



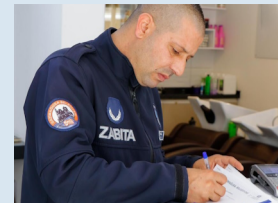

The 23rd Zeytinlik Olive Festival continued unabated



Gazimağusa/Famagusta Municipality Police Unit (Zabita) has launched an effective fight against beauty centres and nail technicians who were found to be operating without permission throughout the city. In the inspections carried out the previous day, a total of 80,872 TL fines were imposed on two individuals.

The Famagusta Municipality Police

increasing complaints about people who continue their activities in a room of their houses without permission to operate as beauticians and nail technicians in the Famagusta region without permission and has acted accordingly.

The Famagusta Municipality Police Unit, which has been working on the identification of individuals for a

while within the scope of the protocol signed between the Cyprus Turkish Beauticians Association and Famagusta Municipality for the inspection of unauthorized beauticians, carried out two separate inspections at houses where unauthorized activities were carried out, especially due to the increasing complaints recently.

It was determined that they carried out the profession of beautician and nail technician, where human health and hygiene rules are among the first conditions sought, in a room of their house, and two people who were determined to have committed the crime of “opening the workplace whose opening is subject to permission without permission or not renewing the permit regarding the working conditions” were fined a gross minimum wage.

While the routine inspections of the Famagusta Municipality Police Unit regarding the workplaces operating in the city continue, sanctions are applied as a result of the general inspections carried out throughout the city.

Famagusta Municipality, which has adopted the principle of peace of the public with city tradesmen who fulfil their tax obligations and comply with the rules, will continue its effective inspections and works for a prosperous, modern, and clean Famagusta with all its units.

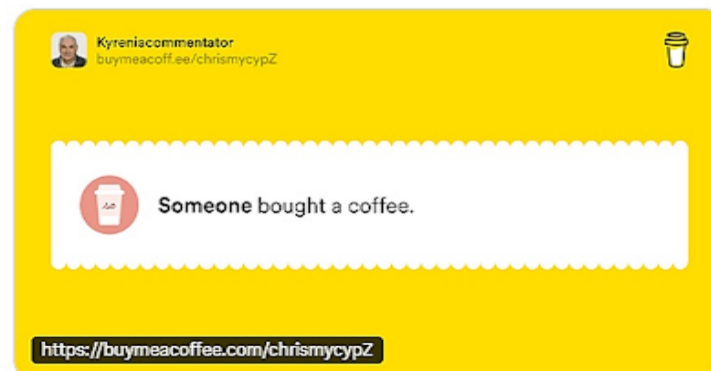

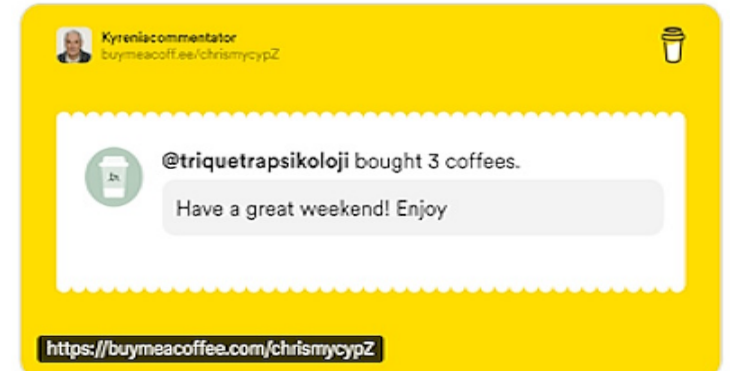

Northern Cyprus has been promoted at the Istanbul Tourism Fair

The Deputy Prime Minister's Office, Ministry of Tourism, Culture, Youth and Environment took part in the Istanbul Tourism Fair, which took place in Istanbul between 9-10 October 2024.

