The internet is a fast moving place with posts of news and reviews being published and shared in social media pages but if they are only in one language that's restricting the potential audience that can be reached.

It's been a very interesting week with contacts made with another sharer of news and reviews in mainly Turkish and I met with Selçuk Buket who is sharing news and review through his Whatsapp group, Girne Aktif and we spent good time together looking at what he is doing and the community area he is sharing through and also where CyprusScene is sharing from its various media publications and decided to collaborate to try a to share collective news and reviews to a wider audience.

Clearly when sharing news and reviews, we need to make a language bridge between Northern Cyprus communities and those worldwide readers and we agreed that language translation is vital if

the largest audience is to be reached.

CyprusScene website provides visitors the opportunity to translate our text articles into their language and in addition we are providing a translation link into our Facebook sharing and asking those that wish to share their Facebook posts through our page to do the same by allowing translation in their Facebook settings.

This is going to take a lot of time and effort before they realise the benefit of sharing news and reviews which can be read in many languages but is so valuable that communities either in the TRNC or worldwide can now read posts all in their chosen language.

To the best of my knowledge the only English language TV shows in Northern Cyprus are the BRT Vox Pop show which is interviews with interesting people in the community and the shows are also broadcast with Turkish subtitles. In addition, BRT English News is published every day and shared on their BRT Haber Facebook page.

BRT also have a English language



radio show, Bayrak International which features music, news and reviews and has a Facebook page.

If the TRNC is going to get worldwide recognition then they need more English language TV shows to share with the world news and reviews broadcasts.

Now back to this week's news and perhaps the most important thing is the statement made TRNC Foreign Minister Tahsin Ertuğruloğlu about "No Turning Back" at the Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO) meeting held in Uzbekistan.

We continuing to receive and publish contributed news and

reviews on our CyprusScene website, podcast channels and online e-newspaper and all are accessed from our website for your information and enjoyment.

## “No Turning Back” said TRNC Foreign Minister Tahsin Ertuğruloğlu



Turkish Cypriot People have been asking for the formal recognition of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus and the acknowledgment of their inherent rights, Foreign Minister Tahsin Ertuğruloğlu stated at an Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO) meeting held in Uzbekistan. “This new road we have embarked upon has no turning back whether it is accepted by the Greek Cypriot side or not.

Greek Cypriots and the international community must accept the undeniable reality of Cyprus, which is, there are two separate sovereign states, two separate democracies, two separate peoples,” Ertuğruloğlu said during his speech at the 26th Meeting of the Council of Ministers of the ECO held in Tashkent, the capital of Uzbekistan, to which the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus is an observer member.

Meeting the Foreign Ministers of the member states of Türkiye, Iran, Pakistan, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan, Afghanistan and Tajikistan, Ertuğruloğlu thanked the Government of Uzbekistan for hosting this important meeting during his speech at the Council.

The minister also expressed his gratitude to Khusrav Noziri, the Secretary General of the Organization of Economic Cooperation, and his team for their efforts in the successful execution of the organization.

Recalling that the Turkish Cypriot State has been a part of the activities and events of the ECO since 1992 and received observer member status in 2012, Ertuğruloğlu noted that the necessary contribution has always been made to the work of the organization. He underlined that Turkish Cypriots have been an enthusiastic participant at the meetings of the organization at all levels, stressing that numerous successful ECO events are hosted in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus.

Emphasizing the intention to organize ECO events in our country in 2023, the minister also noted that the arrangements for this purpose have started, stating that he wants to host participants from all member states in our country and that valuable steps are being examined.

Sharing also his views on the new vision of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus in the face of new dynamics both on the island and in the region, Ertuğruloğlu

said that “the Cyprus issue has been on the agenda of the international community for nearly 60 years and it has been misdiagnosed.” He stressed that the Cyprus issue is a “status issue.”

“As the geography dictates, Cyprus has two owners, neither of which has the right to rule the other and the only way forward requires the cooperation of both parties,” Ertuğruloğlu said, noting that both peoples on the island are sovereign equals and that any effort to tackle this issue must take this fact into account. Affirming that there will be no mutually acceptable agreement unless the perspective of the international community to the Cyprus issue changes, the minister noted that more than five decades have been lost over the Cyprus negotiations and that it is high time to move forward with a new vision.

Underlining that the acceptance of the reality on the ground will certainly bring the much-needed stability, security and cooperation in and around the island of Cyprus, Ertuğruloğlu emphasized that this cooperation should be based on the sovereign equality and international equal status of the two peoples and the two states on the island. He stated that the Turkish Cypriot People have been asking for the formal recognition of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus and the acknowledgment of their inherent rights, namely the

sovereign equality of the state and its equal international status for this reason.

