#### 2014-15 Club Achievements

#### The Club Community Service Signature Project:

A WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE PATIENT TRANSPORT VEHICLE for the new Renal Dialysis Unit at Kyrenia's Dr Akcicek Hospital. With help from 'Friends of the TRNC Emergency Services', The Little Society of Kyrenia, Donors from UK Rotary, Jessic Bar & Restaurant, Acapulco Hotel, Iktisat Bank, Niyazi Adeniz, & Friends of Rotary. The total amount donated was \$40,000 (100,000TL)

- \$1,500 donated to PolioPlus, with the Bill & Melina Gates Foundation Multiplier this
  equates to 7,500 immunisations that protect children from this crippling disease.
- Art & Craft Supplies donated to Karakum Special School, for disabled students. A
  Trampoline, bicycles and electric mini-car also donated. These latter items will help
  make students traffic conscious and help with balance and co-ordination, as well as
  being fun!
- \$1,000 USD donation to 'Cyprus Friendship Program' enabling Cypriot teens to travel
  to US in summer for friendship and leadership team building activities between Turkish and Greek Cypriot young leaders of the future. This work is also followed up locally.
- 3 ShelterBoxes were donated for emergency relief in Nepal in response to the devastating earthquakes. Rotary International, which all Clubs donate to, donated a further 1,000 ShelterBoxes and directed other aid through Nepal Rotary Clubs.
- Continuation of a 3 Year Scholarship for Ülfet Dilek Tomuk, studying Turkish English
   Greek Translation and Interpretation at Near East University.
- International Global Grant Partner for our twin Club in Mersin, Turkey, to provide educational and training equipment for a centre for young adults with learning disabilities.
- International Global Grant Partner for Adana-Cukurova Club in Turkey, on their "Clean Water" project to improve hygiene and supply cleaner water to primary schools in their area.

Minibus boo Girne dialysi

THE dialysis unit being set up at Girne State Hospital has received a boost — in the form of a vehicle

a boost — in the form of a vehicle to transport patients which was handed over yesterday.

The 100,000TL minibus has been provided by the Rotary Club of Kyrenia Liman, under the "signature project" of chairman Malcolm Mitcheson, with the support of the Friends of the TRNC Emergency Services — known as the 112s — and some 20 local businesses, civil groups and charities including the Little Society of Kyrenia. Kyrenia.

Rotary Clubs from Scotland, England and Turkey also con-tributed, along with individual donations and a series of fundraising events.

Plans for the donation began in early June last year when the hospital's deputy chief doctor, Salih Beyoğlu, told Rotary Club members that a patient transport vehicle would be a major boon for the unit.




#### **Bahrain Conference**



As it wasn't an official visit, IDG Mustafa gave only a brief address to say how delighted he was to informally visit such a vibrant Club on his first trip to Cyprus.





#### **Dear Rotarians**

It seems that the majority of Clubs in Cyprus have a problem with attendance of members at meetings. The attendance figures are not at the desired level. This also means less members are involved in the administration of our Club .Bearing in mind that some of the elder members have decided to opt for rule 85 means that our membership has decreased. Therefore there needs to be a concerted effort to ensure new members are enlisted for the healthy functioning of our Club. We must make sure that the prospective members are of the calibre suitable for Rotary membership. Thus all of our members are expected to try and bring in new members.

We need to have a variety of events to bring enjoyment and fun to make meetings more interesting ensuring increased attendance. We should aim to have visits to schools, hospitals, old peoples homes, newspapers, T.V. Stations etc. Also we can arrange to have brunches either on a Saturday or Sunday to break away from routine meetings. There should also be Fellowship weekends with other Clubs to increase cooperation with them. Our members should be encouraged to attend meetings and events of other Clubs in Cyprus.

There is a clear need to increase the image of Rotary and to ensure coverage in the media. We made significant steps to do this during Malcolm Mitcheson's Presidency and a lot of the credit must go to Amanda Fiora who will assist us in this endeavor during my Presidency. We can invite journalists as guest speakers and arrange T.V. Programmes enabling us the opportunity to explain Rotary.

When we get more coverage in the media we can attract new members and also ensure that the charitable work of Rotary is understood by the community at large. We can also cooperate with the Evkaf Foundation for Joint Projects in various fields.

With regard to sponsors for our projects we need to go out to businesses and banks and ask for their help. Perhaps we can put a team together for this purpose. We should also get in touch with EU and U.N. Agencies to see if we can benefit from them. Perhaps we can invite officials from these Agencies to our Club to create a relationship for cooperation.

Our members need to be reminded that there is a minimum requirement for attendance at Rotary Club meetings and that the Club Administration has to ensure that all the members abide by the rules. Adherence to Club discipline, rules and regulations is very important. In this respect we can always ask for advise from Rtn. Taner Erginel who as the retired Chief Justice is more than able to help.

Hence during my Presidency I intend to introduce variety to meetings and to concentrate on increasing the image of Rotary as well as recruiting new members.