In his message, Ataoglu underlined that approximately 42 thousand people, including 17 thousand children and 11 thousand women, were massacred in Gaza, and that the war in which thousands of Gazans were forced to migrate from their homes was a terrorist attack, and said, "Israel is slaughtering people, women, children, young and old, like a terror crowd. This crime against humanity will not be forgotten throughout history and I believe it will not go unpunished."

Underlining that it is imperative for international organizations, especially the United Nations, to put an end to this inhumane terrorist attack as soon as possible, Ataoglu said, "Israel should receive the punishment it deserves for these terrorist attacks and at the same time, it should withdraw from the occupied Gaza lands as soon as possible."

Arikli: Departments That Contribute To The Budget Need Financial Support



The Post Office is being Upgraded

Minister of Public Works and Transport Erhan Arikli made a speech at the meeting held at the Post Office, congratulating the employees on October 9, World Post Day, and thanking the staff for their devoted work. Enver Öztürk, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Public Works and Transport, and Güven Bengihan, President of KTAMS, also attended the staff meeting organized jointly by the Post Office and the Turkish Cypriot Public Servants Union (KTAMS) and made speeches.

Minister of Public Works and Transport Arikli said in his speech that the quality of the service provided will increase, especially if the departments that contribute to the budget are supported more financially.

Stating that the Postal Department,

like the Vehicle Registration, Inspection and Licensing Branch, makes a significant contribution to the state budget, Arikli said, "Our expectations from the 2025 Budget are low. In the coming period, the Postal Department will try to make up for its deficiencies with the contributions of the Motherland Republic of Turkey. In addition to fast and quality service, we will be in consultation with the union so that our staff can work in environments that comply with the standards

TWO IMPORTANT PROJECTS

Arikli said that there are two important projects in front of the Post Office, one is the 'Postal Operation Center' to be built in the Lefkosa Industrial Zone, and the other is the marketing of the products produced by women in the rural area to the world through PTT Shopping Mall.

Arikli said the following about the projects:

"The 'Postal Operation Center' planned to be built in the Industrial Zone will offer our staff the opportunity to work in a much better environment. In addition, one of the buildings in Famagusta Port will be converted into a package post office. Our efforts to improve the infrastructure of the apartment are ongoing.

"THE AIM IS TO CONTRIBUTE TO RURAL DEVELOPMENT"

On the other hand, we aim to implement our project related to PTT Shopping Mall in 2025. PTT AVM is a huge virtual market established by PTT. Our women who live and produce in rural areas will be able to sell their products all over the world through PTT Shopping Mall through the Post Office. In the first place, we start with eight products, among which are molasses and halloumi. We are planning to increase up to 40-50 products. Our aim is to contribute to rural development through the development of women here."

Öztürk, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Public Works and Transport, told OF a memory he had during his student years and said, "Today, e-mails can be sent in seconds. In the past, letters arrived at

their destination very late, but they had much more value," he said.

