Turkish Cypriot waves TRNC flag from highest point in Antarctica



Turkish Cypriot mountaineer Birkan Uzun, who lives in Seattle, Washington state of America, reached the summit of Mount Vinson, which is the highest point of Antarctica with an altitude of 4,892 meters, on 16th December and waved the flag of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC).

Speaking to Turkish Agency Cyprus (TAK), Uzun said that the goal of climbing the summit of Mount

Vinson in Antarctica constitutes the fifth leg of the "Seven Summits" project, which involves climbing the highest mountain of each of the seven continents of the world.

Uzun said "It is very proud to be able to wave the TRNC flag at the summit, I wanted to thank the country I grew up in."

Altun praises Tatar's messages to the International Community

Presidential Communications
Director, of Turkey Fahrettin Altun
stated that TRNC President Ersin
Tatar has given a strong and clear
message to the international
community that Turkey supports a
two-state solution in Cyprus.

Altun noted that President Ersin Tatar took part in the Turkic Council Media Forum which took place two weeks before the Turkic Council meeting and that he explained to the participants why Cyprus is important for the Turkic world.

Stating that President Tatar gave the message that the TRNC is the bastion of the Turkish world in the Eastern Mediterranean, Altun added that with this strong message given, an important gain has been achieved in terms of the recognition of the TRNC and that Turkey has a clear position on the two-state solution in Cyprus has been brought to international platforms.

Altun also pointed out that it was decided to transform the Turkic Council into the Organization of Turkic States at the meeting of Heads of State



of the Turkic Council and underlined that this is a very critical decision.

Çavuşoğlu: TRNC gained status in international organisations

Stating that the TRNC gained in many status international organisations as a result of the efforts made to increase the visibility and recognition of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) in the international arena, Turkish Foreign Minister Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu noted that TRNC Representative Offices were opened in many countries.

Turkish Foreign Minister Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu evaluated Turkey's 2021 foreign policy by drawing attention to the tensions in the Eastern Mediterranean that were caused by Greece and the Greek Cypriot administration.

Emphasizing that the Cyprus problem should be solved completely, Çavuşoğlu said, "We negotiated for the federation for 53 years, and lastly we said in Crans Montana that we would not negotiate for a federation again"

.Noting that the Greek Cypriot side has not desired a solution for the past 53 years, Çavuşoğlu said that the reason the Greek Cypriot side does not desire a solution is because it does not want to share anything with the Turkish Cypriot side.

"If they wanted a solution they would not have destroyed the 1960 partnership. They see the



Turkish Cypriot people as a minority. That's why we are saying a solution based on sovereign equality must be sought" said Çavuşoğlu.

Explaining that another 53 years will not be wasted with talks on a

federation, Çavuşoğlu stated that other countries also supported the idea of a two-state solution on the basis of sovereign equality in Cyprus.

Tanyel's Smile representatives visit President Ersin Tatar



President Ersin Tatar received representatives of Tanyel's Smile – a charity that helps children and their families in the TRNC through the trauma of cancer.

Visiting was Ceyhun Uzun, his wife Gülay Uzun and Cavit Atalar, who informed the President about the work of the charity. Mr Uzun explained that Tanyel's Smile was set up in memory of Tanyel Uzun -- their daughter, who had died in January 2016 at the age of 20, following a long battle against cancer

Mr Uzun, 52, explained to President Tatar that he is a police constable in the UK who received a British Empire Medal (BEM) in recognition for services to policing and to charity in 2020. Mr Uzun explained that they are helping children and young adults up to the age of 24 and their families "who are struggling with the reality of cancer by helping those in need and providing support".

"Raising awareness about the charity is very important for us," Mr Uzun said. "I have taken part

in different international events and marathons to raise funds for the charity. . .broken Guinness World Record titles for the London Marathon in a six-person costume. . .my next objective is to run from Yedidalga on the west of the country to Dipkarpaz on the east. I want to organise a major race in the TRNC in 2022 to raise funding."

In response, President Tatar said: "I commend you for your meaningful work for a very important cause. Being able to transfer funds raised in the UK in order to help those who have been affected by cancer in the TRNC is very important during the times of the pandemic. I wish to reiterate my sadness at the loss of your daughter. Her legacy and smile lives on through the important work of Tanyel's Smile."

President Tatar added: "I hope that 2022 will be a year where we will be able to undertake even more charity work and have more movement, as we continue our struggle against this pandemic."

The President stated that "2021 has been a year of great losses of life as well as economic difficulties stemming from the effects of the pandemic globally. I wish for 2022 to be one of happiness, good health and blessing," he said.

Ertuğruloğlu dedicated his life for the recognition of the TRNC

FM Ertuğruloğlu gave an interview to AA

TRNC Minister of Foreign Affairs Tahsin Ertuğruloğlu stated that as the Turkish side, they came to a policy based on the existence of two separate states having sovereign equality and equal international status on the Island.

