Mustafa Bariam Pattas duly cautioned in  
terms of § 86 of Order in Council 1882:-

I went today that the state must I made against  
Osman - he was threatened by the Zaptiehs that  
if we don't give evidence against Osman we  
should be hanged & that we should suffer -  
They said "Yell against Osman - You are the  
opener against Osman" "The two of you will  
help Osman to fall down because you are  
two and you say against him because he  
has said against you they have released him.  
You say against him you shall catch him &  
release you" They had been keeping us for 22  
days - they used to come day & night and  
they used to ask us to speak against Osman  
"We shall release you you shall catch him who  
is the cause" - he got afraid and at once we  
said so but it is not true - At the moment  
when the local Commandant took us to the  
spot where Osman was placed he told us we  
were the people who committed the crime we

Nizam Singh's case  
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Yusef Bariam Pouroudeh duly  
cautioned in terms of § 86 Order in Council 1882  
states:-

They arrested me kept me for eight days at Delhi -  
They had me shipped on the station and the Zaptiehs  
used to come & tell me that if I wouldn't tell the  
truth they would hang me - They said "Say the  
truth you shall release you - Osman is speaking  
against you they will hang you" - Then they  
took me to both sides then I got Osman and  
I asked the Zaptiehs for themselves can I speak  
before evidence "if you don't give evidence they will  
hang you you will not get off" The statement I  
have already made is not true because we were  
threatened by the Zaptiehs and when local Commandant  
took us to the place & showed us the spot of  
Osman told us we had killed him he &  
then other said "we are not the person who  
killed him but you are the person who  
killed him"