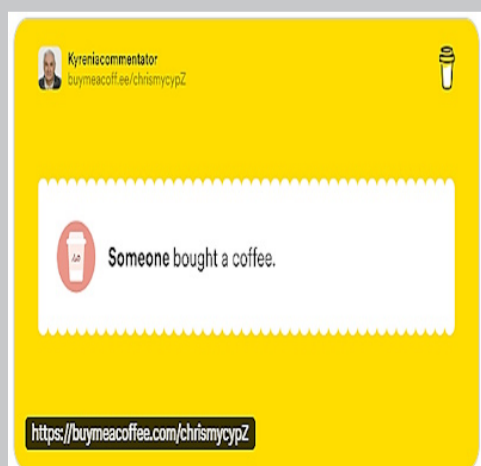
ISKENDER: OUR DEPARTMENT SHOULD BE SUPPORTED AS A BUDGET

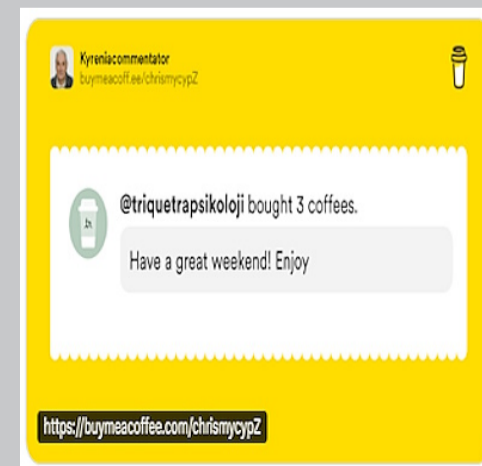

ARUCAD's Prof. Dr. Emrah Öztürk, wins 79th Yunus Nadi Award

ARUCAD Film Design and Management Department Head Assoc. Prof. Dr. Emrah Öztürk, 79th Yunus Nadi Awards in the Story Branch.

Arkin University of Creative Arts and Design (ARUCAD) Film Design and Management Department Head Assoc. Prof. Dr. Emrah Öztürk has achieved great success in the 'short story' category at the Yunus Nadi Awards, one of Turkey's most established and prestigious literary awards. Öztürk was deemed worthy of the 79th Yunus Nadi Awards in the short story category with his work 'The Man Who Cannot Return Home'.

In the 79th Yunus Nadi Awards organised for the 79th time this year, a total of 248 works in 6 branches were meticulously evaluated by the selection committees. 62 works competed in the short story category,

76 in the novel category, 43 in the poetry category, 24 in the social sciences research category, 33 in the cartoon category and 10 in the photography category. As a result of this wide participation and difficult evaluation process, one work was awarded in each branch.

Prof. Dr. Emrah Öztürk wins an award

ARUCAD academic artist Assoc. Prof. Dr. Emrah Öztürk won the award in the short story category as a result of the evaluation of the selection committee consisting of respected names of the literary world Sadık Aslankara, Sezer Ateş Ayvaz, Seval Şahin, Mehmet Zaman Saçlıoğlu and Özcan Karabulut.

In his latest book of stories titled 'The Man Who Can't Return Home' published by Yapı Kredi Publications, Öztürk draws attention



with his original narration and strong character descriptions that go deep into the human soul. The book had previously been among the short list of 10 books selected by the jury of the 70th Sait Faik Story Award, organised in cooperation with the Dürüşşafaka Society and Türkiye İş Bankası Kültür Yayınları, from among 117 story books. Academician, writer and director Öztürk has a total of 3 story books published so far.

The Yunus Nadi Awards are organised every year in memory of Yunus Nadi Abaloğlu, the founder of Cumhuriyet Newspaper, in order to keep alive his contribution to art and literature and continue to support the cultural richness and creative writing tradition of Turkey and the region.

Atelier Arkin, operating as the Lifelong Learning Centre of the Arkin Creative Arts and Design University (ARUCAD), held the opening reception of its 11th Student Exhibition on the evening of 3rd October 2024 at the ARUCAD Art Gallery. The exhibition, which opened with a musical performance,

showcased the works of art students, along with 15 different glass artworks from the Hot Glass Workshop.

The glass artworks were designed and produced by Glass Artist Mete Bahtiyar Karataş at the ARUCAD Glass Workshop, using entirely recycled waste glass. The pieces draw attention to the environmentally friendly aspect of glass art while being presented to art lovers with an aesthetic and

innovative approach.

In the painting section, the students' works began with charcoal sketches and progressed to coloured pieces. These works reflect the students' developmental process, and the exhibition is regarded as a "Development Exhibition." Tekin Can Göntürk led the painting courses, during which two students earned the right to study at ARUCAD.

In his speech at the opening of the exhibition, ARUCAD Vice-Rector Assist. Prof. Dr. İbrahim Dalkılıç stated, "Lifelong learning begins at an individual's birth and continues until the day they close their eyes to life. The knowledge acquired by the individual and the interactions they engage in play a key role in the societal development process. With this exhibition, we see that Atelier Arkin, which we established in the early days of ARUCAD, holds the

potential to be a key building block in the arts and social progress in Cyprus. The glass artworks on display are made entirely from recycled glass, serving as an important symbol for a sustainable future and our diminishing resources."