“This new road we have embarked upon has no turning back whether it is accepted by the Greek Cypriot side or not. Greek Cypriots and the international community must accept the undeniable reality of Cyprus, which is, that there are two separate sovereign states, two separate democracies, two separate peoples,” he said. “I believe that we will remove the obstacles to take our rightful place in the international community,” the minister added, underlining that the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus stands strong with the staunch support of the Motherland Türkiye.

“I sincerely hope that the member states of the ECO would expeditiously take concrete steps to engage more with the Turkish Cypriot state in every field which will help us to overcome the inhuman restrictions and embargoes imposed upon us by the Greek Cypriot side.” He concluded, noting that the Turkish Cypriot side, on many occasions in this platform, had raised the issue of unjust isolation inflicted on every aspect of the daily lives of the Turkish Cypriot People.

## Köprülü: Çetinkaya Taksim Football Pitch controlled access crossings



The Undersecretary of TRNC Ministry of Foreign Affairs Kemal Köprülü made a

statement to the Turkish Agency-Cyprus (TAK) regarding the opening of the Çetinkaya Taksim

Football Pitch and stated that they are constantly in contact with the United Nations (UN). Köprülü noted that Çetinkaya Taksim Football Pitch will be fully opened to youth and national sports with the completion of the work on the pitch in the coming days.

Pointing out that there are entrances to the pitch from two different points, Köprülü reminded that the UN Peacekeeping Force (UNFICYP) has placed barriers at these points. Emphasizing that while placing

the barrels, the walls, which are of ancient artefacts, were damaged, Kemal Köprülü added that the Foreign Ministry made attempts before the UNFICYP on this issue and said "This incident was strongly protested".

Noting that the barriers have been removed but the barbed wires have not been removed yet, the Undersecretary stated that they will make high-level contacts on the issue in the coming days.