Minister Ertuğruloğlu made assessment to the Anadolu Agency correspondent regarding the Cyprus issue and the reactions to his statements on the "recognition of the TRNC" during his visit to Pakistan.

Ertuğruloğlu argued that the claims made by some dailies that he did not want the recognition of the TRNC did not reflect the truth.

The Minister said that such claims were not convincing as he was someone who had dedicated his entire life for the recognition of the TRNC.

Ertuğruloğlu said, "Since beginning of negotiation processes of the Cyprus issue until today, we have shied away from the recognition of the TRNC. This should not be interpreted as we do not want the TRNC to be recognised. There will be some conjectural conditions to come to the point of asking for recognition. Of course, we couldn't come to the point of asking for recognition in the negotiation processes, which were described as 'inter-communal talks, that stole our 60 years, which I have always criticised, '. We tried to realise our recognition within the negotiation process without bringing an active recognition policy on the agenda.

Explaining that the policy carried out by the Turkish Cypriot side today is that the process of inter-communal negotiations on the Island has collapsed, Ertuğruloğlu also stated that this process will never be repeated.

Ertuğruloğlu said, "We have come to a policy of the existence of two separate states having sovereign equality and equal international status on the Island. In this context, demanding sovereign equality and equal international status should not be interpreted as demanding the recognition of the TRNC. diplomacy, demanding the recognition of the TRNC is different from demanding the acknowledgement of equal international status".

Expressing that the policy that there is only one state on the Island should be eliminated, Ertuğruloğlu pointed out that the fact that this state, which represents the Greek Cypriots and is recognized as the "Republic of Cyprus" is not the only state of the Island should be revealed.

Ertuğruloğlu continued as follows:

"These two states (the so-called Republic of Cyprus and the TRNC) must have equal international status so that new negotiation processes can come to the fore. Recognition will come afterwards. Replying to a question during my visit to Pakistan last week, I have said that we have



demanded recognition neither from nor from Azerbaijan. However, the main principle of our foreign policy is the existence of equal international status and two states on the island. The reality of 'one island, two states' must be revealed.

Mentioning that the existence of a state cannot be measured by its recognition, Ertuğruloğlu pointed out that the whole world knows that the TRNC exists, but only Turkey has come to the point of recognising the TRNC.

Reminding that the informal 5+UN Cyprus meeting was held in Geneva on 27-29 April upon the call of the UN Secretary General, Ertuğruloğlu stated that on the ground that there was no common ground, the UN Secretary General closed the meeting by stating that he would call another informal meeting within 2-3 months.

Ertuğruloğlu continued his speech as follows:


"The UN Secretary General also knows that there is no common

ground between the two sides in Cyprus. As long as they recognise the Greek Cypriot side as the so-called 'Republic of Cyprus' and see the Turkish Cypriot side as a 'so-called community' of that state, there will be no common ground. It is high time that the Secretary-General should convene a meeting again and announce his final decision that 'there is no common ground'. The Secretary General also knows that this is the case, but he is playing for time not to declare it."

Ertuğruloğlu said that the "one island, two states" policy will be brought to the agenda as soon as the world, especially the UN, adopts a policy in line with the realities of the Cyprus issue and added that following the acknowledgement of this, they could move to an active towards seeking recognition of the TRNC.



TRAVEL TO THE TRNC FROM THE UK OR GERMANY

As of Monday 27th December the UK and Germany were placed into the RED list – as far as the TRNC are concerned.

The requirement to enter the TRNC from either of these Countries is now,

- * A negative PCR test 72-hours prior to departure
- * Self-isolation is recommended for a period of three days on arrival
- * A PCR test no more than 72 hours after arrival in the TRNC. If negative no quarantine is required,

You are still required to complete the Guvende Kal TRAVEL form no more than 72 hours before your arrival in the TRNC.

ADAPASS/ANTIGEN TESTS

Despite 'rumours' to the contrary the requirements for access to the following venues is still in force.

INTER BORDER COVID REQUIREMENTS

The following conditions remain whilst 'LEVEL 3' requirements are in force whilst crossing the Green Line.

- * Double vaccinated people with EMA-approved vaccines, as well as the Sinovac, Sinopharm or Sputnik vaccines, can cross with a 7-day negative rapid antigen test or PCR test, 14 days after their final dose (1st dose if Johnson& Johnson).
- * Unvaccinated people (including unvaccinated workers and people who will cross for health reasons) can cross with a 72-hour negative rapid antigen test or PCR test.

NORTH CYPRUS TREVOR'S TIPS

Many of you have been receiving my News Round for many years and have shown disappointment that I stopped sending out the monthly News Round.

Well, I am reintroducing it to the delight of many readers.