Gazimagusa Municipality Impose Sanctions On Those Who Break Rules



Gazimağusa/Famagusta Municipality started to impose sanctions on Monday, October 14, within the framework of the powers granted to the municipality by the laws under the heading "Crimes and Penalties" of the Municipalities (Amendment) Law to ensure peace, health, and well-being in the city.

Those who do not comply with the rules in Article 122, Paragraph 1, and the traffic rules in Paragraph 2 of the Municipalities Law will be fined by the relevant unit of Gazimağusa/Famagusta Municipality and the Police and Traffic Police teams.

The offenses that require fixed fines are as follows:

In places where all kinds of spring water to be drunk are packaged and/or where the substances to be eaten or drunk are made, produced, packaged, sold, stored, used or made available, the penalty for non-compliance with the rules and conditions of cleanliness or health and/or the detection of substances that have expired or whose usage and consumption date has expired or which do not comply with the standards determined by the relevant legislation as a result of the analysis, or which are harmful to health to be eaten or drunk, is the minimum wage.

The penalty for opening workplaces that need permission from the municipality without permission is half of the minimum wage. The penalty for non-compliance with the health

conditions of employees in workplaces is the penalty is the minimum wage.

Penalty Imposed for indiscriminate disposal, dumping or storage of garbage, debris, industrial waste and construction debris without the necessary permission is the minimum wage.

The penalty for not complying with the sanitary conditions in public buildings is half of the minimum wage. The penalty for the uncontrolled discharge of septics or wastewater of residences and workplaces into the external environment, without a work and discharge permit or for pouring septic wastes outside the places determined by the municipality is the minimum wage.

The penalty for damage to trees or cutting trees without permission is half of the minimum wage in fields, sports fields and facilities, parks, gardens and green areas, picnics, viewing, and promenade areas.

The offenses that require fixed fines are as follows;

Penalty Imposed for the establishment of pens, dairies, and poultry houses within the boundaries of the Municipality without permission from the Municipality or for feeding more than the specified number of cattle, sheep, poultry, or poultry is the minimum wage. The penalty for not remedying the specified ailment within the period

specified in the notice is half of the minimum wage.

The penalty for failing to fulfil their obligations to notify the relevant Municipality in writing within fifteen days starting from the date of employment, the name, surname, profession, residence, and the amount of wages paid by real and/or legal persons and partnerships with real and/or legal persons who employ contractors is half of the minimum wage.

Penalty Imposed for the failure of real and/or legal persons and partnerships employing contractors to fulfil their obligations to deduct the finalized occupational tax from the wages of the undertaker and deposit it to the Municipality is half of the minimum wage.

The penalty for opening the workplace without obtaining a professional permit or not renewing the permit or not working in accordance with the purpose of the professional leave is the minimum wage.

Penalty Imposed for opening or operating workplaces whose opening is subject to a permit without prior permission or for not renewing the permit related to the conditions of employment is the minimum wage.

The penalty for peddling goods or similar matters without prior permission from the municipality is 20 percent of the minimum wage.

Under the rules of the Animal Welfare Act and the Identification and Registration of Animals and Businesses Act, the penalty for engaging in behaviour that requires sanctions by the municipality is the minimum wage.

The penalty for employers not issuing a health report card to their employees is half of the minimum wage.

Penalty Imposed for hanging an advertising sign/sign without permission from the municipality is the minimum wage.

The offenses that require fixed fines are as follows;

The owner or operator of the touristic facility shall be fined half of the minimum wage for not reporting the information about the overnight stays made in the tourist facility within a month to the Municipality and/or reporting it in a false and/or untruthful manner and/or not providing the information requested by the Municipality and/or not allowing the inspection to be carried out.

