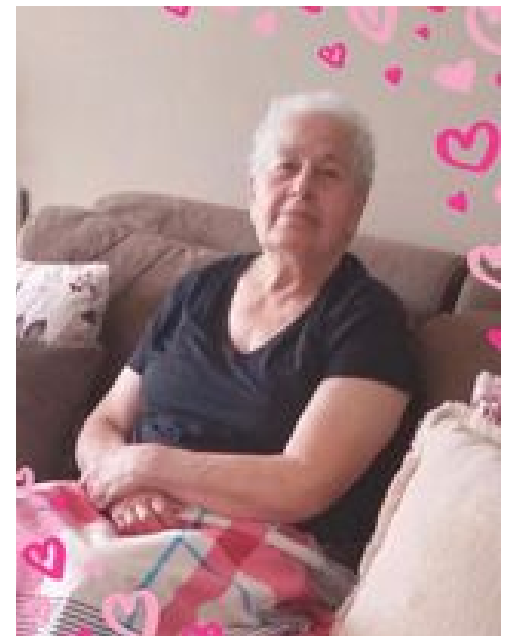

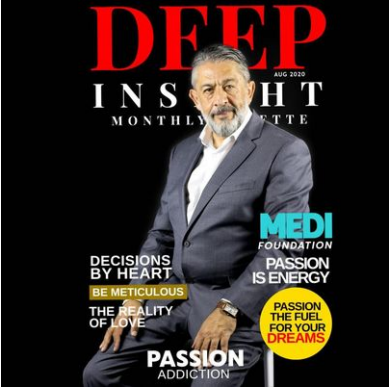

## 3rd Street Ball Tournament to be held in Girne

The third Street Ball tournament will be held at Girne Municipality Sports facilities on 10, 11 and 12 September. The tournament will be organised this year by the Mediterranean Sports Association in cooperation with the Municipality of Girne and the Prime Ministry Anti-Drug Commission. A press conference was held at the Girne Municipality New Service Building regarding the tournament.

Mediterranean Sports Union President, Serhat Deniz, emphasised that the Union is very happy to organise the 3rd Street Ball Tournament, and stated that their aim is to spread the love of basketball in the country in general, especially in Girne. Recalling that the event was like a 3-day festival with the participation of 90 teams last year, Mr Deniz stated that the registrations will continue until Thursday 9th September and 40 teams have registered so far.

The tournament will have 7 categories. A special award will be given in memory of Kemal Hıfıoğlu, who made very important contributions to the country's basketball and who passed away last year. Deniz thanked everyone who contributed to the organisation and supported it with sponsorship.

President of the Prime Ministry Anti-Drug Commission, Hasan Karaokçu, stated that as a commission, they organised many activities with municipalities and non-governmental organisations in order to keep young people away from addiction and bad habits, and pointed out that the commission has been in close cooperation with the Municipality of Girne and the

Mediterranean Sports Union since its establishment.

Commenting that due to the Covid 19 pandemic, children, young people and their families have become more dependent on the internet and have stayed away from social life, sports and cultural activities. Mr Karaokçu emphasised that events such as this Street Ball Tournament gain even more importance.

Özlem Ratip, Representative of the Mediterranean Sports Union, confirmed that the event will comply with the Covid19 measures, and that PCR, Antigen tests, vaccination reports will be requested from the athletes, teams and all participants. Maximum attention will be paid to mask, social distance and hygiene rules.

The tournament will be held in 7 different categories and Ratip said, gift certificates will be given to the 1st place winners in the U11-U-15 categories, 750TL for the U-15 winners, 800TL for the U-17 winners, 1,000TL for the U-20 winners, 1,250TL for the seniors category and 1,000TL for the Masters category winners.

Girne Mayor, Nidai Güngördü, emphasised that while the Covid 19 epidemic continues, the society should adapt to the “new normal”, and noted that vaccination, PCR and antigen tests gain even more importance at this point.

Güngördü stated that the Municipality, the Prime Ministry Anti-Drug Commission and the Mediterranean Sports Union will do their best to ensure that this event is completed without any adverse health effects. Expressing his belief that the tournament will be held in a festive atmosphere this year, Güngördü reminded everyone taking part that they should be very careful to observe Covid measures this year.

Also noting that, due to the Covid 19 pandemic, children, young people and their families have been staying at home for about 18 months and have become more dependent on the internet and smartphones and avoiding social life, cultural and sports activities, Güngördü said that it is important for the youngsters to enjoy activities on the streets, even if only for a short while.

Mayor Güngördü noted that during the 18-month period, in cooperation with the Prime Ministry Anti-Drug Commission and the Mediterranean Sports Union, young people organised many activities to increase the morale of children.

Emphasising that vaccination, PCR and antigen tests gained even greater importance in this period when schools are planned to be opened, Güngördü reminded that there is a big difference between vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals getting the Covid 19 disease.