Bank of England warning as millions of £20 and £50 notes to become void.

The Bank of England has issued an important warning and reminder that some £20 and £50 notes are set to become void and unusable

On September 30, 2022, the Bank of England will withdraw all legal tender status of the paper £20 and £50 notes. Marking a year to this cut-off date, the Bank of England is reminding and encouraging expats to take any old notes they have and deposit them at their local bank. Ask your own Bank for their take on this matter.

After being handed in, these notes will be replaced with the new polymer £20 notes featuring J.M.W. Turner, and polymer £50 notes featuring Alan Turing.

From September 30, 2022, the new polymer £20 and £50 notes will be the only currency of this amount with legal tender status.

On top of this, anyone with old



notes should be able to exchange them through the Bank of England, directly.

Polymer bank notes will provide greater features that make them difficult to counterfeit, and less susceptible to fraudsters and scam artists.

The improved security measures include a hologram image change, which allows cashiers to tilt the note from side to side in order to check the word change between 'Twenty/Fifty' and 'Pounds', which will confirm its validity.

Furthermore, the new notes include see-through windows. Through this, cashiers will be able to examine the metallic image over the main window to see whether the foil is blue and gold on the front of the note and silver on the back.

Other security features include a silver foil patch, a purple foil patch, a portrait of The Queen which is printed on both sides, and an ultraviolet number.



TRNC Driving Licenses

Let me make it quite clear if you are driving a car in the TRNC and

you intend to stay for more than 90 days you must hold a valid TRNC driving license. For you to apply successfully for a license for the first time, you must hold a valid Temporary Residence Permit.

If you carry on driving without said license, you will be driving illegally, and this also includes an outdated license. If stopped by the police, or are involved in a road traffic accident, the penalty, if minor, will be a fine at the very least and your insurance will be invalid. One person last week, was stopped by the police and was fined 6,850 TL because his license was outdated.

Just think about it for a few minutes, if the accident involved



hitting a pedestrian, seriously injuring someone, or even killing someone, the penalty could be a custodial sentence, and after serving the sentence you may also be deported. You will also have to pay for the Third Party repair costs.





It might be the season to be jolly and goodwill to all men but visitors Yeniboğaziçi were in no mood to hand out any festive cheer.

Saturday December 26, 2021: AKSA League 1; Erdal Barut Stadium.

Weather: Dry and cloudy.

About this time of year on the telly there would probably be a rerun of 'İt Be Alright On The Night", well this match was not alright, as compare Denis Norden would say " we will consign this film to the archive files marked 'Forgetful Clips", well we can truly consign this match to the same place as well - it's forgotten already

Shame in front of one of the largest crowd, Esentepe in their last match before the winters break turned in their worse performance of the season, and visitors deservedly came away with the Christmas present of 3 points.

The match had little skill with the ball spending more time in the air than it did on the ground.

After shipping 8 goals in their last 3 matches Esentepe Coach Davut Kansu opted to make defensive changes. The vastly experienced defender Nersin Osman was dropped to the bench, with 18 year old Mustafa Soytürk given his first full start at senior level at right back. After struggling for many seasons with injuries Burak Tümkan was given a rare start at left back. However, his plans were in disarray in the warm ups as goalkeeper Onur

Özbingül who has been struggling with a knee injury failed a late fitness test and had to be replaced by Goalkeeper Coach Tuğrul Denkler.

Esentepe made a horrible start going behind to an early goal in the 7th minute. A corner on the left taken by Cemil went unchallenged and RAMADAN AĞDAÇ drove in a low shot that goalkeeper Tuğrul diving to his right managed to get a hand to but could not prevent it from going into the net. 0-1

Things got worse for Esentepe when Burak went down clutching his hamstring in the 14th minute, the unlucky player was replaced by Nersin. Tragedy for the popular player he has fought so hard to overcome injuries and to get back to full fitness.

Esentepe nearly went two goals down when a Ramadan corner caused confusion in a very static Esentepe defence resulting in a header going just wide.

14 minutes again Esentepe was guilty of giving the ball away again with Cemil having a shot outside the area saved by the diving Tuğrul.

Esentepe had started the match very sluggish and were second best to the ball as the visitors enjoyed the best of the opening half.

Esentepe at last had a goal scoring opportunity in the 27th minute following a Hüseyin Ermiş corner resulted in defender Devran driving a low shot past the Yeniboğaziçi right hand post.



In the 40th minute Devran gave away a free kick just outside the box out on the left, Cemil cracked a shot that had Tuğrul diving to his left to parry the shot, collided with the post in making the save, and had to receive lengthy treatment.