The penalty for any person failing to obtain and/or refraining from obtaining the necessary permit to receive water and/or installing pumps in drinking water pipes before or after the meter and/or using illegal water and/or failing to maintain and/or damaging the water clock and/or wasting water in vain is a minimum wage.

Any natural and/or legal person working in vacuuming or trenching services without obtaining the necessary permission; The penalty for the owner, user, and/or disposal of immovable properties that overflow sewage wells and/or create an unsanitary situation is a minimum wage for the failure of the owner, user and/or owner of the existing pollution immediately and/or within the given time from the notification of the Municipality.

Without obtaining the necessary permission, the occupation of any square, street, road, street, sidewalk, park, or green area belonging to the Municipality, public areas, or similar places in relation to construction

works or leaving commodities in these areas without permission, and placing goods in these areas is twice the amount of the fee.

Any person, State, institution, organization, or owner of the building; The penalty for not connecting to the sewer network even though it is mandatory to connect to the sewer network, or connecting to the sewer without obtaining permission from the Municipality and/or giving waste that will not be given to the sewer network is the minimum wage.

Under the Environment Act, the penalty for making noise in violation of environmental legislation is the

minimum wage.

Incorrect Parking Will Not Be Tolerated Either.

To ensure a safer traffic flow on the roads in our city, sanctions will also be imposed in case of non-compliance with the vehicle parking rules, which we all know but cannot comply with in practice.

If the Traffic Police teams detect faulty parking, vehicle drivers will be fined a fixed fine of 1010.90 TL, which is 2.5 per cent of the minimum wage.

Traffic offenses in the Municipalities Law are as follows;

* Delaying and obstructing vehicle passages.

* Failure to obey the instructions of a uniformed law enforcement officer.

* Failure to comply with a 'No stopping, no waiting' or 'No parking' sign.

* Parking within 9.15 m of corners and road signs.

* Parking within 45.70m of traffic lights or beacons.

* Parking within 13.70m from the pedestrian crossing and bus stop.

* Parking on the double yellow line.

* Parking at the entrances and exits of fire stations, police stations, schools, mosques, churches, hospitals, test houses, theater parks, bus stations.

* Parking a car on the sidewalk.

* Failing to show ID, driving license

and documents belonging to the vehicle despite the request of the law enforcement officer.

* Violating the parking period.

* Parking in the pedestrianized zone.

* Not paying for parking.

* Parking in a disabled parking space.

* Parking on the bus platform.

* Parking at the taxi rank





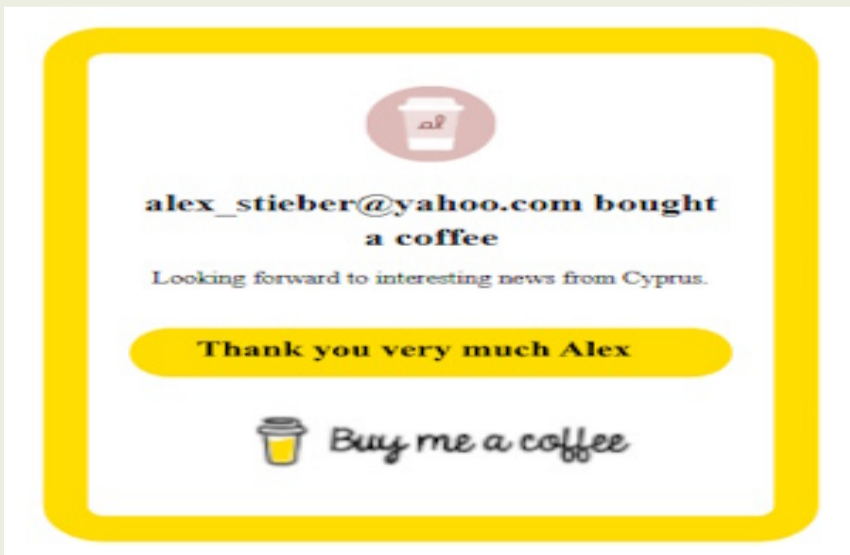

ESENTEPE BEATEN BY “DUBIOUS” PENALTY

Esentepe hoodoo, jinx, monkey on the back call it what you want - continued at the Atatürk Stadium when they were beaten by a “dubious” penalty in the 31st minute, despite a spirited performance they came away from Lefkoşa empty handed.

