ATHENS, Dec. 27.—The Greek Government has awarded its highest civilian honor, the Golden Cross of Saint Xavier and the highest war honor, the Medal of Military Merit, to Asa K. Jennings of Utica, N. Y., for his work with the Near East Relief in directing the evacuation of 500,000 refugees from Asia Minor.

This was the first time in history that both medals were awarded to the same person simultaneously.

The Greek Government also has asked the United States to permit it to award the Medal of Military Merit to the commanding officers of the twelve American destroyers which assisted in the evacuation of the Greek refugees.

Ordu intiyacı için Amerika Büyük Elçimiz vasıtasıyla Amerikaya sipariş edilen mülzeme, silâh ve müimmatın, ayda 50 dolar ücretle sevk, nakliye ve sigorta masamelelerine nazaret işleriyle tavzif edilmiş olan Türk - Amerikan dostluk cemiyeti reis muavini Avukat Ir. Jennings' in kendisine tevdi edilen sipariş işlerini lâyükile ve zamanında başardığı gibi hazinenin asgarî 32.250 dolarlık bir zarara girmesini önlemek suretile de büyük meselesi görüldüğü anlaşıldığından bu hizmetile karşılık olarak muameleyne 94I d. viz cetvellerininin Hava. müstegarlığı tansisatında bin dolar ikraaiye verilmesi ve bütçe-de tertibi mansusu bulunmayan bu paranın 1940 malî yılı Maliye bütçesinin 222 inci masarifi gayri melnuza tertibinden karşılanması; Millî Müdafaa Vekillığının 25/2/94I tarih ve 6255 sayılı tezkeresile yapılan teklifi ve Maliye Vekillığının 24/4/194I tarih ve III24/1654 sayılı mütaleanamesi üzerine, Lunasebei muameleye kararınınun 59 uncu maddesine tevfikeyen, İcra Vekilleri Heyetince 9 Mayıs 1941 tarihinde kabul olunmuştur.