It was a poor first half display by Esentepe with striker Eser working hard up front but getting little support and often isolated, far too often Esentepe was relying on the long ball trying to get the speedy Hüseyin Deynekli into the game it was all too predictable. HALF TIME SCORE: 0-1

Esentepe immediately made a change during the break with Semih Arslan replacing Hüseyin Ermış, the teenager taking up the role of supporting Eser.

The game continued to disappoint with many interruptions due to fouls it was poor fare to the large crowd.

Yeniboğaziçi increased their lead in the 75th minute when winger Serhat sent a high cross, that looked like was going over the Esentepe bar, but it dipped suddenly goalkeeper Tuğrul tried to palm the ball over the bar, instead he succeeded in flicking the ball onto the bar wherein rebounded to substitute MEHMET ÖZTEMİZ to volley home. 0-2,

Esentepe was given a fortuitous lifeline in the 78th minute when a high ball into the Yeniboğaziçi area resulted in Esentepe winning a penalty after Hüseyin Deynekli again went to the ground following a challenge. ESER KAN put away the penalty taking his tally to 7 goals for the season.

Esentepe huffed and puffed but could not find a way to secure an equaliser which in all honesty they didn't deserve. FULL TIME SCORE: 1-2

SUMMING UP: A very disappointing Esentepe performance where their shortcomings were shown up, if there is any transfer money available during the winters break, then a dominant centre half and a creative midfield player must be top of the shopping list. Not many positives to take out of the match Tuğra in midfield worked hard and substitute Semih who came on at the break made his presence felt and put himself about. Veteran defender Okan Kibar was a pick of a very poor team performance.

Esentepe Cup hopes washed away in the Rain Result: GÖÇMENKÖY İYSK1 ESENTEPE KKSK 0

As predicted Esentepe Kıbris Cup hopes were extinguished in monsoon conditions to a hotly disputed penalty and once again the Atatürk Stadium "hoodoo" continues to haunt them.

Thursday 30 December 2021: Nicosia Group Kıbrıs Cup 1st Round: Atatürk Stadium.

The match was played in appalling conditions from start to finish - heavy driving rain, lightning, thunder, waterlogged pitch it was a lottery a farce no doubt about it if this game was played in the UK the match would be abandoned. Full marks to both sets of players who should be applauded in getting this match finished in these conditions.

Once again Esentepe went away from the Atatürk Stadium winless, this venue is certainly their "monkey on the shoulder, in truth they never looked like scoring, Göçmenköy goalkeeper Ali Duvarcı beaten eight times last Sunday could have sat in his goalmouth with an umbrella for protection such was how many times he touched the ball.

The Atatürk Stadium (capacity 28000) was host to around 50 hardy souls who braved the inclement weather.

Both defences dominated the match, close passing was impossible, the ball getting stuck in the many pools of water with

players slipping and sliding everywhere.

Esentepe squad was stretched through injuries and Covid played virtually a full strength team but gave a first senior debut to 17 year old Ismet Güneş at left back and he had a sound match.

Göçmenköy in the 5th minute attacked when a long cross from the left that was laid back by Cemal to Ali Uçtaş to crack in a shot that was deflected for a corner.

Göçmenköy put together a good short passing move surprisingly in the conditions resulted in Mehmet Göçben getting in a low shot outside the box that skidded along the wet surface that Esentepe goalkeeper Tuğrul diving to his left managed to get his fingertips to to deflect it for a corner.

Göçmenköy took the lead in the 38th minute through a hotly disputed penalty. A Cemil corner from the right to the far post was headed onto the crossbar where it rebounded as referee Zeki Torre

was convinced onto the arm of the Esentepe defender Okan Kıbar. Esentepe players protested strongly that the ball had struck Okan's thigh but the referee was unmoved. Göçmenköy top scorer BEKİR YILDIZ sent Tuğrul the wrong way with the penalty kick. HALF TIME SCORE; 1-0

.The match continued in torrential rain with Esentepe defending doggedly but rarely threatening the Göçmenköy goal.

On the 48th minute, Ali Üçtaş tried a shot outside the Esentepe area but the ball cleared the bar.

Both sets of players battled manfully in the treacherous





conditions as the farce continued.

In the 78th minute following a free kick just outside the Esentepe box, Firket brought goalkeeper Tuğrul into action, the goalkeeper flinging himself to his left pushing the ball away for a corner. 0-1.

For once we were thankful that the match would not go into extra time or a penalty shootout as we were cold and wet! .FULL TIME SCORE; 1-0

SUMMING UP; A hard battling performance by Esentepe who defended stoutly but in truth created virtually nothing upfront. Veteran defender OKAN KIBAR had a strong match at the back his experience and leadership qualities keeping Göçmenköy chances to a minimum. He was unlucky to be penalized for the penalty his fellow defender Şenol Hacıoğlu also had a good match. The short winters break gives Coach Davut Kansu a chance to re-access his squad, if any money is available a central defender and a creative midfield player are a must.