Sunday September 29, 2024: AKSA SÜLEYMAN GÖKTAŞ Super League : Atatürk Stadium. Very warm and sunny.

Maybe I am a little biased but Esentepe deserved to get something out of this match, there was plenty of praise from neutrals at the game for their efforts but in the end it was 0 points for the team.

Değirmenlik created the most chances and Esentepe were indebted to goalkeeper AHMET VATANSEVEN who pulled off some magnificent saves to keep Esentepe in the match. Esentepe missed two great chances themselves when it seemed easier to score that proved costly.

In the end it boiled down to two penalty decisions one that was given and one that was not.

The Esentepe claim for a penalty came in the 11th minute in the box, by the left hand byline where Lucman was dragged back by the arm of Emirhan causing the Esentepe forward to fall. Referee Osman indicated that the Esentepe forward dived, I was in a good position and yes I have seen penalties given.

The penalty award that sealed Esentepe fate came in the 31st minute when Devran and a Degirmenlik player made contact with each other in the box and both went to ground a penalty was awarded which was thumped home by

CHUKWUMA EMMANUEL AKABUEZE. My position was not great, first hand I did not think it was a penalty, talking to various people afterwards the concessions of opinion was 50-50.

A very warm afternoon, Esentepe brought with them great support who really appreciated the teams efforts at half and full time.

Esentepe started brightly for the opening 15 minutes on a playing surface that didn't look great especially as we are so early into the season.

Gradually Esentepe were forced back with the vastly experience UNAL KAYA masterminding a lot of their moves.

After the goal Esentepe best chance of the half came in 33rd minute when out of nothing midfielder Benjamin created an opportunity for himself, skilfully beating a couple of players he went on a run and then let fly with a tremendous shot from just outside the box that looked a goal all the way, the diving Hasan Piro was beaten all ends up but agonisingly for Esentepe the effort went just inches past the right hand post.

HALF TIME SCORE : 1-0

Ali Avisoyu who had come on at the break for Ege Can missed a great chance to equalise after good build up by Benjamin and Lucman the ball came across from the left to Ali all alone but he screwed his shot wide of the right hand post.

Esentepe then came under heavy pressure from the home team it was a case of Ahmet v Değirmenlik as



pulled off some incredible saves to deny mainly Chukwuma and Aminu. Also under sustained pressure both Frank and Emek managed to head goal bound efforts off the line.

Incredibly Esentepe after this period of Değirmenlik pressure remained only one goal down and they themselves were beginning to look dangerous on breakaways.

Their best chance came in the 75th minute when Ali put through Emre with only the advancing goalkeeper to beat, but the combative midfielder screwed his shot agonisingly wide of the left hand post - a golden opportunity on another day that would have gone in.

Esentepe pushing central defender

Frank up into attack bravely took the game to Değirmenlik who were visibly tiring.

It was a spirited fightback alas no clear cut chances except a header from Frank in injury time that went straight into the arms of Hasan Piro.

FULL TIME SCORE ; 1-0

SUMMING UP: Değirmenlik knew they had been in a game, Esentepe put in one hell of a performance no-one can fault their effort and workmate. If they keep this level of tempo up in forthcoming matches they will survive in this league they just need to put away their goal chances.

