This year we will be raising money for The Civil Emergency Service Volunteers. The route starts at the Kervan Pizza Garden, Karaoğlanoğlu and will take you on a leisurely 75-mile trip east of Kyrenia using some of the less travelled and most beautiful roads in Northern Cyprus. There are plenty of places to stop along the route. Also attached are the contact details for some hotels and guest houses in the Yeni Erenköy/Dipkarpaz area.

You will be given route instructions along with a testing set of questions which will tax your powers of observation and knowledge of the island.

The start will be at 11.00am. Prize giving at The Balçı Plaza Hotel, Yeni Erenköy will be at around 5.00pm. A BBQ has been kindly provided by Creditwest Bank—on the beach weather permitting!

THE ROUTE IS ON TARMAC ROADS, HOWEVER, SOME OF THE ROADS ARE MOUNTAINOUS WITH DROPS, BLIND BENDS AND NARROW SECTIONS. Therefore, please check that your passengers and indeed you are comfortable with this.

Entries will be limited and will be processed on a first come first served basis. Final instructions will be issued one week before the event.

Closing Date for entries: FRIDAY APRIL 05, 2013


What must be remembered

Civil Emergency Service Volunteers

Formed in March 2008, the Civil Emergency Service (Volunteers) are fully integrated into the Civil Emergency Services of the TRNC and have been called upon many times to assist in road traffic accidents, fires domestic and forest providing medics at football, water skiing, rugby and the many fetes and open events in the TRNC. CES(V) also provides close medical support for special events held at various hotels or the public amphitheatre where international stars perform—among those were Dionne Warwick, Neil Diamond, UB40, Cool and the Gang, Tom Jones, Engleburt Humperdink, Barry White, the Fashion TV Awards, the West End show Mama Mia and many more.

CES(V) is organised into the following: West—Tatlısu /Esentepe; Central—Girne and East of Lapta. Each, under a team leader, is responsible to the Chief officer. CES(V) is administered by a board of officers who meet monthly. Training and CPD training is carried out fortnightly. Exercises are held regularly with the full time colleagues.

CES(V) also provides first aid training for public and other organisations, schools and institutions and is responsible for all first aid and vehicle extrication training for the fire service. Trauma training for the 112 services and both ambulance and emergency room staff throughout the TRNC.

CES(V) is authorised to issue certificates for training by The Association of First Aiders Qualifications which is the awarding arm of the Association of First Aiders (AoFA), the UK's most progressive first aid association which is an Ofqual awarding organisation.