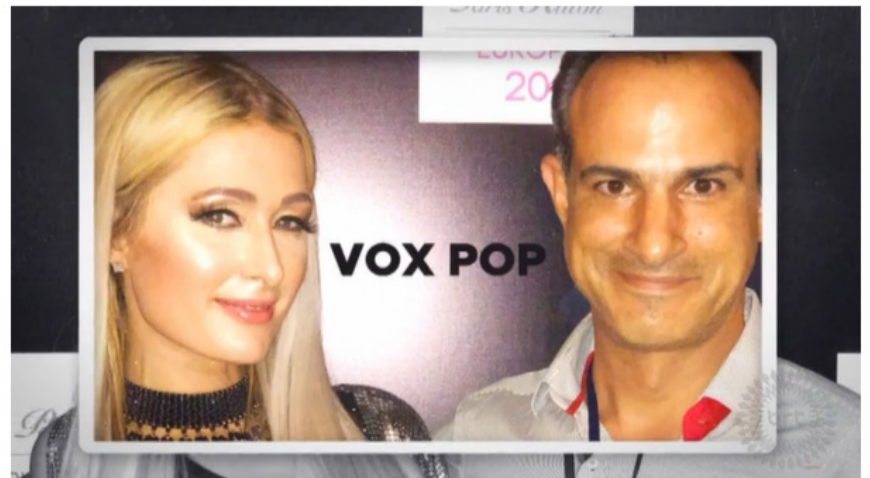

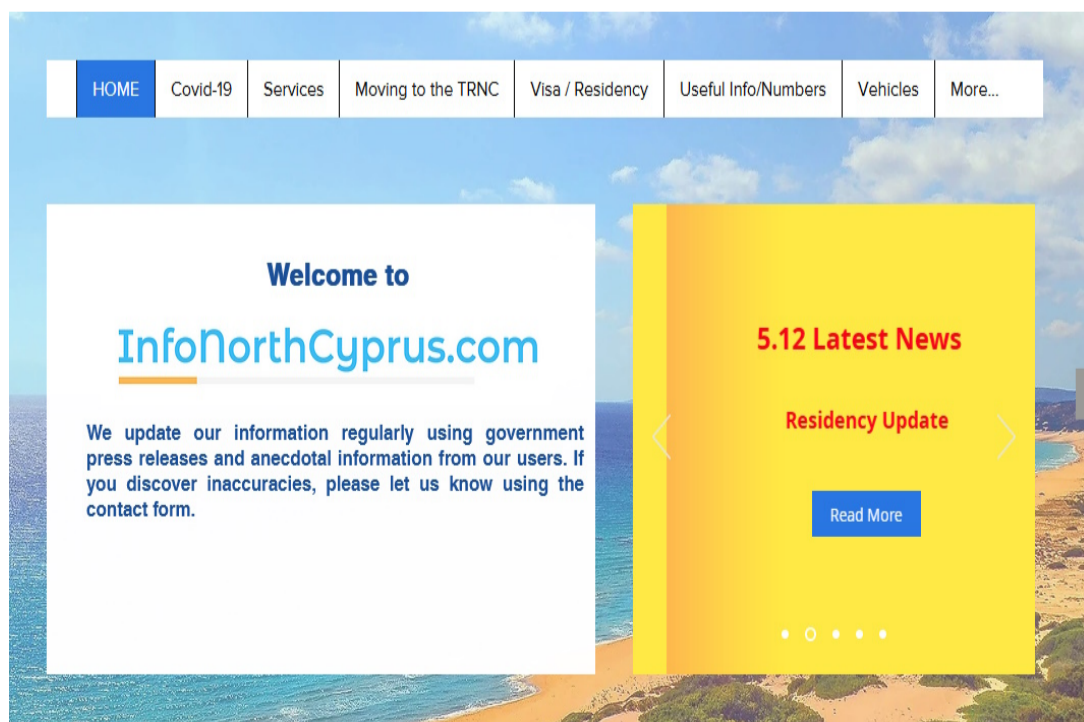



## Kaplica Storm Back in Contention

Kaplica promotion hopes are now back on track after this convincing win over Mehmetçik, leaving them in 2nd place, 2 points behind leaders Çanakkale. Next Saturday these two teams meet in Famağusta.

**Sunday January 22 : İktisatbank BTM League 1 Red Group : Kaplica Emre Genç Stadium.**

This was a “must win” match for both teams, for Kaplica after their defeat at Türkmenköy last week they needed the 3 points to keep up their promotion challenge. For Mehmetçik a win was a must as they have slipped down the table and a defeat would cast them adrift from the leading pack.

It was a 10-30 am kick off which I love, in time to be back in Esentepe for a beer just after 1-00 o'clock.

There was a packed Emre Genç Stadium with the majority being the very partisan supporters of Kaplica., again they made me very welcome.

### MATCH HIGHLIGHTS :

12 mins : Kaplica should have opened the scoring, amazing that they did not as from a Ibrahim Çelik low cross from the right, leading goal scorer Deniz Sert had only to tap the ball in but somehow from a few yards out managed to hit the visitors right

hand post.

13 mins : It didn't really matter as the ball was partially cleared Kaplica Captain EMRE ÇAKIRAL fastened onto the ball and from around 30 yards out let fly with a shot that took a slight deflection to beat goalkeeper Namik. **1-0**

36 mins : A second goal for Kaplica following a Ekrem corner from the left, that “bobbled” around in the Mehmetçik box a few times, the ball fell to Ekrem Aktaş who spotted İBRAHİM ÇELİK in a shooting position and the striker made no mistake. **2-0.**

45 +3 mins : Mehmetçik were given a lifeline with the last kick of the first half when they were awarded a free kick in a very dangerous position just outside the box slightly to the left. Free kick specialist EROL KORKMAZ (who I have seen score a few of these goals) blasted his kick round the wall and past the Kaplica goalkeeper Yasin.

### HALF TIME SCORE : 2-1

47 mins : Mehmetçik almost equalised after the break foiled firstly by a brilliant save from Yasin and then the rebound was scrambled off the line by a Kaplica defender.

53 mins : Likewise in a Kaplica attack Ekrem Aktaş and Ibrahim set up Reşat, who saw his shot cleared off the line by Arif.

61 mins : A third and sealing the win goal came after Mehmetçik loss

possession following a free kick with Ibrahim stealing the ball finding Emre Aktaş on the right whose low right wing cross was met at the far post by İBRAHİM ÇELİK, who had continued running into the box, to bundle the ball in **3-1.**

70 mins : Mehmetçik were in total disarray now from another Ekrem corner the ball was partially punched to the edge of the box by keeper Namik to substitute OGÜN DURSUN who blasted home a first time volley. **4-1**

75 mins : With Mehmetcik pushing men forward, they were caught by a quick Kaplica breakaway with

İbrahim on the right finding REŞAT GENÇ with his cross to slot home **5-1**

A thoroughly emphatic and deserved win for Kaplica, with İBRAHİM ÇELİK the “Man of the Match”, his speed caused havoc in the Mehmetçik defence and when he plays “with fire in his belly” he is a handful for most defences. Also good performances for Captain EKREM ÇAKIRAL, right midfielder EKREM AKTAŞ and defender AZİZ AKTEPE.

Mehmetcik were outplayed though their Captain MURAT ABUZET tried his hardest to get his team going