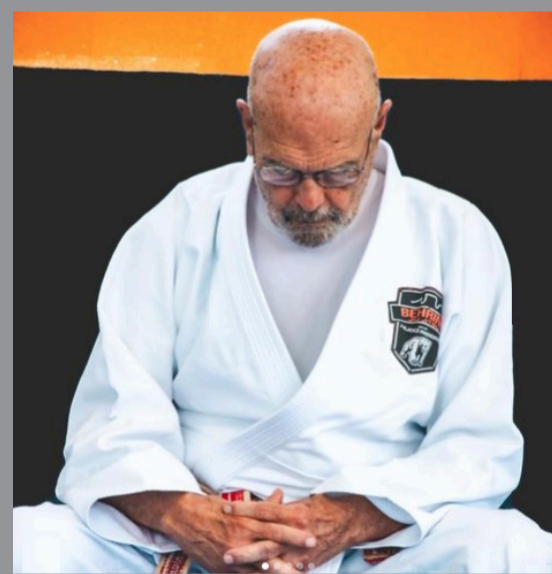

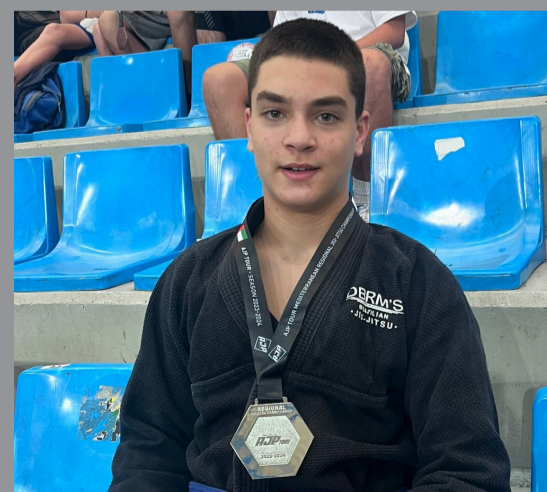

BATTLING ESENTEPE HANG ON FOR A DRAW

Esentepe in the 25th minute had their best chance of the match when

Lucman put through Deniz on the left, the forward unmarked bore down into the box with ex Esentepe Kemal advancing onto him but unfortunately the forwards attempt was blocked by the Alsancak keeper.

Alsancak replied in the 36th minute when Memduh robbed Frank of the ball, cut across the goal area before unleashing a hard shot that was pushed over the bar by the diving Ahmet.

Esentepe were working hard to stay in the match with Alsancak forcing several corners which they mainly won but headers went either wide or over the top of the Esentepe goal.

HALF TIME 0-0

Benjamin who has just undergone a minor heart operation replaced Salih Karal during the break.

Alsancak's big Nigerian striker Weston tried his luck with a shot from outside the box which just went wide of Ahmet's right hand post in the 58th minute.

In a rare Esentepe attack in the 61st minute Deniz tried his luck with a shot outside the area which went over the bar.

75 minutes following a corner from the right there was an almighty scramble in the Esentepe goal which bodies and legs blocking efforts before Ahmet managed to push over the bar a shot for a corner.

In the 88th minute a long throw in from the right was miss -headed across his own area by Lucman to Lawl in a great position at the far post but the Alsancak's leading goal scorer swung wildly and ball sailed wide of the Esentepe goal.



Esentepe were hanging on desperately under siege conditions, bringing on a couple of late replacements to interrupt the flow of the match and to shore up their defence.

As the final whistle blew there were a lot of very tired players from both teams.

On the balance of play Alsancak probably deserved the win, in a game of few chances dominated by the two defences.

Esentepe put in the hard miles

defending as if their lives depended on it. Very hard to pick out their best player Ahmet, Mustafa, Emek, Frank, Devran, and Tugra all put in a shift but for me, EMRE MUTLU just shaded it with an all-action, combative performance in midfield.

A valuable point, though causing concern about a lack of goal chances and only 1 goal scored in 4 matches.

Next Sunday will be a real test for Esentepe when the last 5 seasons' Champions and current leaders MAĞUSA TÜRK GÜÇÜ are the visitors.
